PERSPECTIVA NACIONAL FCC REPORT – 3RD QUARTER 2016

ISSUE: IMMIGRATION

Program: Perspectiva Nacional (Segment #2, 8:00)

When: August 7th, 2016 (STOCKTON-MODESTO** Sunday 5:00am)**

Description of Program

The main theme is a rule modified by the Department of Homeland Security that benefits thousands of undocumented immigrants who are subject to the “punishment of ten years.” Immigration lawyers José Pertierra e Iván Yacub explain the rule, its benefits and the application process.

Program: Perspectiva Nacional (Segment #2, 8:00)

When: August 21st, 2016 (STOCKTON-MODESTO** Sunday 5:00am)**

Description of Program

The main theme is DACA’s fourth anniversary and why so many young-adults have yet to take advantage of this benefit. Simón Sandoval, an immigration attorney, and Ambar Pinto, representative of “United We Dream Action,” explain the benefit of applying for DACA and the constant fear among Hispanics that this immigration relief will no longer exist in the future.

15 days before the Republican convention in Cleveland, Ohio, Donald Trump tries to moderate his tone and present himself as a more presidential candidate. However, polls show Hillary Clinton leading in the race for the White House. We interview Melisa Diaz, Democratic analyst and Israel Ortega, Republican analyst.
