#### **CONSUMMER AWARENESS**

Great Day, Jan 9, 2020, 06:08 AM, :18, Local: The California Food Expo is now ending its run after nearly a decade. The expo's board of directors decided to shut down the event for financial reasons. This is an important alert for viewers as the expo featured hundreds of food and drink businesses from throughout the state.

Midday, Jan 14, 2020, 11:33 AM, :27, Local: PG&E says it is seeing more than twice as many scam phone calls than usual this year. The caller threatens to shut off your power and demands payment in the form of prepaid debit cards or gift cards. This story is important for viewers because scams are incredibly common here in the Central Valley.

Midday, Feb 5, 2020, 11:48 AM, :26, Local: Sprint and Comcast are now partnering to create new caller ID technology to protect you from annoying and invasive robocalls. The technology would prevent callers from faking the phone number that shows up on your screen, making it more difficult to trick you into picking it up. This story is important because these robocalls scam one out of every 10 Americans. Yearly losses add up to nearly \$10 billion.

Midday, Mar 3, 2020, 11:46 AM, :33, Local: iPhone maker Apple is now settling a class-action lawsuit, claiming the company purposely slowed down older phones to get users to buy new models. The payout will cost Apple around \$500 million. This story is important for viewers because they may receive some money because of this lawsuit. Anyone who owned an iPhone 6, 7 plus, or SE can file a claim. The expected payout is expected to be around \$25.

Great Day, Mar 12, 2020, 08:25 AM, :28, Local: The beauty products store Sephora is now making changes because of the Coronavirus. All paid and free in-store makeup services at Sephora are now suspended. This is an important alert for viewers because the chain has a number of locations in the Central Valley.

Midday, Mar 12, 2020, 11:47 AM, :16, Local: The tax deadline could be extended due to the coronavirus. The April 15th deadline could be postponed by at least a few months or waive fees linked to late filing. This is important for viewers who still have not filed their taxes

Great Day, Mar 13, 2020, 08:10 AM, :41, Local: The Save Mart Center is now postponing a number of events because of the Coronavirus. That includes concerts from Lynyrd Skynyrd and the Italian pop group II Volo. This is an important story for people who may have tickets or made plans for future events in Fresno.

Midday, Mar 13, 2020, 11:39 AM, :24, Local: PG&E says it will begin offering flexible pay plans due to the coronavirus. The utility company also says it will not disconnect electricity and gas for people who are unable to pay their bills. This applies to both residential and commercial customers. This is important for viewers who may not be able to work due to the outbreak

Midday, Mar 17, 2020, 11:32 AM, 01:17, Local: Treasury secretary Steven Mnuchin is now calling for lawmakers to come up with a major economic stimulus package to help the country avoid another recession. This new plan would include aid to small businesses and airlines and sending checks directly to Americans. This story is important because the coronavirus is forcing some out of their jobs. Getting some money to help stay afloat could make all the difference for some families.

Midday, Mar 24, 2020, 11:36 AM, :25, Local: The city of Fresno is now suspending its curbside pickup program due to the coronavirus. Any scheduled pickup after March 27 are now on hold. This story is important for viewers because many people rely on these pickup dates to get large and hard to transport items out of their homes.

Great Day, Mar 26, 2020, 09:04 AM, :40, Local: Nearly 3.3 million people filed for unemployment benefits last week. That is more than four times the previous record set back in 1982. The surge comes as layoffs accelerate due to the widespread economic shutdown because of the coronavirus. This story is important for viewers because some economists think unemployment could reach 13% by May. During the great recession, the highest jobless rate was 10%.

#### **CRIME**

Midday, Jan 2, 2020, 11:30 AM, :55, Local: The Roman Catholic Diocese of Fresno is facing a new lawsuit accusing Father Anthony Moreno of sexual assault. The lawsuit says the abuse was reported to church officials, but Father Moreno was allowed to remain in the ministry. This story is important for viewers because Father Moreno has served in churches all over the valley through several decades.

