government abuse and misdeeds. Full Measure is produced by and airs nationally on stations of the Sinclair Broadcast Group. This shows airs Sunday 7:00AM (Preempted for kids E/I on several occasions).

Q1-2023 QUARTERLY REPORT: Significant Local News Issues

There follows a listing of some of the significant issues responded to by this station, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period of January 1, 2023 – March 31, 2023. This list is by no means exhaustive. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any priority or significance.

Consumer

Midday, Jan 25, 2023, 11:36 a.m., 00:35, Local: Voters will get to decide whether a council should raise the minimum wage for fast food employees in California. A referendum challenging assembly bill 257 qualified for the ballot next year. Governor Newsom signed the bill into law on Labor Day. It would allow a council to set standards for wages, hours, and working conditions for any restaurant chain with at least 100 locations in the country. It was supposed to take effect on New Year's Day, but restaurant owners and fast food lobbying groups raised more than \$13 million to fight the new law.

Midday, Jan 26, 2023, 11:30 a.m., 00:35, Local: Be careful when using an ATM. A card-skimming device was found on a Bank of America machine this morning. A service technician found the device on one of the drive-thru standalone machines in the parking lot on Shaw avenue near Peach avenue. The technician called Clovis police who say this isn't the first time a skimmer was found at this location. Detectives are now combing over surveillance footage to see if they can find the person who planted the skimmer.

Crime

Ten O'clock News, Jan 8, 2023, 10:04pm, 01:19, Local: A shooting between left one person dead and injured two others. This important to our viewers because it was a young teen that lost his life. Often times we here about shooting cases, but it always seems to hit people harder when it's someone of a young age, they want answers, and as a news outlet we help get them those answers.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 10, 2023, 10:01pm, 01:02, Local: Police released video today of two people intentionally set a strip center on fire. We reported on the initial fire last week, not knowing the cause. Now, police are looking for the people in the video suspected of arson. This is a follow up story and lets those who lost their businesses in the fire that we are not forgetting about them.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 13, 2023, 10:07pm, 00:32, Local: A man was shot and killed by deputies. The sheriff's office says the man tried to set his apartment complex on fire and held his own child hostage. Deputies tell us they shot and killed the man as he was holding the kid captive. Our market is seeing a small increase in the number of law enforcement official involved shootings. Our coverage lets people know that officers will use force if needed, especially in stressful situations.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 22, 2023, 10pm, 03:54, Local: A man kills 10 and injuries 10 at a Chinese New Years celebration. This is important to our viewers because it was the biggest story of the day nationwide, and everyone wanted answers as to what happened, and we were able to provide them updates. This was relevant to our market because we are close to the area, many people in our area now are from that area, and our very own anchor dad was the mayor of that area. It was also the first homicide that had in over a year. We also localized the story - was able to get an interview with a person who lived just two streets from the incident.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 23, 2023, 10:00pm, 01:18, Local: 7 people were shot and killed by the same gunman in separate shootings in Half Moon Bay, CA. San Mateo County sheriff's deputies were able to arrest the suspect without incident. An 8th person is in the hospital with major injuries. This mass shooting comes after a gunman shot and killed 10 people just 2 days ago in Southern California. These 2 tragedies are devastating not just for the communities where they happened, but for California as a whole. We are seeing a rise in gun violence in our own market, so these two shootings reflect this unfortunate trend.

Great Day, Jan 23, 2023, 8:03 a.m., 00:18, Local: A man is now recovering after a stabbing in northwest Fresno. It happened near 'fountain' way and Tielman avenue yesterday afternoon. Officers say the 31-year-old who was stabbed did not want to go to the hospital and refused to cooperate with the investigation. Officers say the man is in stable condition.

