WOLT provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **US Army:** The US Army Recruiting Battalion in Indianapolis raises awareness for Army National Hiring Days and shares how the pandemic has affected military life.
- **Children's Bureau:** Organization with a mission to preserve families and protect the future of Indiana's children.
- **iHeartMedia Community:** iHeartMedia Indianapolis launches community partnership by offering in-kind media to 8 local non-profits based on RFPs submitted.
- **The National Kidney Foundation of Indiana:** Organization making a difference for those suffering from Kidney disease.
- **United Cerebral Palsy Association of Greater Indiana:** UCPA Indy offers support services to those affected by Cerebral Palsy.
- **Goodwill of Central & Southern Indiana:** Organization with a mission to empower people to increase their independence and reach their potential through different efforts such as education, health, and employment.
- **Nine13sports:** Organization offering biking activities to disadvantaged youth.
- **Hope Healthcare Services:** Clinic offers low-cost, quality healthcare to uninsured.
- **Financial Center First Credit Union:** Not-for-profit credit union that prides itself in providing education, tools, and resources for financial literacy.
- **The Hope Academy:** Charter high school for teens recovering from substance-abuse.
- **The Arts Council of Indianapolis:** Organization focusing on the importance of supporting the arts in central Indiana.
- **Keep Indianapolis Beautiful:** Organization helping people and nature thrive through opportunities such as planting trees, picking up litter, etc.
- **Gleaners Food Bank:** Organization that supplies hunger relief agencies and schools throughout central and southeastern Indiana.
- **Joy's House:** Home that assists with adult day and caregiver services to adults living with life-altering diagnosis.
- **Fairbanks Addiction Treatment Center:** Organization providing recovery treatment.
- **Indy Hunger Network:** Coalition of hunger relief organizations.