Ten O'clock, Jan 2, 2020, 10:05 PM, 02:27, Local: Two men broke into a high-end boutique in North Fresno last month and stole thousands of dollars' worth of designer handbags and jewelry. This is important to viewers because the burglars are still on the loose and the theft was caught on camera. A viewer could potentially be able to identify one or both of the burglars.

Ten O'clock, Jan 3, 2020, 10:03 PM, 01:52, Local: A father in Fresno is still searching for answers on who shot and killed his son and why they did it. Fresno Police said on the day it happened that it was an unprovoked and senseless act of violence. This is important to viewers because a senseless act of violence like this could have happened to anyone and the gunman is still on the loose.

Ten O'clock, Jan 5, 2020, 10:01 PM, :30, Local: Four masked men with handguns robbed a Wienerschnitzel in Visalia and made off with cash and a worker's cell phone. They left in two cars and are still on the run. This is important to viewers because Visalia Police are asking for the public's help in finding any kind of information about the masked men and someone watching may know something about the men or the robbery.

Ten O'clock, Jan 6, 2020, 10:01 PM, 01:45, Local: A Fresno band is missing all of its instruments and gear worth more than 20 thousand dollars, leaving it unable to perform. The equipment was stolen out of the band's U-Haul truck after the band had performed in Santa Ana. This is important to viewers because the band needs help getting their gear back and someone watching could possibly help.

Ten O'clock, Jan 6, 2020, 10:06 PM, 01:46, Local: A man in Fresno has been arrested 11 times in the past year but he keeps being let out of jail. Now he's been terrorizing a neighborhood in Fresno by breaking into people's homes. This is important to viewers because the man is a threat to society and making others feel unsafe and not much is being done about it.

Great Day, Jan 8, 2020, 08:05 AM, :23, Local: People who rent from a Derrell's Mini Storage facility in Merced are now being told to check on their stuff. Deputies say thieves broke into the facility on Santa Fe Drive twice. This is an important alert for the community and anyone who may have items stored at that facility.

Midday, Jan 8, 2020, 11:32 AM, :46, Local: Two gang members are now in custody, accused of involvement in several shoot outs at an apartment complex in southwest Fresno. Police are hoping the arrests will help recovers several unregistered guns and stop the violence in this neighborhood.

Ten O'clock, Jan 9, 2020, 10:00 PM, 02:30, Local: About a year and a half after a man was killed by a driver high on marijuana, that man's family fears they may never see justice. It was the first time Madera County had ever convicted someone for driving under the influence of marijuana. The driver may only go to jail for about four months. This is important to viewers because someone driving under the influence of marijuana may not face a strict enough penalty and that could set a dangerous example for future offenders.

Ten O'clock, Jan 10, 2020, 10:03 PM, 02:17, Local: A woman says a driver cut her off, pretended to be an officer, and tried to get her to come out of her car. This is important to viewers because the imposter is still on the loose and officers would never pull anyone over without flashing their lights first.

Ten O'clock, Jan 11, 2020, 10:01 PM, 01:45, Local: It's been more than a month since a hit-and-run in Selma killed a man. There's been no new leads for police to follow up on for weeks and with no new answers on the hit-and-run, that man's son is pleading for anyone to come forward if they have more information about that incident. This is important to viewers because someone watching could potentially have information for the victim's son and for Selma police.

Ten O'clock, Jan 12, 2020, 10:02 PM, :25, Local: The Fresno County Sheriff's Office says a man was shot and killed in Southeast Fresno. The gunman is still on the run. This is important to viewers because someone watching could possibly provide information about the shooting and may have info that could lead to an arrest.

Ten O'clock, Jan 16, 2020, 10:06 PM, 02:24, Local: The Madera County Sheriff's Office says deputies have caught the man responsible for the October 2019 murder of a 16-year-old girl. The man that deputies arrested had no criminal history before but now has several felony charges from two different agencies. This is important to viewers because it's a positive update and it will provide a sense of peace and justice to the victim's family.