Great Day, Jan 24, 2023, 8:02 a.m., 00:21, Local: Three teenagers are now in the hospital after police say they were stabbed in a fight in southeast Fresno. Police were called to a disturbance near 'chance' and 'Woodrow' yesterday afternoon. Officers tell us four teenage boys were fighting when one stabbed the other three. They are expected to recover.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 25, 2023, 10:01pm, 02:05, Local: Madera Police Department looking for two men who stole and damaged a local business. We got surveillance footage to show the viewers who they can look out for, and what the suspects look like. This happened in our area so it's likely the suspects are still in the area or someone will recognize the men and will be able to help the police catch them.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 28, 2023, 10:01pm, 05:39, Local: Memphis police officers have disbanded the Scorpio unit following the release of the body cam footage of Tyre Nicholas. Officials and community members want another look at the police reform and for new implements to but enforced. This is a follow up to the released of the body cam footage and protest that took place yesterday.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 31, 2023, 10:01pm, 02:31, Local: A Selma police officer was shot and killed while responding to a disturbance today. The suspect was caught and arrested. He has not been identified. This is not only a big story because an officer was shot, but because it is the first time a police officer has been killed while in the line of duty in Selma's history. Some people are very supportive of law enforcement, so this story draws at their heart strings.

Great Day, Feb 2, 2023, 8:02 a.m., 00:21, Local: A man is now hurt after he was hit by a car in southwest Fresno. Police say they got calls about a man lying in the street near marks and olive around five this morning. He was taken to community medical center... And his condition is unknown right now. Officers say the driver who hit the man took off. No one is under arrest. Traffic is now flowing again at marks avenue.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 7, 2023, 10:04pm, 00:34, Local: A man was arrested 8 months after police say he tried to kill someone. Today, the man was found at a home in a town in our area. The county's swat team was requested in order to arrest him. This story shows local law enforcement held people accountable no matter how long ago a crime occurred. People in our area want to know if law enforcement is not forgetting about victims.

Great Day, Feb 7, 2023, 8:03 a.m., 00:23, Local: Police are now looking for a man accused of stabbing a family member in southeast Fresno. Officers say they found a man who was stabbed and hit in the head with a bottle after a fight at an apartment complex near 'lane and 'winery' around nine last night. Detectives say he was taken to the hospital and is expected to recover. No one is under arrest. If you know anything... Please call the Fresno police department.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 11, 2023, 10:01PM, 02:01, Local: A Parlier 13-year-old student was walking home from school died after getting hit by a car. This story is important to remind people of the dangers of speeding and not watching out for pedestrians especially in school zones and to draw attention to the town's complaints about the intersection where the student was hit. This story is relevant because it was in the area and it's not the first time this type of incident has happened this year.

Great Day, Feb 14, 2023, 8:05 a.m., 00:20, Local: Two men are now behind bars, accused of stealing bags of dog food in Madera. Police were called to a burglary at 'tractor supply' early yesterday morning. They were stopped and arrested. Both men are now being held on a 50-thousand-dollar bail.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 16, 2023, 10pm, 06:01, Local: Today the central valley came together to lay fallen Officer Gonzalo Carrasco to rest. This is a follow up to all the coverage of the officer who died while on duty. The story of the officer passing drew national attention, and even police officers from other departments and other states came to the valley to honor and pay tribute to Officer Gonzalo Carrasco.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 19, 2023, 10:02PM, 00:22, Local: A man from Fresno was shot and killed while visiting in Pismo Beach. This was a big headline story as this was Pismo first homicide in 17 years and Pismo a beach that people from the valley travel to often. This is relevant to our viewers as the victim was from the area and was visiting a place that many of us go to, and maybe someone who knew the victim might have more information to give the police to help them close a case.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 20, 2023, 10:03pm, 01:15, Local: Two men were shot and killed Sunday night outside a Northwest Fresno hookah lounge. Officers tell us the two victims were fighting before shots rang out. Police have not arrested anyone in connection to this crime. Officers say they may start policing hookah lounges differently soon after a recent string of violence at these establishments.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 1, 2023, 10PM, 03:30, Local: The man who is a suspect for sever different bombings in a span of three months was arrested, and officials think there are more bombs out there. This is important to our viewers for them to be aware because bombs pose as a serious threat, and that's something they need to have in mind. This is relevant to our market because it's happening in Fresno and affecting our viewers as they are the ones who are the victims of these bombs

Ten O'clock News, Mar 2, 2023, 10:01pm, 00:25, Local: A man was found shot in a rural part of our viewing area. Fresno County Sheriff's deputies found the man and made sure he was taken to the hospital. the victim's condition is unknown. This story is part of a larger uptick in violence that we're seeing in our viewing area. Our coverage lets people know that the problem is still here, and that it is happening in even rural areas.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 3, 2023, 10:01pm, 00:32, Local: Two men are now in the hospital, suffering from gunshot wounds. The victims were found tonight in a rural farming community 45 minutes from our city. The town is in our viewing area, so is close enough to a large populous that people will feel that it happened close to home. No one has been arrested, which makes this shooting even more pressing. Our coverage lets people know a shooter is still on the loose, so they may be at risk of being hurt.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 4, 2023, 10PM, 01:30, Local: A man was shot and killed during an officer involved shooting in Fresno. This is important to our viewers as it happened in an area where there were a lot of people, and roads were going to be closed through the night and in the morning, which would affect people's commute. An officer on duty was also hit with gunfire and being that the central valley just recently lost an officer on duty, this story caught a lot of attention of our viewers.

