California National Guard, Help Homeless, Stop Bullying, Feeding America, Texting & Driving, Recipes for Disaster, Safe Food, Smart



David Gibbs started by asking if we know what the Personhood Movement in America is. The Personhood Movement opposes abortion on demand and the rationing of health care for the elderly and disabled. Nearly 20 states have Personhood Movements designed to protect legally all human life from biological conception until natural death. Life is a God given right enshrined in the Declaration of Independence. David said that Justice Blackman, who wrote the majority opinion in the Roe vs. Wade case, said that if the unborn were ever legally declared to be persons they would have a legally protected right to life. Presently, American law only considers babies to be persons protected by law after they are born. Personhood laws would change that definition and protect babies in the womb. David said this issue is not going away soon.

Brief Description:

Attorney David Gibbs asked the question “must a church apply to the Internal Revenue Service for a 501(c)(3) tax exemption status”. David stated that one of the benefits of churches is the 501(c)(3) tax exemption status. However, a church does not actually have to apply to the Internal Revenue Service for the 501(c)(3) tax exemption status as long as they are in compliance with the regulations of the 501(c)(3) tax exemption status code and requirements. This also applies to church integrated auxiliary groups and well as conventions who do the same type of church work. If however, a church operates food banks, gets involved in trusts or other secular things, they may be required to apply and receive the 501(c)(3) tax exemption status in order to comply with the IRS rules.

David Gibbs said when a church is considering hiring a new staff member they sometime have a certain person in mind for the job position. The church may believe they have to publicize the fact the position is available for others to be able to apply so as not to discriminate in the hiring practice. The Christian Law Association has advised churches it is not a legal requirement that a job position be opened up to other applicants so they may apply. If the church knows of someone who is qualified and wants to hire him or her, it has every legal right to do so without posting the position. It is a judgment call as to whether the church opens up the position to anyone else or not. It is not a legal requirement to do so.

David Gibbs started by say that sadly running a business with faith values can be challenged in America. Many Christians in business prefer not to do business with or provide services to people who openly showing their sexual orientation or other lifestyle practices. What they want is for businesses to accommodate their gender changeability. The state and federal areas of the law seem to be changing on a daily basis. Unfortunately, the trend seems to be heading in the direction that any refusal of services based on sexual gender or lifestyle practices as being "unlawful discrimination". Christian business owner may openly express their faith with their customers, but they may not refuse services to a customer because of their religious faith reasons.
