The Indiana Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments in the case of Ramirez vs. State October sixth at one p-m. The hearing will be at Vincennes University's Shircliff Auditorium.

The Vincennes Civitan Club will take nominations for its "Citizen of the Year" award. The award recognizes volunteers who provide oustanding community service. Nominations are due by October ninth.
