Murder, greed and lust abound in the next two-hour special of America's Most Wanted on Fox. In this "Crimes of Passion" episode focusing on the dark side of love, John Walsh teams up with the U.S. Marshals to hunt down one of their 15 Most Wanted: a fugitive from Pennsylvania accused of brutally shooting and killing his wife in a jealous rage.

MIGUEL "MIKE" TORRES –Reading, PA: For years they enjoyed what seemed to be a storybook romance -- a love so strong they didn't even feel the need to formalize it with vows. But after Barbie Lebron married Mike Torres, she found that her new husband had a dark side -- one that would drive him to violent extremes.

CONG CHI LE – Westminster, CA: Gunshots erupt on the streets of a Vietnamese neighborhood south of Los Angeles and now police are on the hunt for one of the shooters, Cong Chi Le, a gang member wanted on charges of attempted murder and street terrorism.

DAVID FRIEND – Springfield, OR: An unexpected family reunion quickly turns from a celebration into one man's fight to survive after he is beaten and shot. Police say a false accusation by a drunken twelve-year-old leads his neighbors, David and Nick Friend, to break into his mother's home and start attacking her cousin with metal pipes. According to authorities the Friend brothers left the home, but David quickly returned with a pistol, shooting his victim in the chest.

UNKNOWN STUART KINGSTON JEWEL HEIST– Wilmington, DE: The FBI hopes revealing surveillance footage can shed some light into the identities of a group of thieves who pulled off one of the most lucrative jewel heists ever. Investigators say four robbers burst through the doors of a family owned jewelry store, tied up the employees, and then fled with hundreds of thousands of dollars of precious gems – and one of those, a rare ruby, that can never be replaced. A Good Samaritan chased the suspect's van across state lines after the robbery, called 9-1-1 and relayed vital information that will hopefully lead to the thieves' identity and capture.

DAVID BURGERT – Missoula, MT: An ex-con and former militia man with a history of violence and anti-government threats, David Burgert is wanted for the attempted murder of two sheriff's deputies.

NATHANIEL HOWELL– Couer D' Alene, ID: Police in Idaho are on the search for a suspected child molester who barely evaded arrest in December 2011.

ALL POINTS BULLETIN (APB):

- **JERRED HERNANDEZ – Ukiah, CA:** Investigators say that in August 2000, Jerred Hernandez, a recovering drug addict, brutally and fatally bludgeoned his mentor with a baseball bat. Afterward, police say that Hernandez torched the victim's house to destroy the evidence. Though he's been on the run for more than a decade, the FBI is helping out by creating new, age-enhanced photos of what Hernandez might look like today.
- **RICK MCLEAN – Southern California:** Cops say that for years, Frederick "Rick" McLean, used his position in the Jehovah's Witnesses to hide a lengthy history of child molestation. Authorities tell AMW that when one family finally went to the police, McLean made a fast get-away with a small fortune of cash that he secretly had stashed away.

JOSE CORONA –Lewisville, TX:The U.S. Marshals, Texas Rangers and local law enforcement continue their massive manhunt for Jose Fernando Corona – a man accused of decapitating and dismembering his wife with a chainsaw while she was still alive.

LOVE STORY: DICKIE SIMMONS & LOURDES CARDENAS: In an "America's Most Wanted" case unlike any other, a personal tragedy ends in a love story written for the ages. When Los Angeles Police Detective Dickie Simmons first met Lourdes Cardenas in 1989, he believed their first encounter would be their last as the young woman barely clung to life in the hospital. Lourdes had been shot in the head and chest and her brother fatally wounded when gang members broke into her family's home. Beating the odds, Lourdes survived, and after a 1990 airing of her case on AMW, her brother's killers turned themselves in. At the taping of the capture episode, Dickie and Lourdes were reunited and instantly clicked; kindling a romance that today finds them happily married with two children.

Colorado Shooting

James Holmes created a mass shooting at the Century Movie Theatre in Aurora, Colorado during the premiere of *The Dark Knight Rises*. Holmes killed 12 people and injured 58 as he set off grenades and gun shots into the crowd. On July 30, Holmes was charged with 24 counts of first degree murder and 116 counts of attempted murder. We brought this story on a local level where people from the community told us how difficult it was to think of the massacre, but they were still excited to see the film.

Jerry Sandusky Trial

Erie County Councilman Edward Beeman

Edward Beeman owes the IRS more than \$2 million and has pleaded guilty on four counts of Social Security fraud on March 15. Beeman has been in and out of jail due to constant rescheduling his charges. Erie County's District Attorney, Jack Daneri, filed a lawsuit against Beeman in regards to his duties as a councilman. Also, Beeman was caught driving without a license, which continues to be under appeal. Beeman was charged for fraud this past March, but

the investigation continues due to him filing a motion to withdraw the plea because it caused stressed and pressure.

As the investigation continues, Beeman files a motion in U.S. District Court to have more time to review new evidence before he receives his sentencing for his conviction of Social Security fraud. A psychologist told Beeman's attorney that Beeman has suffered from Asperger's disease for many years, which may be a reason why Beeman took the actions that he did. The motion for more time was denied, but on August 27, the judge ordered Beeman back to prison to serve his time for Social Security fraud.

As of August 1, 241 cases of West Nile and four deaths have been reported in the United States for the year. The virus occurs June through September, but cases of illness start to rise in mid-August. With changes in the weather, infected mosquitoes and human behaviors influence each other, resulting in the virus. Erie County's Health Department began spraying in local communities throughout Erie. Also, the department provided some precautions for residents to protect themselves from the virus by using insect repellents outside, running an air-conditioner

whenever possible and, wearing closed-in shoes, long sleeve shirts and pants in the mornings and nights. Luckily, there were no cases of West Nile in Erie County.

Clifton Barney, 21, and Sammica Roberts, 27, arrived at UPMC Hamot's emergency room around 3 a.m. Sunday, September 9, after being shot. Erie police say that Barney was shot in the chest and Roberts was shot in the head, in the parking lot at E. 10th and Brandes St. As the investigation continued, Erie Police told us how Barney was having a difficult time cooperating with them about his shooter. Community activist, Pam Simmelkjaer, discovered Barney being silent due to him being a victim in the past. Barney has served time in behind bars for involuntary manslaughter and possession of a firearm. Eventually, Simmelkjaer had Barney under control.

Clymer Homicide

Clymer Schools Superintendent, Keith Reed, was found shot death outside his home on Monday, September 24. Four days later, Chautauqa County Sheriff's Department captured Anthony Taglianetti, the suspect in Reed's murder. Taglianetti was pulled over and taken into custody in the state of Virginia. Taglianetti refused to waive extradition back in New York to face charges in the shooting of Reed. Currently, Taglianetti is residing in Virginia until an extradition hearing is scheduled within 30 days.
