



FOX 10 Xtra News airs 1 hour of live news each weekday @ 7PM. In addition, the station produces a 2 hour streaming live news show each weekday @ 10AM, "FOX 10 News Now."

This report highlights the issues that were of greatest importance during the months of January, February, and March 2019.

On the chart that follows we list the stories we covered in these topic areas including the date, specific newscast and on-air format. Here is a key to estimate how much time we allocated to each story:

RDR = reader

Anchor reads script with no video. Typically 20 seconds

VO = anchor voice-over

Anchor reads script with video. Typically 20-30 seconds

VOSOT = anchor voice-over/"sound on tape"

Anchor reads script with video. Story includes sound bite from interview subject. Usually 45 seconds

LIVE VO = live voice over

Reporter live in the studio or field with extended video and information. Typically 1 minute

LIVE VOSOT = live voice over/"sound on tape"

Reporter live in the studio or field with extended video and sound bite from interview subject. Usually 1 minute, 45 seconds

PKG = reporter package

A self-contained story narrated by an anchor or reporter

An anchor usually introduces the story

Including anchor introductions, stories typically run 1 minute, 30 seconds

LIVE PKG = live reporter including reporter package

Same as PKG above, except a reporter introduces the story live from the scene

1/2/19	7PM	VO	A SMOKY AND CHAOTIC SCENE AT THE BORDER, WHERE VIOLENCE IS ESCALATING. TEAR GAS AND PEPPER SPRAY USED ON TUESDAY TO STOP A RUSH OF MIGRANTS FROM CROSSING INTO THE UNITED STATES ILLEGALLY. HUMAN RIGHTS GROUPS IMMEDIATELY CONDEMNING BORDER PATROL AGENTS, SAYING - "USING TEAR GAS AGAINST MEN, WOMEN, AND CHILDREN SEEKING PROTECTION IS CRUEL AND INHUMANE." THE INCIDENT HAPPENED JUST A DAY BEFORE A COURT APPEARANCE BY AN ILLEGAL IMMIGRANT ACCUSED OF KILLING POLICE CORPORAL RONIL SINGH. THAT CASE, PROMPTING A SIGNIFICANT REACTION FROM THOSE OPPOSED TO CALIFORNIA'S SANCTUARY POLICIES.
1/9/19	7PM	PKG	A TALE OF TWO PRESIDENTIAL MEETINGS IN D.C. TODAY, ONE WITH MEMBERS OF THE PRESIDENTS OWN PARTY WHERE HE SAID THEY WERE TOTALLY UNIFIED AND ANOTHER WHERE THE PRESIDENT GOT UP AND WALKED OUT ON DEMOCRATS. SCHUMER says: "He sort of slammed the table and when leader Pelosi said she didn't agree with the wall, he just walked out and said we have nothing to discuss." JUST LIKE THE MEETING AT THE WHITE HOUSE BEGAN, IT ENDED NO CLOSER TO A COMPROMISE OVER THE BORDER WALL. PENCE says: "When she said no, the president said goodbye." THE PRESIDENT TWEETING IT WAS A "TOTAL WASTE OF TIME." PELOSI says: "It was a petulant President of the United States. A person who would say, I'll keep government shut down for months or years unless I get my way." EARLIER IN THE DAY THE PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT MEETING WITH SENATE REPUBLICANS. TRUMP says: "Tremendous Republican support, and I think we're going to win. We need... listen... We need border security." HOUSE DEMOCRATS EXPECTED TO "ONE-BY-ONE" PASS SPENDING BILLS THAT WOULD REOPEN INDIVIDUAL AGENCIES. MCGOVERN says: "These bills offer us a way out of the president's shutdown...an embarrassing spectacle that never should have happened in the first place." WHILE THE PRESIDENT DIDN'T DECLARE THE BORDER A NATIONAL EMERGENCY IN HIS SPEECH TUESDAY NIGHT. HE IS STILL WEIGHING THE OPTION. TRUMP says: "You can never have border security unless you have a steel barrier. A concrete wall. You can call it