An example of and some of these PSA are:



**Brief Description:**

Chuck told of the best banking institutions for personal checking accounts, savings and CD accounts. He told of a company that analyzed the rates, fees and features of more than 2300 banks and credit unions of all shapes and sizes across the country. Some of the things we should know is that on-line only savings accounts provide the markets highest interest rates. They are offering 82% higher than the runner up, on-line checking accounts. Interest rates increased much greater in the first 3 month of 2016. For those interested in the lowest fees should focus on offers from credit unions which are 25% cheaper than on-line checking accounts. Chuck said CDs are not a good deal. They yield less over 2 years than an on-line checking account. While inferior to on-line checking accounts, credit union checking accounts continue to offer the best interest rates of all branch based institutions. Finally, according to the report, USAA is the most trusted bank for people with excellent credit. Capital One is the most trusted for people with bad credit.

After securing the use of the public school gymnasium they began to advertise. One of the CLA attorneys strongly encouraged they have a parent's signature on a liability release form for all participants under the age of 18 years. The Christian Law Association was also able to supply the liability release form they could use. Because of this advice, the church required all teens to pre-register and complete liability release forms prior to the date of the tournament. Remember, you must be 18 years or older to be able to sign the form.

**Brief Description:**

David Gibbs said donations of non-cash items are tax deductible but there are some special rules for large and expensive items you have to follow. A church called the CLA when a church member wanted to donate a piano worth a lot of money. The church financial secretary contacted the CLA for a form to use as a receipt for a non-cash donation. One of the attorneys sent them a letter but also sent information from the IRS relevant to certain valuable donations. It seems that certain individuals were placing a very high value on certain non-cash gifts to increase the donor's tax deduction.

Because of this the Internal Revenue Service requires that gifts over \$5,000.00 be appraised by a qualified appraiser. This appraisal must be done within 60 days of the donation. When you accept a donation of a non-cash item, be sure you follow the law.

David Gibbs said the government recognizes churches as non-profit organizations, but the profit corporations do not necessarily have to do the same. A church was upgrading the software in their computer system and found a company that offered their software to non-profit corporation at a very substantial discount. The church was asked to give proof of their non-profit status but could not find the documents. A Christian Law Association attorney told the church the government recognizes any church as a non-profit organization but most corporations do not, nor are they legally required to do so. The church had the option of paying the higher price for the software or work through the tedious and expensive process of becoming formally a 501(c)(3) approved by the government.

The pastor called the Christian Law Association and one of the attorneys told the pastor that passive income is when the tax-exempt organization lets someone else use the property, money or name of the organization or the church and receives income from it for the privilege without actually becoming involved as an organization that does this kind of work. Churches have every right to do this without any fear of loosing its tax-exempt status.

Brief Description:

David Gibbs told of a church whose pastor called the Christian Law Association and asked what the rules were about hiring underage teens, 14 and 15 year olds, to do odd jobs around the ministry property. One of the CLA lawyers told the pastor the Federal government places limits on the number of hours that underage teenagers can work. They can do no more than 3 hours on a school day and no more than 8 hours on a non-school day. Government regulations also forbid 14 and 15 year old teenagers from using power equipment such as power lawnmowers. Most states also have additional regulations with more restrictive use when it comes to child labor. Be careful when using underage teenage labor even if they are accompanied by their parents to work on the property.

Tony Perkins started by quoting the Bible with “even if you suffer for righteousness sake you shall be blessed”. The students at North Carolina State University were told if they want to talk about Jesus you had better have a permit. Grace Christian Life, one of the campus clubs on site, they were told they would have to have a permit to speak freely in the student union. In a lawsuit against the school they asked “isn’t that what the 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment is for?” Alliance Defending Freedom filed the challenge when North Carolina State tried to censor what the constitution guaranteed them their religious liberty. Colleges are places where ideas are freely shared, not gagged argued the club president. Earlier this month a Federal Court ordered the campus to end it outrageous and selective policy.
