With a love of all things paranormal, the ambiance of the South with its gigantic antebellum mansions and canopies of Spanish moss, and a love for her husband's rich storytelling of blacksmiths and the mythology surrounding their origins, it wasn't long until the world of her debut novel, Black Amaranth, was born.

When not working her day job as a nurse, you can find Sasha dreaming of her next beach trip, reading the latest YA novel, and drinking more white chocolate mocha than she should.

Sasha Hibbs is the author of seven YA novels and two short stories published by Evernight Teen Publishing, the Vulcan Legacies, The Boxer and the Butterfly, Northern Pines, A Mad Awakening, is part of the Summer Crush Anthology—a USA Today recommended romance—and the Kissed Anthology. Together, authors Sasha and Christina penned the first in a series, *The Hanging Night*, recently accepted for publication in a nice deal with Evernight Teen Publishing, slated for release later this year.

For the gallery, The Infamous Art Collective and Pillage Sound:

The owner, Tim Hibbs, has been a working local artist for more than 20 years, an artist for even longer. His first art exhibit in Buckhannon occurred in 2001 at Aesop's on Main Street. Since then, he has toured up and down the East Coast at juried fine art exhibitions.

He opened an art gallery on Main Street Buckhannon in 2016. After being shut down for over a year due to COVID, he relocated to a more visible area on Main Street. In 2020 we formed an artist collective, titled 'The Infamous Art Collective' and this is in reference to a group of men in 1856 residing in French Creek, Upshur County, who stood against slavery and was labeled by the editor of *The Herald*, 'The Infamous Nine.' This is a grassroots movement and like 'The Infamous Nine', we are a collective full of skilled local artists who welcome diversity in our artists and their work.

Every month, The Infamous Art Collective is 'pitched' a theme where they then have roughly three weeks to interpret what that theme means to them. The first themed show, 'The Importance of Dreams' was held in 2017. Since then, the collective has explored thought provoking themes which produces a new gallery showing every month full of fresh, eye-catching art.

Steve and Bobbi Halterman own and operate Pillage Sound housed within the gallery. Steve an accomplished musician himself, records using vintage reel-to-reel.

Combined, we offer a Cabaret Voltaire atmosphere for creativity.





How to get to Pickens

If you will be using a GPS system to locate our town, please make sure not to use the route through Holly River State Park unless you are wanting to take a scenic route on a narrow dirt road. It's a very beautiful drive especially in the fall, but if you are wanting paved roads and the quickest route it is not the better choice. The best traveling roads are the ones in the directions below.

From Buckhannon

Follow Rt 20 S 9 miles to the WV Wildlife Center. Turn left on Alexander Helvetia Rd. CR11, proceed 20 miles to Helvetia, turn right on Pickens Rd. CR 45, proceed 5 miles to Pickens.

From Elkins

Follow Rt 219 / 250 S. 16 miles to Mill Creek, turn right on Adolph Road CR46, proceed 6 miles to Adolph. Turn right across the bridge, proceed 14 miles to Helvetia. At the Hutte Restaurant turn left on Pickens Rd. CR45, proceed 5 miles to Pickens.

From I-79 north or south


Take Exit 99 onto Rt 33 east . Take the Rt 20 Buckhannon Philippi exit. Turn right onto Rt 20 south. Go 12 miles to the WV Wildlife Center, turn left onto Alexander Rd and follow it 20 miles to Helvetia. At the Hutte Restaurant, turn right on Pickens Rd CR45, proceed 5 miles to Pickens



He was very intelligent . He fixed the radio on my 1941 Packard sedan. He always had many radios in his station in the process of repair. He could fix anything electronic. Sadly he died at age 62. He was a severe diabetic and a few times he would pass out on the air and the rescue squad would rush up the hill. I really miss him and the old Gospel music.

So thank you for continuing in his christian tradition of good old wholesome dialogue and music.
