QUARTERLY ISSUES AND PROGRAM LISTINGS

THE PROGRAMS AND ISSUES FACING THE COMMUNITY ARE DETERMINED ON AN ONGOING BASIS BY STATION OWNERSHIP, MANAGEMENT AND PERSONEL, THROUGH THE DAY TO DAY CONTACT WITH THE COMMUNITY. INTERACTION WITH THE COMMUNITY CONSISTS OF LOCAL NEWS COVERAGE, PUBLIC AFFAIRS PROGRAMMING AND BY VIRTUE OF KNOWLEDGE OF STATION PERSONEL, WHO RESIDE IN THE COUNTY

FOR THIS QUARTERLY REPORT, THE FOLLOWING ISSUES WERE DETERMINED BY THE STAFF TO BE THE MOST IMPORTANT TO THE COMMUNITY: 1) AMBULANCE SERVICE CONTRACT AGREEMENT REACHED BETWEEN ORANGE COUNTY AND I-U HEALTH. 2) OPENING OF SAFE HAVEN RECOVERY ENGAGEMENT AND CENTER. 3) FRENCH LICK AIRPORT ROAD ISSUES, 4) STUDY OF A NEW ORANGE COUNTY JAIL AND 5) BRINGING SAFE PLACE TO ORANGE COUNTY.

THE PRIMARY MEANS OF ADDRESSING THE ABOVE ISSUES IN ORDER TO INFORM THE COMMUNITY HAS BEEN THROUGH THE AIRING OF DAILY LOCAL NEWS COVERAGE SIX TIMES A DAY, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY. ALONG WITH PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS WHICH ARE BROADCAST 6 TIMES DAILY AS WELL AS AFTER THE LOCAL NEWSCASTS ALERTING LISTENERS TO UPCOMING CIVIC MEETINGS, GOVERNMENTAL MEETINGS, LOCAL BLOOD DRIVES, CHURCH AND REVIVAL SERVICES, AS WELL AS FOOD DRIVES, CRUSADE FOR CHILDREN EVENTS AND A NOTICE OF LOST OR FOUND PETS.
