April 1, 2017	Can Love Succeed When Cultures Clash?	<u>Guest:</u> Nonyelu Anyichie, M.D., Author <u>Description:</u> Anyichie, a Nigerian now living in New York City, discussed how the commonplace experience of seeking a relationship crosses cultures and continents – and leads to both happy and unhappy endings. She spoke about the culture clash she first experience when moving to the United States and how marriages here differ from those in Nigeria.
April 15, 2017	Promoting inclusion throughout the faith-based community	<u>Guest:</u> Tim Williams, Chairman of <i>The Union County Interfaith Council</i> <u>Description:</u> The Union County Interfaith Council organized a networking event on April 26 at which residents from throughout Union County, NJ looking for a faith community to join may "speed date" with various faith-based organizations. It's an opportunity for all houses of worship, regardless of their faith, to come together in one place to meet with community residents who are seeking a place of worship that they feel comfortable with.
April 29, 2017	Missionary Aviation	<u>Guest:</u> Bruce Wolff, Founder of <i>Brigade Air</i> – Bloomingdale, NJ <u>Description:</u> Bruce joined us again to speak about his missions organization, Brigade Air, a Christian youth mission aviation program with the goal of encouraging young people to use their lives in missionary aviation. Bruce is a devout Christian and spoke about his journey leading him into the aviation world and what ultimately encouraged him to mentor young men and women as he does today.
May 13, 2017	Finding hope in a fallen world	<u>Guest:</u> Tracy Davis, Elder at <i>New Life Body of Christ Church</i> in Newark, NJ <u>Description:</u> Ms. Davis felt a great desire to write a book that would uplift your faith and make you evaluate your life. There a thousands of books today that aim to encourage and inspire, but many of them are not founded on Biblical principles. She offers a combination of biblical verses and scriptures, which can be applied to everyday situations. And, she sends a message to all generations that God has a plan for all of us.
May 27, 2017	Why are parents still raising their adult children?	<u>Guest:</u> John Horvat II, Author and Scholar <u>Description:</u> While hiring has been on the increase in recent years, wages are not going up and many college grads are stuck with hefty student loans. As a result, parents bear a financial burden, with nearly 60 percent providing some type of financial support for their adult children. Horvat says parents need to begin preparing their kids for life after graduation while they are still in college. He discussed how to instill a sense of purpose in children's lives and how parents can help them make the transition to adulthood.
June 17, 2017	Has the anti-gluten frenzy gone too far?	<u>Guest:</u> John Douillard, Nutrition counselor for the New Jersey Nets <u>Description:</u> Gluten became branded as the enemy of good health, scaring the public away from wheat, but Dr. Douillard reiterated that it's time everyone takes a deep breath and re-evaluate this “wheat-is-a-villain” attitude.