Great Day, Jan 17, 2020, 05:17 AM, :55, Local: The Madera County Sheriff's department says a 19-year-old former marine is responsible for killing a 16-year-old in Madera last year. Now, investigators say the 19-year-old may have used social media to contact other young girls too. Deputies are asking anyone who was contacted by the former marine to call them right away. This is important for people in our area to know about so they can help the county make its case and keep this from happening to anyone else.

Ten O'clock, Jan 17, 2020, 10:01 PM, 02:00, Local: Thieves are smashing their way into stores and loading up as many cigarettes as they can. Fresno Police say it's because of the rising costs of cigarettes due to a higher tax in California. They've become a lot more valuable so thieves are targeting them so that they can flip them either on the street or to another business owner to try and resell them. This is important to viewers because the thieves are still on the run and anyone watching could possibly identify the thieves and turn them in.

Midday, Jan 20, 2020, 11:31 AM, :36, Local: A man is dead after a high-speed chase through Fresno and into Madera county ended in a high-flying crash. Police say the car officers were chasing hit up to 110 mph. The road the driver was on makes a hard-right turn, but the driver instead drove his car off a canal bank, launched more than 400 feet through the air, clearing the San Joaquin river.

Ten O'clock, Jan 20, 2020, 10:01 PM, :25, Local: A shooting near a homeless shelter in Fresno, California left three people injured. This is important to viewers because the shooter is still on the loose and someone watching could possibly have more information on the incident.

Midday, Jan 23, 2020, 11:58 AM, :36, Local: Fresno police are searching for two people they say robbed a Pier One Imports in north Fresno this morning. Employees told officers that two Hispanic men walked in with a gun and demanded money from a safe. Investigators say the robbers got away with money and an item belonging to one of the employees. This story is important because it is unusual. Officers say it is weird that the robbers would target a furniture store, especially on unloading day. Police are now looking at the surveillance footage.

Great Day, Jan 24, 2020, 06:08 AM, :48, Local: The Kings County Sheriff's Department is now using technology called "Smartwater CSI" to help track down ag thieves. The move was inspired by a decrease in property thefts in Tulare County after the Sheriff's office in that county started using the technology. This is an important crime update for viewers in the agricultural business who may be vulnerable to ag thefts.

Ten O'clock, Jan 24, 2020, 10:05 PM, 02:08, Local: A landscaper who works for FOX26 had his landscaping equipment stolen while working outside the TV station. This is important to viewers because the thieves took advantage of the opportunity in broad daylight to steal the equipment. This could happen anywhere and it's a good lesson to always keep valuable equipment locked up at all times.

Ten O'clock, Jan 25, 2020, 10:02 PM, :30, Local: A six-year-old girl is in the hospital after being shot in the shoulder. It's unknown who shot her, but she wasn't the target. Police say they think there was some sort of argument that led to gunfire within the apartment complex where she and her friend were playing. This is important to viewers because police are still trying to find out more information about the shooting and someone watching could potentially have valuable information that could lead to an arrest.

Ten O'clock, Jan 29, 2020, 10:02 PM, 02:12, Local: A man in Fresno, California says he got a call from PG&E saying that his bill was overdue, and his power could be shut off. The call turned out to be a scam. This is important to viewers because too many people fall for these kinds of scams and it's necessary to report on what to look out for in scam calls.

Ten O'clock, Jan 30, 2020, 10:08 PM, 01:53, Local: A man in Madera County is looking for his stolen scooter. The thief was caught on surveillance video coming up and stealing the scooter from his driveway. This is important to viewers because the thief was caught on camera and someone watching could possibly identify the thief.