Great Day, Mar 6, 2023, 7:04 a.m., 00:33, Local: A man is now recovering after getting shot while on a walk in Central Fresno. It happened near Lewis Ave. and Thesta St. yesterday afternoon. A man walking in the area told officers he was hit in the foot and arm. Investigators say a dark-colored car was seen driving away from the area. If you know anything, you're asked to call the Fresno Police Department.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 11, 2023, 10:01pm, 00:38, Local: In the northern Central Valley, Atwater was faced with their first homicide of the year. This is important to our viewers because deputies are looking for a suspect, so the more people who are aware could help officers create a case. This is relevant to our viewers as it happened in our area.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 12, 2023, 10:01pm, 01:18, Local: The small town of Del Rey faced with their first homicide of the year. This is important to our viewers because deputies are looking for a suspect, so the more people who are aware could help officers create a case. This is relevant to our viewers as it happened in our area.

Great Day, Mar 14, 2023, 7:08 a.m., 00:33, Local: A man is now in the hospital after a drive-by shooting in Southeast Fresno. Officers tell us he was shot while standing near a window at his home near 11th and Vine just before 2:30 yesterday afternoon. His condition is unknown this morning. A black car was seen leaving the area shortly after shots were heard. Anyone with information is asked to call the Fresno Police Department.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 16, 2023, 10:14pm, 02:05, Local: A family is breaking the silence on their daughter's murder case and raising the award amount to six thousand dollars. It's a follow up from a story we have done in the past, and it's reminding people of what happened. It's important because oftentimes our news stories help capture the bad guys, and in this case, officers are still looking for a suspect, and a suspect needs to be found for this family to have closure.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 19, 2023, 10:03PM, 01:34, Local: An officer involved shooting leaves one man dead in Southwest Fresno. It happened at the police station too. This is important to our viewers because the man died at the hands of people who are supposed to save lives so community members are going to want to know the details of what led up to the shooting, and we are able to provide them with that information. This is relevant to our market because it happened in our area.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 20, 2023, 10:01pm, 00:48, Local: A standoff is now over in Fresno after police say a man they wanted to arrest, killed himself. It all started when officers responded to a fight at a home. Once there, detectives went to the home, only to be shot at by a man inside. Eventually, police learned the gunman shot and killed himself. No one, but the suspect, was hurt. Nearby residents were asked to stay inside their homes during this incident. This story involves police getting involved in a deadly incident. This is a disturbing trend we're seeing across our viewing area.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 29, 2023, 10:04PM, 02:00, Local: A high school teacher and his student get into a fight at school. This is relevant to our market as we continuous report on Crisis in the Classroom, whether it's violence, gender or education related. This is important to our viewers because it's not the first time something like this has happened, we often hear about these things nationally or between students and now it's a local story and an it's more than just a fight.

Midday, Jan 2, 2023, 11:31 a.m., 00:30, Local: A man is now in custody after police say he fired a gun outside of a home at the beginning of the new year. Police found 41 casings on the ground near the driveway of the house. Officers say they seized a semi-automatic rifle.

Great Day, Jan 2, 2023, 8:02 a.m., 00:25, Local: Fresno is now reporting its first homicide of the year. It happened in the northwest part of town. Police say they found a man in his 30's shot multiple times near fruit and west Saginaw way around 5 last night.

Great Day, Jan 3, 2023, 7:04 a.m., 00:33, Local: A man is now dead after a shooting in West Fresno. Officers found a man who was shot at an apartment complex off Blythe and Austin around 4:30 yesterday afternoon. He was rushed to the hospital, but he died. We're told the gunshot came from a neighboring apartment. No one is under arrest. Anyone with information is urged to call the Fresno Police Department.

