1) GOVERNMENT

4/5/16 5:00PM (25 SECONDS) TODAY THE GOVERNOR OF MISSISSIPPI SIGNED A LAW THAT ALLOWS EMPLOYERS TO REFUSE SERVICE TO SAME-SEX COUPLES BASED ON THE EMPLOYER'S RELIGIOUS BELIEFS. GOVERNOR BRYANT SIGNED THE BILL DESPITE OPPOSITION FROM GAY-RIGHTS GROUPS AND SOME BUSINESSES. THE MEASURE'S INTENTION IS TO PROTECT THOSE WHO BELIEVE THAT MARRIAGE SHOULD BE BETWEEN ONE MAN AND ONE WOMAN. BUT GOVERNMENT AGENCIES STILL HAVE TO PROVIDE SERVICES. OTHER STATES HAVE CONSIDERED SIMILAR LEGISLATION.

4/13/16 5:00PM (20 SECONDS) ELECTION DAY IS DRAWING NEAR IN THE NORFOLK MAYOR'S RACE. THAT'S WHY YOU FIND ALL THREE CANDIDATES TOGETHER TONIGHT AT THE TED CONSTANT CENTER AT O-D-U. THE SCHOOL GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IS HOSTING THE OPEN FORUM FOR STATE SENATOR KENNY ALEXANDER, NORFOLK SHERIFF BOB MCCABE, AND CITY COUNCILMAN ANDY PROTOGYROU. IT STARTS AT 7.

4/18/16 5:00PM (15 SECONDS) DEFENSE SECRETARY ASH CARTER SAYS MORE TROOPS ARE HEADED TO IRAQ. MORE THAN 200 ADDITIONAL FORCES ARE HEADED OVERSEAS TO HELP THAT STRUGGLING GOVERNMENT FIGHT ISIS. MOST WILL BE ARMY

SPECIAL FORCES. THE REMAINDER WILL INCLUDE SOME TRAINERS, SECURITY FORCES FOR THE ADVISERS AND MAINTENANCE TEAMS.

4/21/16 5:30PM (20 SECONDS) LEADERS IN ECUADOR SAY THEY WILL TEMPORARILY RAISE TAXES, SELL ASSETS AND MAY ISSUE NEW BONDS TO PAY FOR EARTHQUAKE RECONSTRUCTION. THE DEATH TOLL FROM THIS WEEKEND'S QUAKE IS NEARING 600. LEADERS SAY THE DISASTER HAS COST BETWEEN \$2 AND \$3 BILLION DOLLARS. THE GOVERNMENTS OF COLOMBIA AND VENEZEULA HAVE SENT RESCUE WORKERS AND MUCH-NEEDED SUPPLIES TO ITS NEIGHBOR.

4/25/16 5:00PM (25 SECONDS) RESCUE PERSONNEL FOUND ANOTHER BODY IN THE POST-QUAKE RUBBLE IN SOUTHWESTERN JAPAN TODAY. ONE PERSON REMAINS MISSING. THE GOVERNMENT DESIGNATED THE EARTHQUAKES IN SOUTHWESTERN JAPAN A DISASTER OF EXTREME SEVERITY. THE FIRST MASSIVE QUAKE STRUCK APRIL 14TH. THE MOVE CLEARS THE WAY FOR ADDITIONAL GOVERNMENT FUNDING. THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT CAN NOW SUBSIDIZE UP TO 90 PERCENT OF REBUILDING COSTS.

4/25/16 5:00PM (35 SECONDS) THERE IS STRONG EVIDENCE THAT MEXICAN POLICE TORTURED SOME OF THE KEY SUSPECTS ARRESTED IN THE DISAPPEARANCE OF 43 STUDENTS --ACCORDING TO A REPORT RELEASED YESTERDAY BY AN OUTSIDE GROUP OF EXPERTS. A STUDY OF 17 OF THE APPROXIMATELY 123 SUSPECTS ARRESTED IN THE CASE SHOWED SIGNS OF BEATINGS. THE MEXICAN GOVERNMENT RECENTLY RELEASED DOCUMENTS SUGGESTING INVESTIGATIONS HAD BEEN OPENED AGAINST POLICE AND MILITARY PERSONNEL, BUT NO WORD YET ON ARRESTS OR CHARGES. THE 43 STUDENTS AT THE RADICAL TEACHERS' COLLEGE OF AYOTZINAPA (EYE-YO-TEE-NAH-PAH) HAVE NOT BEEN HEARD FROM SINCE THEY WERE TAKEN BY LOCAL POLICE IN SEPTEMBER 2014.

