Oct 4 Carried an interview, at 8:30 for 30 minutes with author, Janel Breitenstein about developing disciplines and life skills in our children.

Oct 8 Ran a 30 minute conversation at 9:30 with Shaunti Feldhahn about breast cancer awareness and treatment.

Oct 21 Broadcast a discussion at 9:30 for 25 minutes with Jennifer Cisney-Ellers, a professional counselor and crisis response trainer, about the mental health of young people, and how parents can consider strategies that can address adolescent suicide.

Oct 25 We aired an interview with David Kinnaman, Mark Matlock at 8:30 for 25 minutes about technology, and how parents can help their children navigate the problems that can come from being constantly online and potential bullying.

Oct 30 At 8:30 we ran a discussion for 30 minutes with Hayley DiMarco and Philip Holmes about becoming debt free and setting up a plan to work towards financial freedom.

Nov 8 Carried an hour long discussion at 9:30 with Dr. Shannae Anderson about domestic violence and how to overcome the helplessness and powerlessness that the victim feels at the hands of their abuser is often unspeakable terror. Dr. Anderson revealed the means necessary for a survivor to regain their voice and feel safe again.

Nov 16 Broadcast a call in show at 6:00 for 30 minutes where listeners could call in and ask financial questions to a panel of experts

Dec 11 We interviewed representatives from the University Hospital Health Care Foundation, at 5:00 for 30 minutes, Laurie Ott and Daniel Wager about the additional care their Chaplains offer patients and families and how other communities can participate in these services
