WKIP provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- Art: Roy Budnik, a Geologist who founded Fall Kill Creative, which is cluster of four locations in downtown Poughkeepsie: Clay Works, Textile Works, Print Works and Story Works. He speaks about he is "curious about creativity" and about the emergence of the arts community in Poughkeepsie.