Ten O'clock, Feb 2, 2020, 10:03 PM, 01:00, Local: Police were out all over the valley looking for people who may have been driving under the influence. They are patrolling to try and attempt to keep people on the road safe from accidents. This is important because not only are you putting people in danger when you drive under the influence, but you will also face a large fine and possibly jail time if you are caught by police.

Great Day, Feb 3, 2020, 09:08 AM, :40, Local: One woman is dead, and five others are hurt after a shooting on a Greyhound bus over the grapevine. It happened overnight in Lebec, which is south of Bakersfield. Officers say when the shooting started, the bus driver pulled over. The shooter then got off the bus and left the gun behind. Officers say the shooter is in custody. This story is important for viewers in our area because the shooting happened close to the Central Valley. Many people use these buses to cross the grapevine to get to, or come from, Los Angeles.

Midday, Feb 4, 2020, 11:30 AM, :20, Local: A 24-year-old man is now behind bars after Corcoran police found him inside a parked car with a minor under the age of 14. Officers say Jose Rodriguez got in touch with the child via social media and arranged to meet for sexual purposes. He is now facing several sex crime charges. This story is important for viewers because it serves as a reminder for parents to make sure they know who their child is talking to online.

Ten O'clock, Feb 5, 2020, 10:11 PM, :26, Local: A teacher's aide in Mendota was arrested for having sex with a 16-year-old boy. Investigators said that they arrested the 42-year-old and are accusing her of having a sexual relationship with the boy. She had been working as an instructional aide for the Mendota school distract when it happened, and she gave a full confession. This is important because people need to be able to talk with their kids about the dangers of this kind of thing.

Midday, Feb 12, 2020, 11:36 AM, :26, Local: A Madera Ranchos woman is now convicted of torturing and murdering her adopted daughter. Amy Chavoya was arrested back in 2015. Prosecutors say the abuse began ten years ago, when she started fostering two children. She was eventually allowed to adopt them both. She now faces life in prison.

Ten O'clock, Feb 12, 2020, 10:04 PM, :47, Local: A man was caught on camera stealing eyeglasses and sunglasses from a Fresno Optometrist's office. The man was seen scooping frames into a trash can before leaving, more than 80 frames were stolen, totaling between 18 and 19 thousand dollars. This is important because this man is still out there, and people are looking for anyone with information to call them.

Great Day, Feb 13, 2020, 05:08 AM, 00:27, Local: State lawmakers are taking aim at package thieves hoping to increase punishments for repeat offenders. If the new proposal passes the state senate, repeat offenders could be charged with a felony after their third offense in three years. The bill would also increase sentences to up to three years in prison. This is important for people in our area to know so they are aware of what our elected officials are working on.

Ten O'clock, Feb 13, 2020, 10:11 PM, :43, Local: Reedley Police busted a crew that carried out several break-ins in the area. They are now hoping to find the owners of the stolen items that were recovered. This is important because if you were the victim of a break-in then your stuff may have been recovered by the police.

Midday, Feb 14, 2020, 11:33 AM, :23, Local: A detentions deputy with the Kings County sheriff's office is now under arrest after detectives say he secretly Recorded sex videos with a woman and then sent those videos to someone else. Investigators say the woman he Recorded had no idea it was happening. Detectives also say the deputy was also harassing the woman who he sent the videos too. That deputy is now on administrative leave while the investigation continues.

Ten O'clock, Feb 14, 2020, 10:02 PM, :21, Local: Fresno Police are searching for a man who robbed a Chevron station at gunpoint. He ran in and demanded money from the employee before running out. Luckily, no one was hurt in the robbery, but the man is still on the loose. There was another similar burglary later that night, but police are unsure if the two are related. This is important because this man is still out there, and he may dangerous.

Ten O'clock, Feb 15, 2020, 10:01 PM, :23, Local: Sanger Police say that a shooting between two groups in vehicles could have been because of road rage. Two people were driving when another group pulled up next to them and started to shoot at their car. One person was hit but they ran away and asked a stranger for help. This is important because police are still looking for those involved in this shooting.

