

Health and Wellness Crime	Capital Connection	Mary Beth Pfeiffer, Projects Writer and Chief Investigative Reporter for <i>The Poughkeepsie Journal</i> , discussed the problem of OxyContin abuse. She said the drug is very addicting, despite the initial studies claiming it wasn't. She outlined the criminal activity, increases in overdoses, and other ill effects of this particular prescription pain medication and what is being done to curb all that.	07/06/2014	7am	30 mins.
Politics & Govt Education Hydrofracking	Capital Connection	New York's Green Party candidate for governor Howie Hawkins discussed why he's running and described the issues for which he's raising awareness. He expressed criticism of the Common Core curriculum standards and stated that inner city and rural schools are under-funded. He stressed his opposition to fracking and emphasized clean, renewable energy (wind and solar). He also advocated for campaign finance reform with true public financing of political campaigns without the use of private funds paying for a candidate.	07/13/2014	7am	30 mins.
Politics & Govt Economy Hydrofracking	Capital Connection	New York State Senator Michael Gianaris, a Democrat from Queens, NY, discussed the balance of power in the State Senate and what a Democratic majority would mean for forthcoming legislation. He also advocated increasing the minimum wage, codifying women's rights under Roe vs. Wade, and thoroughly investigating the effects of hydrofracking before the state votes on it.	07/20/2014	7am	30 mins.
Politics & Govt Govt Corruption Crime	Capital Connection	Zephyr Teachout, Associate Professor of Law at Fordham University, progressive Democrat and candidate for Governor of New York, discussed whether Gov. Andrew Cuomo was blocking investigations into government corruption in the interest of big donors. She explained what she would like to accomplish in her campaign: to clean up state politics and harken back to traditional political values. She also suggested that the state's prison population could be reduced by decriminalizing some activities (like marijuana use by all, not just by those who want to use it for medicinal purposes).	07/27/2014	7am	30 mins.
Govt Corruption	Capital Connection	Ken Lovett, Albany bureau chief for the New York Daily News, discussed the legal and political implications of a federal prosecutor investigating Gov. Andrew Cuomo for allegedly interfering with the Moreland Act Commission, which was supposed to independently investigate government corruption.	08/03/2014	7am	30 mins.

Politics & Govt Govt Corruption Education	Capital Connection	John Cahill, the Republican candidate for New York Attorney General and a former Chief of Staff to Governor Pataki and Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Conservation, discussed his background and why he's running for office. He talked about the responsibilities the current Attorney General had in overseeing and implementing recommendations of the Moreland Act Commission (the scandalized anti-corruption task force). Politics & Govt Govt Corruption	Capital Connection	Blair Horner, Legislative Director for the New York Public Interest Research Group (NYPIRG), discussed the results of opinion polls of Gov. Andrew Cuomo's approval rating and what those mean for the governor's re-election chances and for his political opponents. Economy Education	Capital Connection	New York State comptroller Thomas Dinapoli reviewed the state pension funds of which he has oversight and discussed how the funds are doing and the impact this has on local governments' budgets. Politics & Govt	Capital Connection	Dick Dadey, Executive Director of Citizens Union, discussed the proposed redistricting amendment which would redefine the process by which representational districts are drawn in New York State. Politics & Govt	Capital Connection	Ken Lovett, Albany Bureau Chief and columnist for the <i>New York Daily News</i> , discussed the race for Lt. governor and what that means for the governor's race.
