ENGINEERS CALLED THE CRASH A FLUKE.TESLA ADMITS THE SOFTWARE ISN'T PERFECT AND SAYS THE DRIVER STILL HAS TO BE ALERT. INVESTIGATORS ARE LOOKING INTO THE DESIGN AND PERFORMANCE OF THE AUTOPILOT SYSTEM.

7/5/16 4:00PM (30 SECONDS) THE U.S. GOVERNMENT IS INVESTIGATING COMPLAINTS FROM FORD EXPLORER OWNERS. DRIVERS SAY THEY SMELLED EXHAUST GAS INSIDE THEIR S-U-VS.THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY ADMINISTRATION SAYS IT HAS RECEIVED 154 COMPLAINTS.THE ISSUE IS REPORTED IN 2011 TO 2015 FORD EXPLORERS.OWNERS SAY THEY SMELLED EXHAUST GAS WHEN THE S-U-VS WERE IN FULL THROTTLE, LIKE WHEN CLIMBING STEEP ROADS OR MERGING ONTO FREEWAY RAMPS. THE ODOR WAS ALSO DETECTED WHEN THE AIR CONDITIONER WAS IN RE-CIRCULATION MODE. ONE DRIVER SAYS THE ODOR CAUSED A CRASH. FORD SAYS IT IS COOPERATING WITH THE INVESTIGATION.

7/10/16 6:00PM (30 SECONDS) PRESIDENT OBAMA AVOIDED GETTING INTO SPECIFICS TODAY WHEN ASKED ABOUT THE INVESTIGATION INTO FORMER SECRETARY OF STATE HILLARY CLINTON'S PRIVATE EMAIL SERVER. THE PRESIDENT SPOKE IN MADRID AFTER MEETING WITH SPAIN'S ACTING PRIME MINISTER.