Great Day, Jan 3, 2023, 8:01 a.m., 00:17, Local: Detectives are now looking for witnesses in a deadly shooting in southeast Fresno. Police say they found the body of 40-year-old Luis 'Alberto Castillo' on 'Jackson' avenue, north of 'turner' on Friday night.

Great Day, Jan 9, 2023, 7:10 a.m., 00:25, Local: A husband and wife are now in the hospital after getting shot in the legs while they were sleeping in their bed. It happened just before 4:30 near Iowa Avenue in Southeast Fresno. They were taken to CRMC and are expected to recover.

Great Day, Jan 11, 2023, 8:02 a.m., 00:35, Local: A man is now behind bars after a hit- and- run in central Fresno. It happened just before three this morning near 'McKinley' and 'first'. Police say a car was heading north on 'first street' and was hit by a pickup truck that ran through a red light on 'McKinley'. The two men inside the car were taken to c-r-m-c. Officials are saying the passenger is in critical condition right now.

Midday, Jan 18, 2023, 11:30 a.m., 00:35, Local: Two teen boys are now recovering in a hospital after a fight turned into a stabbing right outside of Fresno High School. Fresno police say four teens were involved. Officers say one of the teens was stabbed in the upper body. The other was stabbed in the lower body. Both are expected to recover.

Great Day, Jan 18, 2023, 8:02 a.m., 00:17, Local: A man is now facing murder charges, accused of stabbing a man to death while watching a football game. This 43-year-old surrendered to Fresno County sheriff's deputies yesterday. Deputies say he started fighting with a man on Saturday while watching an n-f-l playoff game. The man was stabbed several times... And died. The accused stabber's bail is one-million dollars.

Midday, Jan 23, 2023, 11:33 a.m., 00:30, Local: A man is now under arrest after Corcoran police say he walked into a home and exposed himself to a person inside. Later that same night, officers say he circled another home and broke into the backyard. That is where they say he was peeping into bedroom windows. Police say the homeowner confronted him and was able to keep him there until officers arrived to arrest him. He is now booked into the Kings county jail.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 30, 2023, 10:01pm, 02:51, Local: The Tulare county sheriff is asking Governor Gavin Newsom to execute the person responsible for killing 6 people a few weeks ago in Goshen. The killer still has not been caught, but deputies tell us they are close to making an arrest. No one has been executed in California since 2006, but the sheriff is asking that this killer be put to death because one of the 6 victims was a child. the sheriff says the state should execute people who kill children. Because 6 people were shot and killed, it is getting attention from across the country. This aggressive call from the sheriff in this case is the latest update in this case.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 3, 2023, 10:10pm, 05:42, Local: The Tulare county sheriff's office announced today its deputies, along with other law enforcement agencies, arrested two men in connection to a mass shooting from January. During that incident, deputies claim the men shot and killed six people. This massacre happened in a small town, making the crime all the more surprising. Since the shootings took place, we have covered numerous press conferences, covering all updates. Our coverage of this story will continue as the suspects are arraigned and, possibly, sentenced.

Midday, Feb 3, 2023, 11:30 a.m., 08:00, Local: Nathaniel Dixon is now accused of killing a Selma police officer. The Fresno county sheriff's office held a news conference of the killing of officer Gonzalo Carrasco Jr. live on Midday. Dixon made his first court appearance this morning. He is charged with five counts, including first degree murder.

Midday, Feb 7, 2023, 11:30 a.m., 00:30, Local: A sex offender out of Riverdale is wanted for failing to register his new address. Fresno county sheriff's detectives say Jose Ramos is required by law to update his information with law enforcement. He is 64-years-old with gray hair and eyes, and he may have a mustache. If you know where he is, call the Fresno county sheriff's office.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 8, 2023, 10pm, 03:32, Local: An elderly man was attacked in the front of his house by a stranger. This is important to our viewers because it could happen to anyone. This is relevant to our station because it's an exclusive story.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 13, 2023, 10:03pm, 03:22, Local: One person was killed, and another was killed during a street race in a busy Fresno area. This crash comes after much legislation has been passed to cut down on this practice. One of the drivers involved in this crash has yet to be caught. People care about this story because two of the people hurt had nothing to do with the race. Our coverage shows how dangerous street racing can be.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 15, 2023, 10:02pm, 03:44, Local: Fresno county is warning city residents to expect traffic delays for tomorrow's police officer funeral. Thousands are expected to attend the morning service, so law enforcement is shutting down roads to allow for vehicles to attend the event. The funeral is happening during people's morning commute, so thousands will be impacted by these delays. Our coverage lets people know there will be delays, so they will know to leave for work tomorrow earlier than usual.

