- Fairbanks Addiction Treatment Center: Organization providing recovery treatment.
- Indy Hunger Network: Coalition of hunger relief organizations.
- People for Urban Progress (PUP): PUP focuses on innovative and creative ideas/projects that focus on reuse and sustainability through projects like "Dome Bag Project" and the Amtrak Collection.
- The Harrison Center for the City: Community-based, nonprofit arts organization that seeks to be a catalyst for renewal in the city of Indianapolis.
- Women's Fund of Central Indiana: Organization whose mission is to mobilize people, ideas and investments so women in community have equitable opportunity to reach full potential regardless of background.
- Big Brothers Big Sisters of Indianapolis: Organization that partners youth with parents/caregivers, volunteers, schools, and donors so each child can reach his or her full potential.

- Indy Opera: The Indy Opera's mission is to educate, inspire, and entertain through musical storytelling.

- A Kid Again: Resources allowing children with disabilities the opportunity to fulfill childhood wishes.