4/28/16 5:00PM (20 SECONDS) YOU CAN ASK CANDIDATES FOR HAMPTON CITY GOVERNMENT QUESTIONS ABOUT HOW THEY WOULD SERVE AT 6:00 IN CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS. THE ASK THE CANDIDATE FORUM IS SPONSORED BY THE SOUTHERN CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE. YOU WILL GET A CHANCE TO HEAR FROM THE CANDIDATES RUNNING FOR SCHOOL BOARD FIRST, THEN HOPEFULS FOR MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL WILL TAKE THE STAGE

4/29/16 5:00PM (35 SECONDS) PET OWNERS, YOU KNOW THE COST OF MEDICATIONS FOR YOUR FOUR LEGGED LOVED ONES CAN BE EXPENSIVE. A CONGRESSIONAL SUBCOMMITTEE DISCUSSED THE COST OF PET MEDS, AND WHETHER THE GOVERNMENT SHOULD GET INVOLVED. THE FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION SAYS MANY DON'T REALIZE THEY CAN GET THEIR PRESCRIPTIONS SOMEWHERE OTHER THAN THE VET. THAT COULD REDUCE COSTS. ALSO, MAKING GENERICS MORE WIDELY AVAILABLE MIGHT MAKE PET MEDICATIONS MORE AFFORDABLE. SOME MANUFACTURERS AND VETS WORRY THOSE MEASURES COULD CUT INTO A VET'S PROFITS FORCING THEM TO RAISE PRICES ON CARE TO MAKE UP THE DIFFERENCE.

5/3/16 11:00PM (25 SECONDS) BIG CHANGES IN NORFOLK TONIGHT - MAYOR ELECT KENNY ALEXANDER WRAPPED UP HIS VICTORY PARTY, A SHORT TIME AGO. THERE WAS ALSO AN UPSET ON CITY COUNCIL. LONG TIME COUNCILMAN BARCLAY WINN LOST HIS RE-ELECTION BID TO ANDRIA MCCLELLAN. MCCLELLAN CELEBRATED WITH HER SUPPORTERS TONIGHT AT MJ'S TAVERN. SHE SAYS SHE'S HUMBLED TO REPRESENT SUPERWARD SIX, AND SHE RAN ON A PLATFORM OF TRANSPARENCY IN GOVERNMENT.

5/3/16 11:00PM (75 SECONDS) 10 ON YOUR SIDE'S ANDY FOX JOINS US NOW TO DEBRIEF ON THIS HISTORIC ELECTION. ANDY, KENNY ALEXANDER HAS SOME BIG SHOES TO FILL AS NORFOLK'S NEXT MAYOR. HE WILL HAVE A LOT OF ISSUES TO DEAL WITH. POVERTY, SPREADING THE WEALTH OUTSIDE OF DOWNTOWN, TRANSPARENCY IN GOVERNMENT, ACCOUNTABILITY, EDUCATION. ANDY WHERE DID ALEXANDER WIN THIS RACE EXCEPT IN

OUR FRIEND CHARLIE HARTIG WHO WAS WITH US ALL NIGHT THOUGHT IT WAS A THROW BACK AGAINST PAUL FRAIM. COULD BE, BUT WHAT WE KNOW IS BARKLEY WINN WAS OUT HUSTLED. I'M TOLD ANDRIA MCCLELLAN WHO DESCRIBES HERSELF AS A COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER HAD THE BEST GRASS ROOTS CAMPAIGN OF ALL CANDIDATES. AUDIO RECORDINGS FROM HIS ARTICLE 32 HEARING, SHOW HE'S ACCUSED OF SPILLING SECRETS TO A PROSTITUTE IN HAWAII LAST YEAR. THE GOVERNMENT SAYS THEY FOUND EMAILS AND A NOTEBOOK WITH CLASSIFIED INFORMATION WHILE SEARCHING HIS HOME. THE GOVERNMENT SAYS LIN HAS ADMITTED TO ALL CHARGES ON THOSE TAPES. BUT HIS DEFENSE SAYS THEY PLAN TO ARGUE INVESTIGATORS SEARCHED HIS HOME ILLEGALLY - ALONG WITH OTHER MISSTEPS. THIS CASE IS STILL IN THE HANDS OF THE HEAD OF FLEET FORCES, AND LIN IS IN THE BRIG.

