*Period Covered: January-March 2023*

1. Family: Marriage, childrearing, singleness
2. Aging: Senior citizen opportunities, staying active and healthy, housing options, government services
3. Youth Challenges: College, youth culture, finding employment, premarital sex and abstinence, drugs
4. Health Issues: Staying healthy, disease and its prevention, local and national trends in health (COVID, opioid crisis, higher death/suicide rate among young and middle-aged individuals), gender dysphoria and transgenderism
