### **October 2017 (30:00)**

Hurricane Harvey recovery efforts continue in the Crossroads, and Victoria City Manager O.C. Garza was back to give an update. The storm impacted a large area of South Texas, and city officials have been assisting residents and informing them of recovery resources available to them. Victoria Emergency Management Coordinator Richard McBreyer and Police Chief Jeff Craig were also on hand to give recovery status updates.