5/9/16 11:00PM (30 SECONDS) NORTH CAROLINA AND THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT HAVE DRAWN THEIR LEGAL BATTLE LINES OVER H-B-2. BOTH SIDES ARE SUING THE OTHER OVER THE CONTROVERSIAL BILL. WE'VE BEEN TELLING YOU ABOUT H-B-2 SINCE GOVERNOR PAT MCCRORY SIGNED IT RECENTLY. IT FORCES TRANSGENDERED PEOPLE TO USE THE RESTROOM BASED OFF THEIR BIRTH CERTIFICATES, NOT WHAT MAKES THEM FEEL MOST COMFORTABLE. MCCRORY FILED A LAWSUIT AFTER THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT TOLD NORTH CAROLINA TO ABANDON THE LAW. THEN THE FEDS FILED THEIR OWN -- SAYING H-B-2 VIOLATES THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT.

5/17/16 11:00PM (25 SECONDS) A NAVY LIEUTENANT CHARGED WITH SPYING PLEADED NOT GUILTY TODAY. EDWARD LIN FACED A JUDGE AND REQUESTED A TRIAL BY JURY. INVESTIGATORS BELIEVE HE GAVE CLASSIFIED INFORMATION TO A FOREIGN GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVE AT LEAST TWICE OVER THE YEARS. 10 ON YOUR SIDE LEARNED HE LIKELY SPIED FOR TAIWAN, WHERE HE WAS BORN. THE GOVERNMENT SAYS LIN CONFESSED TO EVERYTHING, BUT HIS DEFENSE SAYS THE CONFESSIONS WERE COERCED. HE'LL BE BACK IN COURT NEXT MONTH.

5/20/16 11:00PM (30 SECONDS) THE NATIONAL COALITION AGAINST CENSORSHIP IS GETTING INVOLVED -- JUST ONE DAY BEFORE CONTROVERSIAL ART IS SET TO DEBUT IN VIRGINIA BEACH. WE'VE BEEN TELLING YOU ABOUT THE PAINTINGS OF MARK RYDEN, WHICH WILL APPEAR AT THE MUSEUM OF CONTEMPORARY ART STARTING TOMORROW. SOME FIND THE WORKS OFFENSIVE, AND TWO MEMBERS OF THE VIRGINIA BEACH ARTS AND HUMANITIES COMMISSION RAISED CONCERNS ABOUT USING TAX DOLLARS TO FUND THE SHOW. TODAY THE COALITION SAID GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS CANNOT USE FINANCIAL LEVERAGE AS A THREAT TO SILENCE THOSE WITH WHOM THEY DISAGREE.

5/23/16 12:00PM (15 SECONDS) DURING THE COLD WAR, THE GOVERNMENT HAD A NUMBER OF SECRET BUNKERS ACROSS THE STATE OF WASHINGTON FOR THE GOVERNOR AND OTHER TOP OFFICIALS TO TAKE COVER IN AND SURVIVE. SEVERAL ARE IN WHAT ARE

NOW WASHINGTON STATE PARKS. THEY'RE CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC, BUT DREW MIKKELSEN GIVES US AN INSIDE LOOK.

5/25/16 12:00PM (35 SECONDS) ANTI-GOVERNMENT PROTESTS ARE GOING ON RIGHT NOW IN BRUSSELS. EARLIER TODAY, SOMEONE ASSAULTED THE CITY'S POLICE CHIEF AS HE TRIED TO MAKE THE PROTESTERS STOP WHAT THEY WERE DOING. THE ASSAULT WAS CAUGHT ON CAMERA. WE HAVE TO WARN YOU, THIS MAY BE HARD TO WATCH. HERE YOU CAN SEE CHIEF PIERRE VANDERMISSEN CHASING DOWN PROTESTERS AND USING PEPPER SPRAY. ALL OF A SUDDEN, YOU SEE SOMEONE RUN UP TO HIM AND SMASH A ROCK INTO HIS HEAD. YOU CAN SEE THE HIT INSTANTLY KNOCKED THE CHIEF OUT. PARAMEDICS TOOK HIM TO THE HOSPITAL AND HE IS RECOVERING FROM THE INJURY. PEOPLE ARE PROTESTING IN BRUSSELS BECAUSE OF LOST PENSIONS AND CUTS TO WORKERS BENEFITS.

