Sample news stories covered:

1/1/18 - UPPER THUMB — The proposed recall of four out of five Juniata Township Board members is back on again. The same area of contention is in NextEra Energy Resources; proposed Pegasus Energy Center wind farm. Tuscola County Clerk Jodi Fetting issued notice that the recall on Jan. 8, submitted by township resident Nancy Laskowski, was withdrawn three days after being filed. New petitions were filed by resident Garrett Tetil regarding same issue. The Tuscola County Election Commission will hold a clarity/factual hearing on those petitions 2 p.m. Jan. 10 in the Tuscola County Probate Courtroom.

1/30/18 - BAD AXE — A Bad Axe man now faces up to 15 years in prison after pleading guilty to a single meth-related charge. Through a plea agreement with the Huron County Prosecutor's Office, Patrick James Paicz pleaded guilty to possession of meth at his arraignment Monday. He also pleaded guilty to being a second-time habitual offender. Paicz, 40, was arrested following a Jan. 3 traffic stop in the city of Bad Axe. Inside Paicz's vehicle, police found meth, suspected powder drugs and a cell phone.

2/5/18 - BRIDGEHAMPTON TOWNSHIP — A total of four people were arrested following a drug raid Wednesday, on North Ruth Road. Deputies arrested the individuals inside, including one who tried to escape through a bedroom window. Those arrested were three family members — a 51-year-old man, a 52-year-old woman, and their 33-year-old son — and a 40-year-old man. The parents are being lodged in Sanilac County jail on marijuana charges, while the son was lodged on child support warrants. The 40-year-old man was lodged on warrants from Lapeer County.

2-26-18 - HARBOR BEACH — With the help of grants, Harbor Beach hopes to make some improvements to the local marina. City council began the process to secure funds to bring the marina to the next level. Each project must be listed under a separate grant proposal, and the process needs to start with a public hearing. The city set a public hearing date for March 28, which will coincide with the second regular council meeting in March. At that time, several items for grant approval will be laid out to the community.

3/19/18 - PIGEON — An oil leak was determined to be the cause of a fire that took place at the Blue Diamond Steel Casting plant Friday night. According to Winsor Township Fire Chief Nick Pavlichek, firefighters were called to the scene around 7 p.m., where oil from a hydraulic power unit began leaking and ignited some electrical panels on fire. He said workers noticed the fire and were able to evacuate safely. There were no injuries reported and total damage is still being assessed.

03/29/18 - BAD AXE -- Bad Axe administrators are looking to realign the district, and some parents and board members voiced concerns and questioned the proposal. The proposal includes shifting 7th graders to the high school, 3rd graders to the middle school, and adding a Young 5s and Head Start Program to the elementary school. The focus of the proposal is academic benefits -- such as the secondary schedule being under one roof, more flexibility, and opportunities for more offerings like Advanced Placement courses.
