Each week WLRN's <u>Tom Hudson</u> and WJCT's <u>Melissa Ross</u> discuss the week in Florida news with listeners, journalists and newsmakers from around the state. Both stations post the show, frequently with different headlines, on the web. *The Florida Roundup: Statewide Edition* airs live Fridays at 1 pm. In addition to WLRN in South Florida and WJCT in Jacksonville, the program also is carried statewide on WUSF-Tampa, WGCU-Fort Myers, WQCS-Fort Pierce, WFIT-Melbourne, WMFE-Orlando and WUFT-Gainesville.