6/6/16 12:00PM (25 SECONDS) THE NORFOLK-BASED U-S-S HARRY S TRUMAN IS NOW EVEN CLOSER TO IT'S ISIS TARGETS. IT MOVED FROM THE PERSIAN GULF TO A BETTER POSITION IN THE MEDITERRANEAN SEA. THE U-S GOVERNMENT SAYS THE AIR STRIKES ARE HAVING A MAJOR EFFECT. THE JETS FROM THE TRUMAN ARE NOT ONLY HITTING ISIS POSITIONS, THEY'RE ALSO SENDING SUPPLIES. THE NAVY EXTENDED THE CARRIER'S TOUR BY A MONTH - THE MEN AND WOMEN ABOARD SAY THEY'RE STILL GOING STRONG.

6/8/16 12:00PM (30 SECONDS) VIOLENCE AT A STUDENT PROTEST IN PAPUA NEW GUINEA. POLICE STARTED SHOOTING DURING THE DEMONSTRATION. FOUR PEOPLE DIED AND ABOUT A DOZEN OTHERS WERE HURT. PEOPLE IN PORT MORESBY SAY POLICE FIRED BULLETS AND USED TEAR GAS TO STOP A GOVERNMENT PROTEST AT PAPUA NEW GUINEA UNIVERSITY. THESE PICTURES SHOW A HEAVILY-ARMED OFFICERS HOLDING THEIR GUNS. THOUSANDS OF STUDENTS HAVE BEEN PROTESTING THE GOVERNMENT AND SKIPPING CLASS FOR WEEKS. PAPUA NEW GUINEA STRUGGLES WITH VIOLENCE AND POVERTY, DESPITE HAVING A LOT OF RESOURCES.

6/16/16 12:00PM (35 SECONDS) HEAVY RAINS, HAIL AND WINDSTORMS HIT NORTHERN ITALY - CREATING A LOT OF DAMAGE. THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT WILL DECLARE A STATE OF NATURAL DISASTER FOR THE AREA HIT BY SEVERE WEATHER IN THE PAST FEW DAYS. HAIL, RAIN, FLOODING, LANDSLIDES AND WIND HAVE CREATED EXTENSIVE DAMAGE IN THE WINE, HORTICULTURAL, FRUIT, AND HONEY SECTORS, BUT ALSO IN CORN AND FORAGE PLANTATIONS. A 57-YEAR-OLD WOMAN DIED AFTER BEING HIT BY A TREE THAT FELL DUE TO THE HEAVY RAINS AND STRONG WINDS IN THE AREA. THE FLOODING OF RIVERS AND STREAMS AND DOZENS OF LANDSLIDES HAVE CAUSED INTERRUPTIONS IN SECONDARY RAILWAY LINES IN MOST OF LUMBARDY.

6/16/16 12:00PM (30 SECONDS) OVERNIGHT, DEMOCRATIC LAWMAKERS ENDED A NEARLY 15 HOUR FILIBUSTER ON A COMPROMISE. REPUBLICAN LEADERS HAVE REPORTEDLY AGREED TO ALLOW VOTES ON UNIVERSAL BACKGROUND CHECKS AND A BAN TO STOP PEOPLE ON THE GOVERNMENT'S TERRORIST WATCH LIST FROM GETTING GUN LICENSES. 40 SENATORS, INCLUDING TWO REPUBLICANS JOINED THE FILIBUSTER EFFORT. TAKE A LISTEN TO VIRGINIA'S SENATOR TIM KAINE REMARKS.

6/20/16 12:00PM (20 SECONDS) AFGHAN GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS SAY A SUICIDE BOMBER KILLED 14 PEOPLE. IT HAPPENED EARLIER TODAY IN KABUL. A POLICE OFFICIAL SAYS ALL OF THE VICTIMS ARE FROM NEPALE. EIGHT OTHER PEOPLE WERE HURT IN THE BOMBING. A TALIBAN SPOKESPERSON SAYS IT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ATTACK. THE TALIBAN HAS STARTED MORE ATTACKS ON GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES AND AFGHAN SECURITY FORCES RECENTLY.

