Length 58 minutes

Description Emily Colson explains how her view of God has changed, through years of struggling to raise an autistic son as a single parent. She describes painful situations she's encountered in public, where people have been rude or hostile to Max because he is not acting normally. She says "God doesn't want Max to be 'normal', He wants him to be more like Jesus."

Title Helping Your Daughter Embrace Her Inner Beauty

Length 25 minutes

Description As a girl and young woman, Scarlet Hiltibidal struggled with feeling beautiful, accepted and loved. Her mom was a well-known actress with lots of admirers; Scarlet felt plain by comparison. In this interview, she shares stories from her teen years such as her dad finding her "hottie" list where she identified cute boys at school, and the time she bought a dog tag so she could be like another girl she admired. She also shares about her eating disorder in college and how she realized she needed to confess what was going on in order to experience God's healing. In this interview, Scarlet will help educate parents about the beauty- and body-obsessed mindset that many teen girls adopt. She'll give insights and advice to parents on how to help their daughters counter negativity and know their identity in Christ.

On the other side of it, Bruce and Serena now share their story—the pain they walked through together and individually, as well as the grace Serena discovered in both Bruce and Jesus.
