

WZXI Issues/Programs

Second Quarter 2022

WZXI offers a news and information program line up over WZXI-AM, W231DM and W234CN and provides over the air service 24/7 from studios in Lancaster, Ky. In addition program content is available over the station stream. The program schedule remains much the same as previous Quarters. The stations remained on the air through the extremes of the local weather providing service to the listening areas.

WZXI monitors KIH41 weather service radio and relays weather bulletins when they originate from NWS via station EANS facilities. Local weather forecast are broadcast generally at the top and bottom of each hour. Other EANS bulletins, locally originated and Required Monthly test were broadcast.

During this Quarter, WZXI aired 20 minutes of Public Service Announcements daily M - F in addition the station aired listener opinion vignettes 5 times daily M - F. Kentucky Focus public affairs program each Sunday morning. A schedule of those programs is attached. WZXI carried election results from the Garrard County Courthouse.
