The Florida Roundup

This program, launched in Oct. 2017, mirrors the format of WLRN's original locally-focused Florida Roundup program with a broader, statewide focus. Each week WLRN's <u>Tom Hudson</u> and WJCT's <u>Melissa Ross</u> discuss the week in Sunshine State news with listeners, journalists and newsmakers from around Florida. Both stations post the show on the web, frequently with different headlines. *The Florida Roundup* airs live Fridays at noon. In addition to WLRN in South Florida and WJCT in Jacksonville, the program also is carried statewide on WUSF-Tampa, WGCU-Fort Myers, WQCS-Fort Pierce, WFIT-Melbourne, WMFE-Orlando, WFSU-Tallahassee, and WUFT-Gainesville.
