In Health Today: It seems that obesity can be as contagious as an infection. A study in which thousands of Boston residents participated demonstrated that a person has a 57% greater chance of gaining weight if they have a friend who is obese. The risk triples if the friend is a close one and is almost doubled between siblings. Between spouses, the risk is 37%. Although it is influential that between friends and family members there are generally similar eating habits, according to the experts, the determining factor is that when one has a friend or relative who is obese, it changes the perception of what is a healthy weight.

In our immigration bulletin, we would like to denounce various unscrupulous groups in the US who are tricking undocumented aliens, particularly Mexicans, by making them think that for a specific sum of money, they can help them emigrate to Canada where the authorities will grant them asylum. As a result of this practice, hundreds of immigrants are arriving daily at the Canadian border only to found that they have been swindled. Canadian authorities say that the majority were fooled by an organization in Naples, Florida that charged them \$400 per adult and \$100 per child, promising as well that they would find employment. Canada does not give preference to Hispanic immigrants. Last year only 28% of Mexicans received refugee status versus 47% of those of other nationalities.