whatever you want." THE WHITE HOUSE THREATENING IF ANY OF THE DEMOCRATS' STANDALONE SPENDING BILLS MAKE IT THROUGH CONGRESS AND TO THE PRESIDENT'S DESK, HE WILL VETO THEM. MEANWHILE, THOUSANDS OF MIGRANTS FROM THE CENTRAL AMERICAN CARAVANS ARE STILL WAITING TO CROSS INTO UNITED STATES, CAMPED JUST SOUTH IN TIJUANA AND THEY'RE REACTING STRONGLY TO THE PRESIDENT'S ADDRESS ON IMMIGRATION. REACTION WAS PREDICTABLY MIXED BUT THERE'S AGREEMENT ON ONE POINT, THE GROWING HUMANITARIAN CRISIS AT THE BORDER. AMERICANS WHO LIVE IN BORDER AREAS, ALSO REACTING STRONGLY, MANY WHO SUPPORT THE PRESIDENT SAY IT WAS EXACTLY WHAT THEY WANTED TO HEAR. WHILE OTHERS CLAIM HE'S NOT DOING ENOUGH TO HELP THE MIGRANTS AND NEEDS TO SOFTEN HIS TONE. DEMOCRATIC LAWMAKERS ARE NOW PUSHING THE ADMINISTRATION TO OFFER MORE AID TO THE MIGRANTS WHO ARE AWAITING THEIR CHANCE TO APPLY FOR ASYLUM.
1/31/19	7PM	VO	A RECORD-BREAKING DRUG BUST AT THE ARIZONA BORDER TODAY. A LOAD OF THE DANGEROUS DRUG FENTANYL WAS SEIZED AT THE NOGALES PORT OF ENTRY. NEARLY 254-POUNDS OF FENTANYL WERE FOUND UNDERNEATH A FALSE FLOOR IN A PRODUCE TRUCK. UNITED STATES CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION HELD A PRESS CONFERENCE IN NOGALES TODAY TO ANNOUNCE THE DRUG SEIZURE. A LARGE STASH OF METHAMPHETAMINE WAS ALSO CONFISCATED FROM THE TRUCK. THE TRUCK DRIVER IS FROM MEXICO AND IS IN FEDERAL CUSTODY.
1/31/19	7PM	PKG	IT'S ONLY BEEN ONE DAY SINCE A BIPARTISAN GROUP OF 17 LAWMAKERS GOT TO WORK NEGOTIATING A SPENDING BILL THAT BOTH DEMOCRATS AND REPUBLICANS CAN POTENTIALLY AGREE ON. BUT IN DUELING PRESS EVENTS TODAY, THE PRESIDENT AND HOUSE SPEAKER BOTH CALLED INTO QUESTION WHETHER A DEAL IS EVEN POSSIBLE. JUST OVER TWO WEEKS REMAIN FOR THE BIPARTISAN CONFERENCE COMMITTEE TO STRIKE A SPENDING DEAL BEFORE TEMPORARY GOVERNMENT FUNDING RUNS OUT AGAIN. I would like to build it even faster, but its getting built" MEANWHILE, HOUSE SPEAKER NANCY PELOSI SAYING THE EXACT OPPOSITE, THAT WALL MONEY IS A NON-STARTER FOR A SOLUTION. PELOSI says: "There's not going to be any wall money in the legislation, we might need more ports of entry, some roads that's part of the negotiation." THE PRESIDENT'S AND HOUSE SPEAKER'S REMARKS CASTING DOUBT OVER WHETHER A BIPARTISAN COMPROMISE CAN BE REACHED BY FEBRUARY 15TH. ERNST says: "There should not be hardlines drawn by any one leader on what the direction of the conference committee should be." ON TWITTER, THE PRESIDENT SEEMINGLY DONE CALLING IT A FENCE, BARRIER, OR STEEL SLATS, URGING "LETS JUST CALL THEM WALLS FROM NOW ON", "A WALL IS A WALL". LANKFORD says: "At the end of the day the democrats who told us reopen the government for three weeks and then we'll make a deal on all this border security, if they were actually lying or not telling the truth at that time period that will be obvious to all the American people as well." PRESIDENT TRUMP SAYING HE THINKS THE NEGOTIATIONS ARE IN THE SAME PLACE, WHEN ASKED IF HE THOUGHT HE WAS CLOSER OR FARTHER AWAY FROM A DEAL SINCE THE GOVERNMENT REOPENED ABOUT A WEEK AGO.
2/4/19	7PM	VO	MORE THAN 10-THOUSAND MIGRANTS IN AT LEAST THREE CARAVANS CONTINUE PUSHING NORTH TO THE U.S. BORDER. SO FAR THE MEXICAN GOVERNMENT HAS PROVIDED A SIGNIFICANT AMOUNT OF AID FOR THESE MIGRANTS - INCLUDING FOOD, SHELTER, AND MEDICINE. THAT'S EXPECTED TO CONTINUE WHEN THEY REACH THE BORDER. THE CARAVAN'S MOVEMENT COMES JUST DAYS AFTER THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION ANNOUNCED NEARLY 4-THOUSAND MORE TROOPS WERE HEADING TO THE BORDER.

