Section I. Issues

This station has identified the following issues as significant ones that are facing our community in this quarter:

- A. **STATE ELECTION 2022:** The Democratic primary on September 6th decided several stateheld offices, including Berkshire County District Attorney, Berkshire County Sheriff, and State Senate. WTBR provides listeners exposure to the candidates and their ideas and views.
- B. LOCAL NEWS & POLITICS: Summer months are usually on the quiet side for local issues, but this year several persistent issues stayed on the minds of listeners, including charter objections on budget items, the city's homelessness problem, and road maintenance.
- C. COMMUNITY, ARTS, ENTERTAINMENT, AND NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS: Summer is the busy season for the area's arts and culture economy. Pittsfield continues to benefit from the increased attention to these activities, and WTBR profiles many of the offerings in interviews with these organizations.
- D. **EDUCATION:** September marked the beginning of the new school year for both public schools and community college. Students and families are grappling with the cost of college and keeping up with the possibility of student loan debt forgiveness.
- E. LAW ENFORCEMENT & PUBLIC SAFETY: Fire safety, ambulance issues, environmental police, and digital forensics dominated the topics covered in the category of public safety this quarter.
