The mumble strips will be installed on the roads' centerlines. The half-million-dollar project is expected to take about two weeks.

I-94 Traffic Shift

07-14-17

Motorists on Interstate 94 between Evansville and Garfield will encounter a traffic shift that began today, as crews begin resurfacing the eastbound lanes and the re-decking of two bridges. Traffic will be reduced to a single lane in each direction using the current westbound lanes.

Full access to the Evansville, Brandon and Garfield ramps will be maintained using temporary crossovers. However, some ramps will close for a short time once paving work begins later this summer. The speed limit has been reduced to 60 mph in the work zone.

The overall project includes resurfacing both directions of I-94 between Highway 79 and Highway 114 bridges. The work will run through 2018.

Motor Vehicle Services Statewide Closing For Upgrade

All statewide Motor Vehicle Offices, including Otter Tail County will be closed starting today. The closure is related to a system upgrade and services not available include vehicle registration, renewal of tabs, as well as license plates. However, Driver's License, DNR & Fish and Game transactions will still be processed.

Offices statewide will reopen on Tuesday July 25th. The closing is due to the transition to "MNLARS" in coordination with the State of Minnesota. MNLARS will replace the core functionality for DVS operations. When finished, it will be a Web-based system for driver's license, identification card and vehicle registration and ownership transactions. The closure this week is related to the motor vehicle portion while the implementation of the driver's license portions of MNLARS is planned for 2018.

Garfield Highway 114 Closures

07-26-17

Overnight closures of Highway 114 at Interstate 94 south of Garfield are scheduled to start Monday.

The highway closures are necessary so crews can remove the eastbound Interstate 94 bridge deck over the roadway. Highway 114 will close each night at 9 pm and reopen by 6 am the next day. The work is expected to take about one week.

Detours will direct traffic around the closure. The interstate ramps at Highway 114 and I-94 will remain open.

The work is part of the I-94 resurfacing and bridge deck replacement project underway between the Evansville and Garfield exits of I-94.

Becker/Otter Tail Highway Work

08-21-17

Motorists on Highway 34 east of Detroit Lakes and Highway 87 east of Frazee will face delays and a detour when culvert work begins this week and next week.

Crews will replace two culverts on Highway 34 – one near Snellman and one near Osage this week. The work on Highway 34 will require lane closures and motorists may encounter intermittent delays where crews are working.

When work moves to Highway 87 the week of August 28th, traffic will be detoured east of Frazee. Signs will direct traffic to Highway 10, County Road 60 and County Roads 51 and 33. The detour is scheduled to be removed prior to the Labor Day weekend. A second culvert on Highway 87 near Evergreen will be replaced with lane closures.

The culvert work will result in improved drainage along Highways 34 and 87.

State Highway 225 becomes Becker County Highway 26

08/30/17

The ownership of Minnesota Highway 225 from Osage to Ponsford will transfer from the Minnesota Department of Transportation to Becker County ~~on September 1st~~ ^{today}. The road ~~will then~~ ^{is now} be known as Becker County State Aid Highway 26.

Turnback funds in the amount of \$9.5 million will be provided to Becker County to improve the roadway. Becker County has been planning a series of improvements to the road over the next several years.

Signs along the route are scheduled to be changed during the month of September, and maintenance responsibility will shift to the county.

Highway 225 is one of several roadways that MnDOT is working to transfer to a proper level of government.

In 2012, MnDOT completed a jurisdictional realignment study to ensure roads are owned and maintained at the correct level of government. For example, a higher volume county road that serves regional connections may become a state highway. Lower volume state highways that serve primarily local connections may be transferred to the county.

Painting Signal Light Poles

The yellow and green traditional colors have been replaced with the color black. Taylor says he had seen black colored poles in other communities and thought they looked sharp. He says city crews made an exception at the intersection of Friberg Avenue and North Aurdal Avenue, next to the Kennedy School...

Vernon Avenue Construction

Central Specialties of Alexandria has been hired to do the Vernon Avenue street resurfacing project in Fergus Falls. Resurfacing will be located between Cascade Street and Arlington Avenue.

Part of the work will require improvements to the concrete walks by installing new ADA compliant pedestrian ramps which will be located on both sides of the street. This work will likely start still this week. Traffic will be maintained during this work, but traffic control devices will be installed near the driving lanes.

Once the concrete improvements are completed, Central Specialties will then install the planned traffic detour prior to starting the resurfacing work. The resurfacing work is scheduled to start the last week of September.

Substantial completion for all work is scheduled for this fall.

The Fergus Falls Fire Department was busy Friday afternoon after a contractor working on the Vernon Avenue resurfacing project struck a Great Plains Natural Gas line, causing a leak.

The gas line was struck shortly after the noon hour. A worker using a saw was cutting into concrete when the incident began. Workers had trouble shutting down the line. Traffic was shut down from Burlington to Sheridan until about 4:00 pm.

There were no evacuations. The fire department checked homes in the area of the break, the corner of Arlington and Vernon, and determined that gas had not entered any homes, so residents were allowed to stay in their homes.
