12/31/12 11:00pm (30 SECONDS) AS WE'RE COUNTING DOWN THE NEW YEAR HERE IN THE U-S - THE KABUL GOVERNMENT HAS ANOTHER REASON TO COUNT DOWN.THE HEAD OF THE AFGHANISTAN TRANSITION COMMISSION ANNOUNCED DETAILS TO THE NEXT PHASE OF TRANSFERRING POWER FROM THE U-S MILITARY TO FULL AFGHAN CONTROL.THE NEXT BIG MOVE WILL BEGIN IN TWO MONTHS.THE TRANSITION BEGAN IN EARLY 2011.IT WILL HELP PAVE THE WAY TO GIVE AFGHAN FORCES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR SECURITY BY THE END OF 2014.THAT'S WHEN MOST NATO FORCES - INCLUDING SOME 66-THOUSAND U-S TROOPS - ARE PLANNING TO PULL OUT.

1/1/13 6:00pm (40 SECONDS) BACK TO THAT BREAKING NEWS ON THE FISCAL CLIFF.RIGHT NOW - LEGISLATION TO BLOCK THE "FISCAL CLIFF" IS HEADED TO THE WHITE HOUSE FOR PRESIDENT BARACK OBAMA'S SIGNATURE.THE BILL WILL AVOID, FOR NOW, THE MAJOR TAX INCREASES AND GOVERNMENT SPENDING CUTS THAT HAD BEEN SCHEDULED TO TAKE EFFECT WITH THE NEW YEAR.THE VOTE WAS 257 TO 167.

ACCORDING TO THE F-B-I, THEY RECORDED 2-POINT-78 MILLION BACKGROUND CHECKS IN DECEMBER...AN INCREASE OF 39 PERCENT FROM NOVEMBER. THE F-B-I ALSO SAID DECEMBER TENDS TO BE THE BUSIEST MONTH FOR BACKGROUND CHECKS....MAINLY DUE TO HOLIDAY GIFT SALES. THE FIGURE DOES NOT REPRESENT THE NUMBER OF FIREARMS SOLD, SINCE THE GOVERNMENT DOES NOT DOES NOT TRACK THAT. FEDERAL LAW ONLY REQUIRES BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR SALES FROM COMMERCIAL VENDORS WITH A FEDERAL LICENSE.

1/9/13 5:00am (29 SECONDS) A POSSIBLE SOLUTION TO THE ALL OF THE COUNTRY'S FINANCIAL PROBLEMS. AND IT'S ONLY A LITTLE BIGGER THAN THE BUTTONS ON YOUR REMOTE CONTROL. WE'RE TALKING ABOUT A PLATINUM TRILLION DOLLAR COIN.THE IDEA SOUNDS SIMPLE ENOUGH. THE **DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION** SAYS: THE CARS ARE **SO QUIET** TRAVELING UNDER 18 MILES PER HOUR- THAT PEOPLE WALKING OR RIDING BIKES, AND THE VISUALLY IMPAIRED DON'T NOTICE THEM. JAPAN'S TWO BIGGEST CARRIERS, JAPAN AIRLINES AND ALL NIPPON AIRWAYS, GROUNDED THEIR 7-87S FOR SAFETY CHECKS --- AFTER ONE OF THE AIRCRAFTS WAS FORCED TO MAKE AN EMERGENCY LANDING. A BURNING SMELL WAS DETECTED IN THE COCKPIT AND THE CABIN. LAST WEEK --- ANOTHER 787 LEAKED FUEL IN TOKYO AFTER FLYING BACK FROM BOSTON. ALSO IN BOSTON --- A FIRE IGNITED IN A BATTERY PACK ON ANOTHER JAPAN AIRLINES 787 AS THE PLANE SAT ON THE TARMAC .

