WOLT provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Walking Across America:** Stephen Meyers walks over 6,000 miles across the country in effort to raise awareness for Post-Traumatic Stress.
- **Kids Voices of Indiana:** Organization serving the state's children and families through three main programs that focus on legal education, child advocacy, and family visitation.
- **Shepherd Community Center:** Organization that nurtures the physical, emotional, spiritual, and academic development of community families.
- **Children's Bureau:** Organization with a mission to preserve families and protect the future of Indiana's children.
- **Indiana Center for Prevention of Youth Abuse and Suicide:** Organization focusing on the prevention of abuse and suicide through evidence-based curriculum used to educate and empower youth and adults.
- **Soupremacry:** Local restaurant assisting in the aid of feeding first responders during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- **Indiana Primary Health Care Association:** Organization advocating for quality health care for Indiana residents through various community-oriented primary care initiatives.
- **Mimi Blue Good Food:** Local restaurant assisting in the aid of feeding first responders during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- **Goodwill of Central & Southern Indiana:** Organization with a mission to empower people to increase their independence and reach their potential through different efforts such as education, health, and employment.
- **The National Kidney Foundation of Indiana:** Organization making a difference for those suffering from Kidney disease.
- **Outreach, Inc.:** Organization serving the homeless youth.
- **Taste Restaurant at Lucky Lou:** Local restaurant assisting in the aid of feeding first responders during the COVID-19 pandemic.
