This report contains descriptions of issue-responsive programming broadcast by this station during the reporting period.

KVUE Issues-Responsive Programming

The following programs aired on the station during the reporting period. Each program regularly provides information or addresses current local issues of concern to viewers in the area where the station is located.

- Texas Country Reporter: Texas Country Reporter host Bob Phillips introduces viewers to homegrown businesses, colorful people, and points of interest across the state. This program airs every Sunday morning at 10:30 AM and is 30 minutes in length. (Syndicated)
- Boomtown: KVUE'S commitment to covering Austin's explosive growth and the opportunities and challenges that go along with it. Stories air almost daily in all newscasts covering traffic, development, jobs, the economy, affordability, housing, etc.
- Community Service Projects: KVUE sponsors a number of community service projects throughout the year, encouraging viewers to participate. These segments air during various newscasts and are generally 2-3 minutes in length. (Local)
- Community Service Specials: KVUE airs periodic in-depth programs that provide viewers with information and opportunities to give back to the community. These programs air at various times and are typically 30-60 minutes in length. (Local and Syndicated)
- Defenders: The KVUE News investigative team provides comprehensive reports on critical issues and concerns facing the city of Austin and its citizens. These Defenders reports air on Mondays and/or Thursdays during the 6:00 or 10:00 PM newscasts and are typically 3-4 minutes in length. (Local)
- Friday Football Fever: KVUE's Sports team covers all the biggest high school football matchups with highlights and analysis every Friday night during football season.
- Monday with the Mayor: KVUE visits with the Mayor of Austin every other Monday to discuss current topics of interest to the citizens. The segments air on Monday evenings during the 6:00 a.m. newscast and are typically 3-4 minutes in length. (Local)
- Take This Job: Anchors go to local businesses and "work" at specific jobs and/or try new things suggested by our viewers. Connecting with communities and bringing awareness to what careers are out there (Local)
- Texas This Week: KVUE Political Reporter Ashley Goudeau covers the big events from the week in Texas politics and interviews experts or local and/or state officials about timely topics. This airs weekly in the Weekend Daybreak newscast. (Local)
- Vote Texas: This is an initiative of both the news and marketing departments to encourage civic engagement and participation in the voting process.
- KVUE News Special Reports: KVUE periodically airs special news segments relating to issues of significant real-time importance to Austinites. These segments may include breaking news, severe weather coverage, viewer responses to KVUE calls to action, etc. These segments can air at any time and vary in length from several minutes to several hours. (Local)
- Political Debates: KVUE airs periodic political debates to provide viewers with information prior to casting their ballots. The debates air at various times and are one hour in length. (Local & Syndicated)
