Quarter 4: LIVE REMOTES

Live remote for Celebrate Ludlow in Ludlow, MA. Promoted Ludlow business and non-profits especially those that are available to residents to ensure they know what services are available for them.

Live remote for Three Rivers Fall Festival in Three Rivers promoting the community and the local events entering this fall and holiday season. (October 1)

Live remote for veteran food collection in Ludlow, MA supporting the Sgt Desforges VFW. (November 1)

Valley's Classic Hits partnered with local Palmer Food Share to host a food drive in the parking lot. We broadcast live with our station partners and collected food and non-perishable items for the local food pantry (November 5)

Annual participation in the Coats for Kids organized by the Ware Knights of Columbus and held at Nat Falk's Clothing. Ongoing event with one day remote where people can bring coats that are turned over the local schools. (November 12)

Quarter 4: New events

We provided ongoing holiday music for the Ware Flair Christmas lighting tour. It is a drive-through event and people tune their radios to the station which plays uninterrupted holiday music for the two hours of the event.

High School football season began concluded during this quarter. The games are sponsored locally and are available on Podcast for later broadcast.

High School basketball season began with the plan to provide on air coverage for 16 local games. This December we also began broadcasting Springfield International Charter School basketball games in addition to our local listening area games.

Hardwick, MA town administrator Nicole Parker joined our Town Manager Segment feature.

Quarter 4: Ongoing: We continue our partnership with Western MA News to provide updates and headlines. These air 4x's a day at 4, 5, 6 and 7 PM.

Randalls, a local farm in Ludlow calls in a 5-minute weekly feature on Friday that highlights items of the season as well as growing, harvesting, and farming information. This feature previews the weekly show which airs on Friday for one hour.

We began a new weekly show targeting local veterans and benefits available to them. The Western Mass Veterans Radio Show airs on Saturday mornings and features two local veteran agents as well as featured veterans who discuss benefits and solutions for our local veterans.
