WYPR also carries 61.5 hours per week of NPR news programs, 14 hours per week of news-oriented talk show programs from NPR, more than 100 hourly newscasts each week from NPR, 24 hours per week of news programming from the BBC World Service, 5 hours per week of news programming from PRI, and 3.5 hours per week of business news from APM. We air 13 local newscasts each weekday and more than 25 traffic reports each weekday.

In addition, we carried gavel to gavel coverage of the House Impeachment hearings, both in the Intelligence and the Judiciary Committee, as well as the full House vote.
