

Here is a list of issues covered from July first to September 30th, 2022 on Vincennes radio station WZDM. The list is by no means comprehensive...

1. Issue Description-- New Good Samaritan peri-natal program

Program and time -- Newscasts on all 3 stations throughout the day

Date-- July 11th, 2022

Duration-- 1 minute

Description-- Good Samaritan has started a new service line to help mothers and babies throughout the community. The hospital's Community Paramedicine program is a free or low-cost service.

2. Issue description- Libertarians headed to court in lawsuit

Program and time-- Newscasts on all 3 stations throughout the day

Date-- July 15th, 2022

Duration--45 seconds

Description-- Libertarians in Indiana are planning to take the state to court. Party chairman Evan McMahon said on Indy Politics that the party plans to sue the state over the state's requirements for political parties to hold publicly funded primaries to choose party candidates in the general election.

3. Issue description-- On My Way Pre-K assistance available

Program and time-- Newscasts throughout day on all 3 stations

Date-- July 22nd, 2022

Duration-- 40 seconds

Description-- Indiana families below a certain income level are eligible for assistance through the "On My Way Pre-K" program. The course is provided by the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration.

4. Issue Description-- National Night Out to raise crime awareness

Program and time-- Newscasts throughout day on all 3 stations

Date-- August third, 2022

Length-- 45 seconds

Description-- The Vincennes Police Department held its National Night Out at Rainbow Beach. The annual event is a community outing bringing the Department and community together.

5. Program description-- Vincennes University Launches Project ASPIREE

Program and time-- Newscasts throughout day on all 3 stations

Date-- August 10th, 2022

Length-- 40 seconds

Description-- Vincennes University has secured a renewal grant for over 328-thousand dollars to attract under-represented students. The Project ASPIREE program assists those from income-eligible backgrounds, or first-generation college students.

6. Program description-- Daviess County Holding Immunization Clinic

Program and time-- Newscasts throughout day on all 3 stations

Date-- August 14th, 2022

Length-- 1 minute

Description-- If you missed out on the Daviess County Health Department's back to school immunization clinic, the county will be holding clinics with extended hours today.

7. Program description-- Employability Skills funding coming to Vincennes Schools

Program and time-- Newscasts throughout day on all 3 stations

Date-- August 23rd, 2022

Length-- 40 seconds

Description-- Vincennes Community Schools will receive 203-thousand dollars in employability skills grant funding. The money will be used in partnership with the group Equitable Education Solutions.

8. Program description-- Law Enforcement and Stop Arm Violations

Program and time-- Newscasts throughout day on all 3 stations

Date-- September 2nd, 2022

Length-- 45 seconds

Description-- The Knox County Sheriff's Department is involved in the SAVE campaign. SAVE stands for Stop Arm Violation Enforcement. The enforcement becomes even more important, with many area students heading back to school.

9. Program description-- Non-profit Organization Set for Backpack Giveaway

Program and time-- Newscasts throughout day on all 3 stations

Date-- September 4th, 2022

Length-- 50 seconds

Description-- The Kids Equipped to Achieve-- or KETA-- backpack giveaway happened at the First Christian Church in downtown Vincennes.

10. Program description-- Students pass I-READ Test

Program and time-- Newscasts throughout day on all 3 stations

Date-- September 13th, 2022

Length-- 1 minute

Description-- Knox County third graders passed the I-Read exam in numbers much higher than the state average. The state average was just below 82 percent.

11. Program description-- Energy Assistance Available

Program and time-- Newscasts throughout day on all 3 stations

Date-- September 21st, 2022

Length-- 45 seconds

Description-- Beginning October 3rd, Energy Assistance Applications for the 2022-2023 season will be available. PACE Community Action Agency says its program provides income qualified households in Daviess, Greene, Knox, and Sullivan Counties a one-time benefit toward their home's primary heat source.

12. Program description-- Men's Wellness Fair

Program and time-- Newscasts throughout day on all 3 stations

Date-- September 26th, 2022

Length-- 50 seconds

Description-- The Good Samaritan Hospital Men's Wellness Fair is planned this year for October 18th at the Highland Woods Community Center. The fair will run from seven to ten a-m, and again from four to seven p-m, that day.
