*Keith McGhee/Millcreek Teenager's Body Found*

The body of 19 year old Keith McGhee was found on January 2<sup>nd</sup> near West 19<sup>th</sup> and Peach streets after going missing after a New Year's Eve party. His body was found frozen and no foul play was suspected. A fundraiser was held days after his death to offset funeral costs. Our coverage included interviewing the Erie Police Chief, talking with the coroner, and attending the fundraiser. Reporter Elizabeth D'Aurora also sat down with friends of McGhee's to reflect on his life.

*East Erie Turners Shooting/Rashid Anderson – Killed in Shooting*

A report of shots fired turned out to be a shooting inside a club which injured three people and killed one. 26 year old Rashid Anderson was the murder victim in this crime. The suspect, 21 year old Courtney Harden soon turned himself in to police. Another man, 25 year old Michael Noble II was taken into custody for allegedly shooting into Harden's home shortly after the shooting at the club. The sisters of Saint Joseph held a vigil a few weeks later to "take back the site" where Erie's first homicide of 2014 took place. Our coverage included interviewing police, neighbors, city council members and community members.

### *CRIZ "City Revitalization and Improvement Zone" Grant Denied*

At the very end of December, Governor Corbett announced two Pennsylvania cities were recipients of the CRIZ grant, and Erie was not one of them. Scott Enterprise, the group that's proposing to create a 150-million dollar mixed-use harbor place development and was hoping to get funding from the state, expressed their disappointment. City officials found out in January that it was due to a technical issue with choosing the Sewer Authority as the one to write bonds. Our coverage included interviews with Scott Enterprise officials, Pennsylvania State Senator Sean Wiley, Erie city officials, and 3<sup>rd</sup> District Representative Ryan Bizzarro.
