During the previous quarter, the issues listed below have been significant to our community. We ran the responsive programming indicated to address them. This list is not exhaustive and the order does not reflect priority or significance.

---

ISSUE: Independence Day

RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: Promotion of Feed the Multitudes

DATE / TIME: July 2, 2020 7:25am - 7:35am:

DESCRIPTION OF RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: Feed the Multitudes is an annual event at Victory Fellowship. Feed the Multitudes does not only celebrate Independence Day with food and activities, but also provides for the physical needs of attendees. In addition to posting the information on our website, we also encouraged listeners to attend and/or volunteer and aired an interview about the event with Pastor Frank Bailey of Victory Fellowship on Thursday, July 2 at 7:25am.

ISSUE: Stimulus Check Scams

RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: MoneyWise "Stimulus Check Scams"

DATE / TIME: July 6, 2020 at 10:00am for 25 minutes

DESCRIPTION OF RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: "It's a sad fact of life, wherever there's money, there's a scammer trying to take it away. Con artists are now going after people who may already be in financial trouble. The target? Stimulus checks. Scammers constantly change their tactics to match conditions. With trillions in coronavirus relief funds going out, they've adapted to this new environment. Host Rob West tells you how to protect yourself."

ISSUE: Difficult Times

RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: Daily Hope "Why is Life in This World So Hard, Parts 1-3"

DATE / TIME: July 10, 13, & 14, 2020 at 9:00am for 25 minutes each

DESCRIPTION OF RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING:

Part 1: "Why is this world so hard to live in? The Bible says it is because we all want to be our own boss—we say, "I know what will make me happy more than God does. I want to do live life on my own." But here's the Good News: God has not left us here without hope. He sent us a Savior, his Son, Jesus Christ. When you choose God, he will help you make it through the difficulties of life."

Part 2: "Disappointment is a natural part of life because everything on this planet is broken and nothing works perfectly. But God doesn't just leave us alone to sort it all out. RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: Turning Point "What About The Children, Parts 1 & 2"

DATE / TIME: July 27 & 28, 2020 at 7:30pm for 26 minutes each

DESCRIPTION OF RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING:

Part 1: "Nothing is more heartbreaking than the loss of a child. If you've ever wondered where little ones go when they die, Dr. David Jeremiah offers biblical assurance that children who pass away, pass directly into the arms of God."

ISSUE: Questions about the CARES Act

ISSUE: Coin Shortage

RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: MoneyWise "COVID Coin Shortage"

DATE / TIME: August 28, 2020 at 10:00am for 25 minutes

DESCRIPTION OF RESPONSIVE PROGRAMMING: "Got coins? If you do, odds are you haven't been using them much lately due to coronavirus sheltering. But swapping \$10 in coins for paper money could get you a free sandwich! That's just one more example of the collateral damage done from the coronavirus outbreak, a shortage of coins in circulation.