THE PASSENGER IN THE TRUCK WAS ARRESTED BY MEXICAN AUTHORITIES. THE BORDER PATROL AGENT WAS NOT HURT. THE BORDER HAS BEEN REOPENED.
2/7/19	7PM	VO	AS THE GRIDLOCK OVER THE BORDER WALL GRINDS ON ON CAPITOL HILL, OPPONENTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S IMMIGRATION POLICIES ARE PUSHING BACK IN NEW WAYS. NEW MEXICO'S DEMOCRATIC GOVERNOR IS ORDERING THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE STATE'S NATIONAL GUARD TROOPS FROM THE SOUTHERN BORDER...SAYING THERE'S NO CRISIS. MEANWHILE, THE WHITE HOUSE IS DEALING WITH MULTIPLE CHALLENGES TO THE PROPOSED ROUTE OF THE BORDER WALL...INCLUDING FROM SOME PEOPLE WHO SAY THEY COULD LOSE THEIR HOMES. THIS AS WE'RE LESS THAN A WEEK AWAY FROM THE DEADLINE. IT'S BEEN 17 DAYS SINCE THE NATION'S LONGEST PARTIAL GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN CAME TO AN END. OVER THE WEEKEND TALKS STALLED, REPORTEDLY OVER A DISPUTE TO CAP THE NUMBER OF IMMIGRANTS FEDERAL AGENTS CAN CATCH IN THE UNITED STATES. 2/12/19	7PM	PKG	AFTER YEARS OF EVADING AUTHORITIES, INFAMOUS MEXICAN DRUG LORD JOAQUIN "EL CHAPO" GUZMAN WILL NOW SPEND THE REST OF HIS LIFE IN PRISON. TODAY A JURY FOUND HIM GUILTY ON ALL TEN COUNTS. MENENDEZ says "Today we say, American Justice has been served." NOTORIOUS MEXICAN DRUG LORD, JOAQUIN "EL CHAPO" GUZMAN -- GUILTY ON ALL COUNTS. THE JURY ANNOUNCING THEIR DECISION TUESDAY IN A FEDERAL COURTHOUSE IN BROOKLYN. SIXTY-ONE-YEAR-OLD GUZMAN STARING AT JURORS, SHOWING NO EMOTION, AS ALL TEN GUILTY COUNTS WERE READ. THE JURY FINDING THAT "EL CHAPO" WAS IN FACT THE LEADER OF THE SINALOA CARTEL WITH EVIDENCE SHOWING THAT UNDER HIS DIRECTION, DRUGS LIKE COCAINE, METH, AND HEROIN POURED INTO THE UNITED STATES FOR MORE THAN TWO DECADES. OVER THE COURSE OF NEARLY THREE MONTHS, JURORS HEARD FROM FIFTY-SIX WITNESSES WITH SOME OF GUZMAN'S CLOSEST ASSOCIATES HANDING OVER INCRIMINATING TEXT MESSAGES AND PHONE CALLS. IN A POWERFUL EYE WITNESS ACCOUNT, GUZMAN'S FORMER BODYGUARD TESTIFYING THAT HE SAW THE DRUG LORD KILL THREE PEOPLE, SHOOTING TWO IN THE HEAD AND SHOOTING ONE WHILE BEING BURIED ALIVE. GUZMAN'S DEFENSE TEAM SAYING THAT WHILE THEY FOUGHT HARD, IT WAS DIFFICULT TO FIGHT THE OVERWHELMING EVIDENCE PRESENTED IN THIS CASE. LICHTMAN says "The fight is not over. We'll continue to fight for Joaquin Guzman till our last breaths." GUZMAN, WHO MANAGED TO EVADE AUTHORITIES FOR YEARS, EVEN BREAKING OUT OF MEXICAN PRISONS TWICE WILL NOW SPEND THE REST OF HIS LIFE BEHIND BARS. DONAHUE says "It is a sentence from which there is no escape and no return." GUZMAN IS SET TO BE SENTENCED ON JUNE TWENTY-FIFTH.
2/19/19	7PM	VO	MORE THAN A DOZEN STATES ARE NOW SUING IN AN ATTEMPT TO BLOCK PRESIDENT TRUMP'S PLAN TO BUILD A BORDER WALL. THE LEGAL CHALLENGES CLAIM THE PRESIDENT'S DECISION TO DECLARE A NATIONAL EMERGENCY, UNCONSTITUTIONAL. THE EMERGENCY DECLARATION, ISSUED ON FRIDAY, COULD FREE UP TO 8- BILLION DOLLARS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A BORDER WALL. PRESIDENT DONALD TRUMP SAYING HE WILL OVERCOME THE LAWSUIT, TWEETING OUT THAT HE HAD AN ABSOLUTE RIGHT TO MAKE THE DECLARATION.

