

Akron Group – WAKR, WONE-FM, WQMX 2021 1st Quarter Community Issues/Programs

During 2020, a survey was conducted by the Center for Marketing and Opinion Research to assess the community needs facing Akron and Summit County. Normally, these reports are published during 1st quarter each year, but so far, during 2021 we have not seen a new report. According to the most recent information we have, the problems facing Northeast Ohio during the period fell into the following categories (presented in order of importance):

NOTE: We know, from our own involvement in the community that during the period since the research was completed, COVID 19 Pandemic related shut downs emerged as a most important topic. These include both health concerns and economic concerns. Also Diversity, Equity and Inclusion has become a hot topic. Therefore, our stations have focused on COVID related issues and Equality Issues during the 2nd quarter of 2021.

CORONAVIRUS: COVID continues to affect our listening public and during the quarter, we have focused on the continuing adjustments to best COVID practices being made by the state, and we have reported on the announcements made by Ohio's Governor DeWine. Attention has also been paid to mis-information being distributed by other media and the continuing changes in vaccine availability has been a part of our coverage.

BLACK LIVES MATTER: During the period, we have continued to see concerns with racism and police brutality dominate the public discussion. RCRG Stations have included news and updates regarding these issues in their regular programming.

WAKR-WONE-WQMX focused on the following issues for this quarter:

Regularly Scheduled Programs

In addition to the programs listed, stations also provided the following regularly scheduled news and community service programming:

WAKR News – 3:00 length local newscasts 5am-9am M-F at the top and bottom of each of each hour 5:30a-8:30a, and top of the hour following CBS News 9a-1p.

CBS News – airs on 1590 WAKR Newscasts are 6:00 in length until 9am M-F, with the exception of the World News Roundup at 8:00 a.m. M-F (10 minutes) and 1-min hourly updates throughout the day.

WAKR Ray Horner Show – 6:00 a.m. - 9:00 a.m. Monday-Friday. News, sports, weather, traffic, business and topical interviews of local, national and community interest.

America in the Morning - airs on 1590 WAKR 5a-6a M-F with topical news, sports, business and information. 54:00 length. Network program.

WONE News – 1:30 length hourly local newscasts 6a-8a weekdays. These newscasts are conversational in nature and air at 6:40am, 7:40am and 8:40am.

WQMX News – 2:30 length local newscasts 5:30a-8:30a at the top and bottom of each hour weekdays.

Akron Weather Updates - all stations present weather updates at least every hour during live programming and break in to programming when severe weather events warrant.

Akron Traffic Updates - All stations: regular traffic and highway construction updates at least four times each hour on WAKR, WONE & WQMX during weekday mornings. Updates are provided weekday afternoons as needed.

Spectrum – produced by the RCRG Newsroom presenting in-depth treatment of local, regional and national issues. Some programs also include presentations of the City Club of Cleveland highlighting a wide range of programming. Airs on WAKR and WONE.

Forum 360 – produced by the Jewish Community Center of Akron in association with the Rubber City Radio Group, a 30-minute program airs each Monday morning at 12:30 a.m. on WAKR and Sunday at 6:30 a.m. on WONE at 5:30 p.m. on WAKR depending on sports schedules.

Center Talks – produced by the Akron Urban League and 1590 WAKR with information on agencies and programs of benefit to the Akron urban community. This program runs 30:00.

Ready, Set Grow - on 1590 WAKR with host Tom Dayton offering advice for gardening and landscaping. Saturday 8:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m. This program also airs Sunday evenings on a replay.

My Beautiful Home - on 1590 WAKR with hosts Katherine DeLong and Andy January with information on home décor and preserving value for homeowners. Saturday 11:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. This program also airs Sunday evenings on replay.

CBS Weekend Roundup - a 48:00 minute review of the week's biggest news stories. Program airs Sundays on WAKR.

CBS Face the Nation - a 58:00 program with news and debate originating in Washington, D.C. Program airs Sundays on WAKR.

RCRG Community Outreach

As part of our continued community outreach, RCRG works in partnership with various community groups to both raise funds and help operations of non-profit charitable groups and profile worthwhile community events. Among the initiatives for this quarter:

All Stations Participated in these Community Events

At the beginning of the quarter, we continued to be prevented from running community events outside of our studios. Beginning in June, we have been able to return to the public and ran some events.

Vehicle Inspection & Document Shredding. This annual free event was held on June 16th, in the front parking lot of our building on Akron's West Side. There were over 220 cars to be safety checked. We supported this with on-air promotion, interviews, web, newspapers and on site. This was conducted in partnership with the Akron Police Department, Summit County Sheriff's office, and the Ohio Highway Patrol.

Akron Marathon. RCRG Stations also participated in the *National Interstate 8k & 1 Mile* marathon race, which is a preliminary event leading up to the Akron Marathon, coming in September. The event was held on June 26th at the University of Akron, Infocision Stadium.

WQMX Hosted or Participated in the Following Community Events:

<u>Pet Rescue:</u> WQMX hosts a weekly event on its morning show featuring animals available for adoption. We work with local independent pet rescue "One of A Kind Pets" We also support this program with social media.

WONE Hosted or Participated in the Following Community Events:

Rock The Lock

This is a weekly TGIF sponsored by the Radio Station. Event supports the Valor Home of Summit County. An agency that supports efforts to find affordable housing for US Military Veterans. This event runs weekly from Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day weekend. Various WONE personalities participate in this event.

WAKR Community Programming:

<u>Ray Horner Morning Show:</u> This program airs 5:30a – 9:00a, Monday-Friday with the exception of major holidays. It provides regular newscasts, sports, traffic and weather in addition to a regular listing of community, news and topical interviews.