Ten O'clock, Feb 16, 2020, 10:03 PM, :25, Local: A 19-year-old was shot multiple times and rushed to an area hospital. Fresno Police are asking anyone with information about this shooting to please call them. This is important because whoever shot the person is still out there.

Great Day, Feb 17, 2020, 05:06 AM, 01:00, Local: The hunt is now on for a shooter or shooters who attacked a 19-year-old in Northwest Fresno. Officers say the teenager is now recovering in a nearby hospital. This is important for people in our area to know as police are asking anyone with information about the shooting to help with the investigation.

Great Day, Feb 18, 2020, 06:07 AM, 01:20, Local: Multiple businesses in North Fresno are on high alert after a string of burglaries in the area. This is an important crime alert for viewers as investigators are asking for anyone with information to contact them.

Great Day, Feb 19, 2020, 05:02 AM, 00:40, Local: The hunt is still on for a pair of men wanted by police for robbing several Fresno businesses last week. Officers say surveillance video shows the men pulling out guns and demanding cash. Ten O'clock, Mar 21, 2020, 10:00 PM, :34, Local: There were two shootings in Fresno tonight and police are asking for anyone with information on either to call the Fresno Police Department. One teenager was shot in the face and one man was shot in a drive-by shooting. This is important because police are looking for information in both of these shootings.

Ten O'clock, Mar 24, 2020, 10:01 PM, 01:30, Local: A police chase in Fresno led to a shootout between the officers, those in the car, and a citizen with a CCW. Two men in a car ran from police, they began to shoot at the police and the police fired back, A citizen shot one of the men in the chest and tackled him so police could arrest him, police are still looking for the second man. This is important because police are still looking for another suspect and he may be dangerous.

Ten O'clock, Mar 28, 2020, 10:00 PM, :36, Local: A suspected D.U.I. driver caused a multi-car crash on the highway. The driver was driving erratically and rear-ended a car which led to multiple cars crashing and one car catching on fire. This is important because it shows the danger of driving while under the influence.

#### **ECONOMY**

#### **EDUCATION**

Great Day, Jan 7, 2020, 06:07 AM, :19, Local: A new agriculture and technology building is set to be unveiled at Madera City College this week. The building cost nearly a half-billion dollars with funding provided by Measure C. This is an important news update for viewer as more projects are planned for community college campuses in Madera, Fresno, Reedley, Clovis and Oakhurst.

Great Day, Jan 14, 2020, 05:08 AM, :47, Local: Fairmont Elementary School is now planning to build a new state of the art ag complex. The project will cost around \$5 million across a two-acre plot next to the school. The new complex will include a science lab, an animal lab, and a water energy and technology lab. This is important for people in our area to know about because the school is taking donations to raise funds for the new complex, which will help to educate future farmers here in our area.

Midday, Jan 15, 2020, 11:39 AM, :26, Local: The Merced county library is launching a six-month pilot program to allow five of its branches to stay open past 6:00 p.m. This is important for viewers in our area because many people, especially children rely on service offered by public libraries.

Ten O'clock, Feb 25, 2020, 10:12 PM, :2:07, Local: The school board in Selma voted to cut several positions today. Several teachers found out that they would soon be unemployed, however, the cuts were not as large as the board initially proposed. This is important because these budget cuts are going to affect a lot of people.

Great Day, Mar 9, 2020, 06:05 AM, :39, Local: The Clovis Unified School District says it is taking extra precautions to protect students from the Coronavirus. The district says its classrooms, common spaces and restrooms are now deep-cleaned every night. This is an important alert for viewers in our area who may have children in the district and are concerned about their safety.

Great Day, Mar 27, 2020, 06:08 AM, :16, Local: More valley school districts are extending campus closures because of the Coronavirus. Central, Parlier and Selma Unified now say home-based learning will continue through at least May 1st. Kings Canyon Unified is also keeping its students at home until at least the beginning of May.