1/29/13 5:30am (30 SECONDS) A LOCAL LAWMAKER IS WORKING TO MAKE IT ILLEGAL TO SMOKE WITH KIDS IN THE CAR. 2/1/13 4:30am (40 SECONDS) TRANSPARENCY CONCERNS IN GUANTANAMO BAY TOP OUR MILITARY HEADLINES. A NEW ORDER FROM A U-S MILITARY JUDGE AIMS TO KEEP THE COURTS HONEST THROUGHOUT THE TRIAL OF THE ALLEGED MASTERMINDS BEHIND THE 9/11 ATTACKS. OFFICIALS BELIEVE THIS ALL STARTED AFTER AN ANNOUNCEMENT BY ITALY'S NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF GEOPHYSICS. FOLLOWING THE QUAKE--THE ORGANIZATION TOLD THE GOVERNMENT ABOUT A POSSIBILITY OF MORE TREMORS. WORD SOON SPREAD AMONG CIVILANS AS LOCAL OFFICIALS WENT DOOR TO DOOR WARNING PEOPLE.

2/4/13 12:00pm (30 SECONDS) THANKS TO AN AGREEMENT OVER THE WEEKEND, YOU MAY BE ABLE TO AFFORD THOSE SUMMERTIME FAVORITES. THERE HAD BEEN THREATS THE COST OF TOMATOES COULD DOUBLE TO AS MUCH AS \$5 A POUND IF THE US GOVERNMENT AND MEXICO COULDN'T REACH A DEAL. THE STICKING POINT: CROP PRICES. AMERICAN GROWERS CLAIMED MEXICAN FARMERS WERE PRICING THEM OUT OF THE MARKET, CHARGING SUCH LOW PRICES, THEY COULDN'T STAY COMPETITIVE. THIS WEEKEND'S TENTATIVE AGREEMENT SUBSTANTIALLY RAISES THE PRICE OF MEXICAN-GROWN TOMATOES SOLD IN THE U-S.

THE 16-PAGE CONFIDENTIAL MEMO SAYS IT'S LAWFUL TO TARGET AL-QAIDA LINKED U-S CITIZENS IF THEY POSE AN "IMMINENT" THREAT OF VIOLENT ATTACK AGAINST AMERICANS - AND THAT DELAYING ACTION AGAINST SUCH PEOPLE WOULD CREATE AN UNACCEPTABLY HIGH RISK. THE MEMO DOES NOT REQUIRE THE U-S TO HAVE INFORMATION ABOUT A SPECIFIC IMMINENT ATTACK AGAINST THE U-S.

2/7/13 6:00AM (35 SECONDS) IN OTHER NEWS ACROSS THE NATION PRESIDENT BARACK OBAMA HAS DIRECTED THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT TO GIVE LAWMAKERS ACCESS TO CLASSIFIED INFORMATION FROM THE WHITE HOUSE. THE INFORMATION WILL GIVE THEM THE LEGAL RATIONALE FOR DRONE STRIKES AGAINST AMERICANS LINKED TO AL-QAIDA. SEVERAL LAWMAKERS HAVE PRESSED THE WHITE HOUSE FOR MORE INFORMATION ON HOW DECISIONS ARE MADE TO TARGET U-S CITIZENS ABROAD.THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT SENT AN UNCLASSIFIED MEMO TO KEY LAWMAKERS LAST YEAR. 2/12/13 6:00AM (30 SECONDS) WE HAVE A 10 ON YOUR SIDE CONSUMER ALERT FOR MEAT LOVERS- IMPENDING FEDERAL BUDGET CUTS COULD MEAN FEWER GOVERNMENT SAFETY INSPECTIONS AND HIGHER PRICES FOR MEAT AT YOUR LOCAL GROCERY STORE. A WHITE HOUSE MEMO RELEASED LATE LAST WEEK SAYS THE FEDERAL BUDGET CUTS SET TO TAKE EFFECT ON MARCH FIRST WOULD LEAD TO 21-HUNDRED FEWER INSPECTIONS BY THE F-D-A.THAT WOULD FORCE MEATPACKING PLANTS TO SHUTDOWN, AND LIMIT MEAT SUPPLIES IN GROCERY STORES - WHICH WOULD LEAD TO HIGHER PRICES. THE WHITE HOUSE IS HOPING TO FIND A WAY TO AVERT THE CUTS.

2/17/13 6:00AM (22 SECONDS) AUTOMATIC, ACROSS-THE-BOARD GOVERNMENT SPENDING CUTS TAKE EFFECT ON MARCH FIRST.
