IT SAYS WELLS FARGO WAS RECKLESS AND RELIED ON GOVERNMENT INSURANCE TO BACK DEFICIENT LOANS. THE GOVERNMENT IS SEEKING HUNDREDS OF MILLIONS OF DOLLARS IN DAMAGES AND CIVIL PENALTIES. WELLS FARGO HAS DENIED THE ALLEGATIONS.

10/12/12 5:00AM (27 SECONDS) THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE SAYS THE GOVERNMENT AND BUSINESS NEED TO WORK TOGETHER ON ISSUES OF CYBERSECURITY. SECRETARY PANETTA CHARACTERIZED THE ISSUE AS ONE AT THE NEXUS OF BUSINESS AND NATIONAL SECURITY.HE SAYS--THE VERY OPENNESS OF COMPUTER NETWORKS THAT HAS MADE INTERNET BUSINESS SO SUCCESSFUL ALSO BRINGS WITH IT CERTAIN VULNERABILITIES.HE DESCRIBED ONGOING TERRORIST EFFORTS TO LAUNCH CYBER ATTACKS AND THE POSSIBILITY THAT INTERNET VULNERABILITY COULD LEAD TO A "CYBER PEARL HARBOR".

10/14/12 6:00PM (25 SECONDS) DO NOT EXPECT A BIG INCREASE IN YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY MONTHLY CHECKS NEXT YEAR.