HE IS ACCUSED OF TRANSPORTING NEARLY 254 POUNDS OF THE SYNTHETIC DRUG INTO THE UNITED STATES. THE CENTER OF DISEASE CONTROL SAYS FENTANYL IS NOW THE DRUG MOST OFTEN INVOLVED IN FATAL OVERDOSES IN THE UNITED STATES. AGENTS ALSO SAY THEY FOUND 400 POUNDS METH IN THE TRUCK.
3/6/19	7PM	VO30T	ACCORDING TO THE LATEST FROM BORDER OFFICIALS, COMPARED WITH LAST YEAR, THE NUMBER OF MIGRANTS CROSSING THE U-S-MEXICO BORDER IN FEBRUARY MORE THAN DOUBLED. DEMOCRATS SAY IT'S A HUMANITARIAN CRISIS, BUT, THE ADMINISTRATION SAYS IT SHOWS THE U-S HAS A NATIONAL EMERGENCY. IN HER TESTIMONY BEFORE THE HOUSE HOMELAND SECURITY COMMITTEE, SECRETARY KIRSTJEN NIELSEN DEFENDED THE PRESIDENT'S EMERGENCY DECLARATION ALONG THE SOUTHERN BORDER, TELLING LAWMAKERS THE U-S IS ON TRACK TO APPREHEND ONE MILLION ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS ATTEMPTING TO ENTER THE COUNTRY THIS YEAR. THERE WERE MORE THAN 66-THOUSAND IN FEBRUARY, THAT'S UP MORE THAN 18-PERCENT COMPARED TO ONE MONTH BEFORE. STILL, DEMOCRATS ARE EXPRESSING SKEPTICISM, QUESTIONING WHETHER AN EMERGENCY TRULY EXISTS, AND WHETHER THE PRESIDENT'S JUSTIFICATION FOR BORDER WALL FUNDS IS APPROPRIATE. THOMPSON says "Real border security cannot be achieved by building a wall on the Southern Border." THE BILL TO BLOCK THE PRESIDENT'S EMERGENCY DECLARATION PASSED THE HOUSE LAST WEEK, AND IS EXPECTED TO PASS THE SENATE NEXT WEEK. STILL, THE PRESIDENT WILL ALMOST CERTAINLY VETO THE MEASURE, LEAVING IT TO THE COURTS TO DECIDE.
3/18/19	7PM	VO30T	THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION DEFENDS THE PRESIDENT'S NATIONAL EMERGENCY AS THE HOMELAND SECURITY SECRETARY SAYS HER VISION IS IN LINE WITH PRESIDENT TRUMP'S PLAN FOR A SOUTHERN BORDER WALL. HOMELAND SECURITY SECRETARY KIRSTJEN NIELSEN LAID OUT HER VISION IN HER ANNUAL "STATE OF HOMELAND SECURITY ADDRESS. NIELSEN SAID BORDER AGENTS STOPPED 75 THOUSAND MIGRANTS FROM CROSSING ILLEGALLY INTO THE U.S. LAST MONTH. THAT FIGURE IS EXPECTED TO CLIMB TO NEARLY 100 THOUSAND THIS MONTH. BUT SHE'S CALLING ON CONGRESS TO DO MORE TO STOP ILLEGAL IMMIGRATION. KIRSTJEN NIELSEN HOMELAND SECURITY SECRETARY: "The situation at our Southern Border has gone from a crisis to a national emergency to a near system wide meltdown. I say this with the utmost sincerity and urgency. The system is breaking and our communities, our law enforcement personnel and the migrants themselves are paying the price." LAST FRIDAY, THE PRESIDENT VETOED A BILL TO CANCEL HIS NATIONAL EMERGENCY DECLARATION. THE HOUSE IS EXPECTED TO VOTE NEXT WEEK TO TRY TO OVERRIDE THAT VETO.

