Lt. Gov. Josh Green / COVID in Hawaii (20 minutes)

The Lt. Gov. visits with an update on COVID-19 in the state. The LG covers the record number of COVID cases over the last several days; the importance of vaccines & boosters; mask wearing basics; the new Honolulu city policy on gatherings; the infectiousness of the omicron variant; the treatment of COVID omicron; the status of testing in Hawaii and the nation; the optimum time for getting a COVID test.

Today's topics include the latest Covid numbers; herd immunity; the possibility of this being the peak of the omicron spread; omicron vs delta and the loss of taste and smell; crowding in hospitals; staffing challenges in the hospitals; the information coming out of the Dept of Education regarding Covid; an update on mask wearing.

The Lt. Gov. also updates us on the issue with water safety on Red Hill.

FEB 6, 2022 – Lt. Gov. Josh Green / COVID in Hawaii / Red Hill water

The Lt. Gov. gives a weekly update on COVID in Hawaii. Topics include the decrease in COVID numbers and what that means; other variants; the Safe Travels program; home testing and the reporting of statistics; the effect of COVID in the schools.

The Lt. Gov. also covers the ongoing issue with safe water in Red Hill.

FEB 13, 2022 – Lt. Gov. Josh Green / COVID in Hawaii / Red Hill water

The Lt. Gov. gives a weekly update on COVID in Hawaii. The LG speaks on the continuing decline of COVID cases, especially hospitalizations; the loosening of restrictions for businesses; vaccinations for children; the COVID death rate; the activity in the hospital; secondary issues that have arisen due to COVID, especially mental health.

The Lt. Gov. also gave an update on issues the legislature has been tackling this session. He also addressed the indictment of two Hawaii legislators on bribery charges.

FEB 20, 2021 – Lt. Gov. Josh Green / COVID in Hawaii

Lt. Gov. Josh Green updates us on the COVID-19 situation in Hawaii. He covers the latest case numbers; anticipating when the death count will start dropping; the numbers on vaccinations and boosted residents; relaxing the restrictions on Oahu;

Other topics: the water controversy at Red Hill and the bill that Hawaii Senator Brian Schatz introduced for the closing of the underground fuel tanks; the upcoming state budget relative to coronavirus response; Hawaii's recent tourism numbers.
