Millcreek School District Budget

At the beginning of April, Millcreek School District's Superintendent, William Hall, said that there would be some serious cuts to the budget do to being in debt nearly 9 million dollars. Board members said that the community would be looking at a tax hike but that would only raise a small portion to the 9 million dollar debt. The possibility of closing elementary schools was brought to attention, with Ridgefield elementary as the main target. Parents voiced their opinions about closing the school, but in the end it was a final decision. The preliminary budget was done by May 28th and the final budget was voted on June 27th. Our coverage included attending financial meetings, school board meetings, interviews with the superintendent and interviews with parents of those attending Ridgefield.

Boston Marathon Bombing

On April 15th, the finish line of one of the most prestigious marathons was the scene of two fatal explosions. After the explosions, racers were stopped about a mile out from the finish line and moved quickly to safety. Many people from the Erie area were either at the marathon or had close ties to the annual event. Three days later, two possible suspects were brought to the media light. After the suspects were confirmed, police were involved in an area manhunt. After gun fire at a local college, one of the suspects was killed. The other would later be captured and taken into custody. Our coverage consisted of national stories and interviews with locals who had ties to the Boston Marathon.

Millcreek Twp. School District Budget/Closure of Ridgefield & Vernondale

The Millcreek Township School District and school board faced a shortfall when they prepared its preliminary budget. They heard arguments from concerned parents and taxpayers, who believed that the closure of two elementary schools within the district, Ridgefield and Vernondale, would set the district and its students back. Initially, the board and acting superintendent, Bill Hall, proposed the closure of the two schools for just one year in an attempt to recoup some of the money. In the end, however, the district was forced to close both schools indefinitely; this created a lot of disappointment among parents whose children attended the schools. Our coverage was spread throughout the month, including PTA meetings at Ridgefield Elementary School, to Millcreek Township School District school board meetings where the board and Hall discussed their preliminary budget, to the final decision where the schools' closure was announced.

At their May school board meetings, members of the board and district debated ways in which the district can save money. The possibility of closing schools was discussed, as was the possibility of raising taxes. They also discussed the possibility of a one-year collective bargaining agreement with the teacher's union to help bridge the financial gap. Our coverage of the talks included attending school board meetings and getting reactions from those in attendance and members of the board. The interviews ran on several shows and throughout our evening newscasts after the meetings.

Guns are not permitted in Perry Square, but Dillon fought for the right in court. Despite knowing the law, he and other protestors carried firearms into the park on June 22 for the rally. Citations were given out, but no one was arrested. Our coverage consisted of advancing his court hearings prior to the rally, the rally itself, and Second Amendment rights as it pertained to Dillon and the Erie area.

She also did not have flood insurance because her area of residence is not deemed a "flood zone." Our coverage focused on the initial flooding of Millcreek and her residence, the storm's aftermath and the destruction to Reese's property, and how flood insurance can be valuable even if someone doesn't live in a "flood zone."