TOTALING SEVEN-POINT-FIVE MILLION DOLLARS AT 35 SCHOOL DISTRICTS AND CHARTER SCHOOLS. IT'S THE LATEST ROUND OF FUNDING AS A PART OF A 38 MILLION DOLLAR PLAN TO PROVIDE LOW-INCOME SCHOOLS WITH NEW BUSES.
2/11/19	7PM	VO	CHANDLER POLICE DEPARTMENT AND FIRE DEPARTMENT HELD A JOINT TRAINING EXERCISE AT THE CHANDLER PUBLIC SAFETY TRAINING FACILITY TO PREPARE FOR SCHOOL SHOOTING SITUATIONS. 2/11/19	7PM	PKG	A 16-YEAR-OLD STUDENT AT NOTRE DAME PREP IN SCOTTSDALE HAS BEEN ARRESTED ACCUSED OF GIVING A PILL LACED WITH FENTANYL TO A 17-YEAR-OLD. THAT TEEN APPARENTLY OVERDOSED ON THE DRUG. TONIGHT, PARENTS ARE CONCERNED OTHER STUDENTS IN NORTH SCOTTSDALE MAY HAVE OBTAINED SIMILAR PILLS.
2/14/19	7PM	PKG	THE PARKLAND MASSACRE ALSO SPURRED STUDENT ACTIVISM HERE IN ARIZONA. HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS FROM AROUND THE STATE FORMED A "MARCH FOR OUR LIVES" PHOENIX CHAPTER. AND ON THIS ONE YEAR ANNIVERSARY, INSTEAD OF PROTESTS, THEIR MESSAGE IS BEING DRIVEN THROUGH A NEW BILL MAKING ITS WAY THROUGH THE STATE LEGISLATURE. THEY'RE ALSO HOLDING THEIR OWN VIGIL TONIGHT.
