It will be added to the 5% increase already implemented this year, resulting in a 7% increase over the 2022-2023 salary schedules. Since the implementation of a salary study in 2019, the base salary for a first-year teacher at Danville Public Schools has risen from \$39,924 in 2017-2018 to \$46,211 for 2023-2024.
