## **STADIUM E/I PROGRAMMING INFORMATION SECOND QUARTER 2018**

Stadium aired the FCC required average of 3 hours of E/I programming each week, April 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018. E/I programming aired each Sunday within an E/I block from 11:00 AM ET to 2:00 PM ET. During second quarter 2018 there was only one exception to this, on Sunday, 5/20 the E/I programming block aired from 10:00 AM ET to 1:00 PM ET. The block moved an hour earlier on 5/20 due to a live baseball game on the Stadium schedule that started at 1:00 PM ET. The pre-empted hour of E/I programming from 1:00 PM ET to 2:00 PM ET on Sunday, 5/20 (Future Phenoms and Sports Stars of Tomorrow) was also aired the following week in its second home on Saturday, 5/26 12:00 PM ET to 1:00 PM ET.

The E/I programming on Stadium is targeted to ages 13 – 16 and includes the programming lineups and program descriptions listed below. The E/I programming block (day/time) and programs within the block will remain the same for third quarter 2018.

**DRAGONFLY TV SPORTS** - Dragonfly TV Sports" is a weekly half-hour science television series that meets the educational and informational objectives of the FCC's Childrens Programming requirements for children ages 13-16. The programs highlight children "doing" projects with real hands-on experience and demonstrates practical applications of mathematics and science, in particular, as it relates to individual sports or sporting activity. It introduces young viewers to a variety of scientific disciplines within a particular sport and challenges them in critical thinking and problem solving skills, while providing valuable information to reach answers. The series profiles high school athletes who have overcome personal adversity to pursue their dreams. The athletes are recognized for their classroom achievements, as well as their contributions in extracurricular activities. The importance of dedication, discipline, commitment to academics, and community involvement are spotlighted as part of the athletes' success. The stories strive to inspire viewers to pursue knowledge and a healthy, active lifestyle, despite any personal difficulties.

**SPORTS STARS OF TOMORROW** - This program showcases the hard work and dedication required to be a true sports star. Chronicled are the trials and tribulations of young athletes as they strive to become top level performers in the sports arena. This program helps viewers realize that with hard work and determination, their goals in life and on the playing field are attainable. Key values such as dedication, discipline, commitment and community involvement are reinforced in each episode. 
