WOLT provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT): INDOT addressed major road projects affecting daily commutes in major interstate highways in addition to raising awareness for National Work Zone Awareness week
- Republic Plane Pull: Fundraiser benefiting Indiana children organizations such as the Indiana Children's Wish Fund, Riley Children's Foundation, A Kid Again, and Peyton Manning Children's Hospital