6/24/16 12:00PM (25 SECONDS) BRITAIN'S VOTE TO LEAVE THE EUROPEAN UNION FOLLOWED A BITTER REFERENDUM CAMPAIGN. THE VOTE HAS TOPPLED THE GOVERNMENT - SENDING GLOBAL MARKETS PLUNGING AND BRITAIN'S PRIME MINISTER RESIGNING. THE

RESULT WAS A SHOCK RIGHT FROM THE START. NO ONE EXPECTED A WIN FOR THOSE CAMPAIGNING FOR BRITAIN TO LEAVE THE 28-MEMBER EUROPEAN UNION. THE VOTE - 52-48 PERCENT. BRITAIN IS NOW THE FIRST COUNTRY TO SAY 'THAT'S ENOUGH'.

6/28/16 12:00PM (25 SECONDS) A STUDENT IN INDIA IS SITTING IN JAIL FOR CHEATING ON A TEST. 17-YEAR-OLD RUBY RAI RANKED FIRST IN THE BIHAR STATE EXAMS BUT WAS CAUGHT CHEATING AFTER A VIRAL VIDEO EXPOSED HER LACK OF KNOWLEDGE IN HER STUDIES. RAI WAS RETESTED AND FAILED, ULTIMATELY CANCELING OUT HER ORIGINAL SCORES. SHE IS EXPECTED TO STAY IN JAIL UNTIL JULY 8TH. THE STATE GOVERNMENT SAYS THEY ARE WORKING ON TOUGH MEASURES LIKE FINES AND JAIL TERMS TO DETER STUDENTS FROM CHEATING IN THE FUTURE.

2) MILITARY

4/5/16 5:30PM (10 SECONDS) A RETIRED U-S MARINE CORPS DOG WHO LOST ONE OF HER LEGS WHILE PROTECTING ALLIED TROOPS IN IRAQ AND AFGHANISTAN WAS AWARDED A TOP MILITARY MEDAL TODAY.

4/11/16 5:30PM (30 SECONDS) THE U.S. MILITARY WANTS TROOPS TO STAY QUIET WHEN IT COMES TO POLITICS -- AND ITS PUTTING IT IN WRITING. THE JOINT CHIEFS OF STAFF WILL DRAFT A LETTER THIS WEEK REMINDING BOTH TROOPS AND HIGH-RAKING OFFICIALS TO REMAIN "**APOLITICAL.**" THE MILITARY TYPICALLY REMAINS NEUTRAL ON POLITICS SO LEADERS CAN GIVE THEIR BEST ADVICE TO THE PRESIDENT. TROOPS CANNOT ATTEND ANY POLITICAL EVENTS IN UNIFORM. BUT CAPTAIN GREGORY HICKS SAYS THAT POLICY IS TOUGHER TO ENFORCE DURING AN ELECTION YEAR.

4/14/16 5:30PM (25 SECONDS) THE U-S IS CONDUCTING JOINT PATROLS WITH THE PHILIPPINES IN THE SOUTH CHINA SEA. IT'S A RARE MOVE NOT DONE WITH MANY OTHER PARTNERS IN THE REGION. DEFENSE SECRETARY ASH CARTER MADE THE ANNOUNCEMENT IN MANILA TODAY. THE U-S ALSO PLANS TO KEEP NEARLY 300 TROOPS IN THE PHILIPPINES THROUGH THE END OF APRIL. THE U-S WILL BEGIN SENDING FORCES ON INCREASED ROTATIONS INTO THE PHILIPPINES - TO BEEF UP TRAINING AND TO SUPPORT INCREASED MILITARY OPERATIONS IN THE REGION.

4/14/16 6:00PM (35 SECONDS) WE HAVE A FOLLOW-UP TO A MULTI-MILLION DOLLAR LAWSUIT AGAINST LINCOLN MILITARY HOUSING... A FEDERAL JURY FINALLY REACHED A VERDICT. THE FAMILY CLAIMS THEY GOT SICK FROM MOLD WHILE LIVING IN NORFOLK. THE FIRST TRIAL ENDED IN A MISTRIAL IN JANUARY. BUT TODAY THE JURY FOUND LINCOLN MILITARY HOUSING NEGLIGENT, BUT AWARDED THE FAMILY FAR LESS THAN THE 8-MILLION DOLLARS THE ATTORNEY'S WANTED. THE LAWYERS FOR THE FAMILY OF MARINE GUNNERY SERGEANT JOE FREDERICO CLAIMED MOLD GAVE HIM PERMANENT BRAIN DAMAGE FROM MOLD EXPOSURE. THE JURY AWARDED THE FAMILY IN TOTAL, 350 THOUSAND DOLLARS. ATTORNEY'S FOR THE FREDERICO'S SAY ITS A MIXED FEELING FOR THEM.
