THE EXECUTIONS ARE CAUSING UNREST IN THE REGION.REPORTS SAY LEBANON'S SUPREME ISLAMIC SHI'ITE COUNCIL, AND YEMEN'S HOUTHI MOVEMENT, ARE AMONG THOSE WHO QUICKLY CONDEMNED THE KILLINGS.

1/3/16 6:00PM (35 SECONDS) A GROUP OF ARMED PROTESTERS HAVE TAKEN OVER A FEDERAL BUILDING AT AN OREGON WILDELIFE REFUGE.THIS COMES AFTER THE PROTESTORS LED A MARCH EARLIER SATURDAY IN SUPPORT OF TWO OREGON RANCHERS CONVICTED OF SETTING FIRES ON GOVERNMENT LAND. THE RANCHERS CLAIM THOSE FIRES WERE CONTROLLED BURNS THAT GOT OUT OF HAND. THE GOVERNMENT THOUGH - SAYS THE FIRES WERE STARTED TO COVER UP POACHING. THE TWO RANCHERS ARE SET TO REPORT TO PRISON TOMORROW. AMMON BUNDY - SON OF CLIVEN BUNDY, THE NEVADA RANCHER KNOWN FOR HIS ARMED 2014 STANDOFF WITH THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT - IS AMONG THE PROTESTORS.

1/3/16 6:00PM (30 SECONDS) WE'RE FOLLOWING DEVELOPING NEWS OUT OF SAUDI ARABIA. WE'VE JUST LEARNED THAT COUNTRY WILL SEVER TIES WITH NEIGHBORING IRAN -- AFTER HUNDREDS OF IRANIANS PROTESTED AGAINST THE EXECUTIONS OF 47 PRISONERS IN SAUDI ARABIA. PROTESTERS CHANTED 'DEATH TO AL-SAUD,' THE KINGDOM'S RULING FAMILY, AS WELL AS TO THE UNITED STATES AND ISRAEL, WHICH THEY ACCUSE OF SUPPORTING THE KINGDOM DESPITE THE EXECUTIONS. ONE PROTESTOR SAYS SAUDI ARABIA'S RULING FAMILY WILL EVENTUALLY BE OVERTHROWN BY ISIS.THE PRISONERS EXECUTED BY THE SAUDI ARABIAN GOVERNMENT WERE CONVICTED OF TERRORISM CHARGES.THE EXECUTIONS SPARKED CONDEMNATION FROM PEOPLE ACROSS THE REGION.

1/10/16 6:00PM (10 SECONDS) IN OREGON -- DOZENS OF MEMBERS FROM AN ARMED GROUP CALLED THE PACIFIC PATRIOT NETWORK SHOWED UP SATURDAY AT THE MALHEUR NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE. THAT'S WHERE ANTI-GOVERNMENT DEMONSTRATORS TOOK OVER THE BUILDING MORE THAN A WEEK AGO. CHRIS LIEDLE HAS MORE.

1/17/16 6:00PM (16 SECONDS) LIKE A LOT OF US, PRESIDENT BARACK OBAMA IS CELEBRATING THE RELEASE OF AMERICANS HELD PRISONER IN IRAN. 2/19/16 4:00PM (35 SECONDS) THE GOVERNMENT SAYS HOVERBOARDS ARE NOT SAFE. THE CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY COMMISSION CAME TO THAT CONCLUSION FOLLOWING ITS MONTHS-LONG INVESTIGATION INTO THE SAFETY HAZARDS. THE C-P-S-C HAS SENT OFFICIAL NEW HOVERBOARD SAFETY STANDARD NOTICES TO RETAILERS, MANUFACTURERS, AND IMPORTERS. IT'S UNCLEAR IF THE DRIVER WAS AIMING FOR THE WORKER OR THE BUILDING. INVESTIGATORS SAY THE DRIVER HAD A GRUDGE AGAINST THE GOVERNMENT. HUNDREDS OF WORKERS WERE FORCED TO WAIT TO LEAVE THE BUILDING LAST NIGHT DURING THE INVESTIGATION.
