Fort Hood Shooting-

A shooting spree occurred at several locations on the Fort Hood military base near Killeen, Texas. Four people, including the gunman, were killed, while sixteen additional people were injured. The shooter, 34-year-old Ivan Lopez, died of a self-inflicted gunshot wound. We brought the story to a local level by talking to a woman who was directly affected by PTSD and through her own tragedy has become an activist for PTSD legislation.

Missing Malaysia Plane-

Flight 370 was a scheduled international passenger flight from Beijing that lost contact with air traffic control on 8 March 2014 less than an hour after takeoff. Malaysia Airlines (MAS) reported the flight missing. The aircraft, a Boeing 777, was carrying 12 Malaysian crew members and 227 passengers from 14 nations. The search that took place was being covered through the month of April.
