A brief synopsis:

Caprice Jones stopped by to talk about his new self-help organization Fountains Of Youth. Their mission is to help area individuals overcome generational or situational poverty by providing them with skills to rise above their circumstances. The training focuses on communications skills and financial literacy, while emphasizing additional education and finding/keeping sustainable employment. The organization provides two programs. Pioneers is a one to three year program for people ages 16 to 24 -and- Trailblazers is a fourteen week program people age 18 and up [and is geared towards helping those who have been incarcerated]. Right now the center is looking for volunteers to be mentors.

OTHER SERVICES

NEWS: All Townsquare Media of Dubuque stations carry news of the American Broadcasting Company and six local newscasts each weekday. In addition, WDBQ-AM carries Iowa state news from Radio Iowa.

WEATHER: Townsquare features full access to satellite and radar transmissions of current conditions. WJOD is associated with Weathertime, a private weather service that has a much better track record than the National Weather Service, is faster with their reports, and is especially valuable to the Dubuque area's extensive agricultural community.

PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENTS: Townsquare of Dubuque stations average well over 20 locally oriented public service announcements per day for various non-profit groups in the tri states.
