WOLT Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WOLT provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- Convicted2Change: Convicted2Change is an organization that helps with engaging, empowering, and inspiring youth in the community as well as people dealing with financial hardships and the organization is hosting a July event to benefit the community.
- Joseph Maley Foundation: Joseph Maley Foundation is an organization working with area schools to educate and empower students with physical disabilities. A walk/run is held to raise funds for the organization.
- Independence Academy of Indiana: The Independence Academy of Indiana is a school for children on the autism spectrum grades 4 thru 12 helping its students graduate with a high school diploma.
- US Army: The US Army is increasing awareness about the many different options available for recruits.
- National Urban League: The National Urban League focuses on the empowerment of African Americans and other underserved urban residents in economical, parity, power, and civil rights issues.
- Benjamin Harrison: Educational events awareness.
- Families First: Families First is an organization that offers a variety of resources including recognizing and preventing domestic violence, recognizing and treating mental health, recognizing crisis and suicide prevention.
- Indy Cruise: Auto show fundraiser to raise money for Folds of Honor which funds scholarships for the children of fallen military personnel.
- Indiana Victim Rights Coalition: A not for profit to assist victims of crime of their rights within the judicial process against their defendants.
- Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT): INDOT oversees the constructions and maintenance of interstate highways, U.S. routes, or state roads and it continuously addresses major road projects through awareness efforts.
- Every Dog Counts: Not for profit that assists in rehabilitating and relocating dogs rescued from negative situations.

- Indianapolis Neighborhood Housing Partnership (INHP): INHP helps with the increase of affordable and sustainable housing opportunities for individuals and families as well as helping with the development and revitalization of neighborhoods.
- St. George Festival: Annual fundraiser benefitting St. George Christian Church.
- Indianapolis Santa Hustle 5k: Annual holiday event benefitting Little Red Door Cancer Agency.
- **Prison Greyhounds:** Organization that fosters retired racing greyhounds and matches them with specially selected offenders who are ready to make amends. Greyhounds are taught basic house manners prior to formal adoption.
- Indiana Council on Problem Gambling: Indiana Council on Problem Gambling is an organization that offers resources to individuals and families affected by problem gambling.
- Angels and Doves: Non-profit charity that travels across the country preventing bullying, bullying injuries, and bullying suicides.
- Indiana Mortgage Bankers Association: Indiana Mortgage Bankers Association helps with the education, advocacy, and the support offered to its members and Hoosiers with their business and homeownership needs.