Midday, Feb 16, 2023, 11:30 a.m., 03:00, Local: Thousands are gathered in downtown Fresno for a service in honor of Selma police officer Gonzalo Carrasco Jr., who was shot and killed in the line of duty. The funeral service wrapped up moments ago.

"Ten O'clock News, Feb 17, 2023, 10:03PM, 02:21, Local: California sheriff study found that America's crime wave is connected to suspects released on low or no bail.

This is important to our viewers as some say it create a loop hole for repeat offenders. California is home to thousands of prisoners, some of which prisons are over populated. So, this raises questions to our viewers safety, and their votes which is why it's relevant to them because it affects them in some sort of way whether they are for or against the no bail.

Midday, Feb 20, 2023, 11:30 a.m., 00:40, Local: One person is now under arrest in connection to the killing of bishop David O'Connell. Police say he was shot in the chest in his home on Saturday. He served the Los Angeles area for more than 45 years. Bishop Brennan of the Diocese of Fresno worked closely with O'Connell. Hie released a statement saying he was an extraordinary man who touched the lives of many and had a great passion for ministering to the disenfranchised and immigrant communities.

Great Day, Feb 20, 2023, 8:02 a.m., 00:13, Local: Police are searching for a person who robbed a massage parlor. It happened around 9:45 last night near Clovis Ave and Griffith. Police say someone forced their way into the massage parlor and took a couple hundred dollars.

Great Day, Feb 22, 2023, 8:05 a.m., 00:15, Local: An officer is now recovering in the hospital after getting rear-ended. Investigators say he was directing traffic near Belmont and maple after a fallen tree caused a crash in the area. Officials say a woman was speeding and crashed into the officer's car.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 23, 2023, 10:05pm, 00:27, Local: A man accused of killing a cop in a nearby town was arraigned today. He pleaded not guilty to several charges, including first degree murder. Because the man being charged is accused of shooting and killing a police officer, this has become a high-profile case. We have covered this case since the day the shooting happened. There is no word on when he will be in court again.

Great Day, Feb 23, 2023, 8:06 a.m., 00:19, Local: Deputies in Merced County are now looking for two men who they say tried to steal an a-t-m. Sheriff's deputies went to a burglary call at a chevron gas station along highway 59 in Snelling. They say surveillance video shows the two men going into the store and stealing several items off shelves. We're told the men were not able to get away with the machine.

Midday, Feb 24, 2023, 11:36 a.m., 00:30, Local: The man accused of killing Selma police officer Gonzalo Carrasco Jr. is now pleading not guilty to several charges, including murder. 23-year-old Nathaniel Dixon was arraigned yesterday. He was arrested and booked in the Fresno county jail that afternoon. If convicted on all charges, he faces life in prison without the possibility of parole or the death penalty.

Great Day, Feb 27, 2023, 8:04 a.m., 00:17, Local: Tulare county sheriff's deputies are now trying to find four accused armed robbers. Investigators tell us the accused robbers walked into the valley fuel on avenue 196 in Plainview and demanded money from the clerk. No one is hurt. But if you know anything about this robbery... You're asked to please contact the Tulare County sheriff's office.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 6, 2023, 10:01pm, 02:17, Local: A man was shot and killed by Fresno police over the weekend. Police say the man fired at them which is why they were justified in shooting him. The California DOJ says the suspect never had a gun, and questions PD's judgement in shooting the suspect. This controversy, while originally just local, is turning into a statewide story. This debate over what was found at the scene of the crime will either make the DOJ or the police look bad.

Great Day, Mar 14, 2023, 6:05 a.m., 00:26, Local: A man is now in the hospital after a drive-by shooting in southeast Fresno. Officers tell us a man was shot while standing near a window at his home near '11th' and 'vine' just before two-30 yesterday afternoon. That's a few blocks east of highway 99. He was taken to a hospital... His condition is not known this morning.

Great Day, Mar 22, 2023, 8:04 a.m., 00:22, Local: The hunt is now on the person responsible for a deadly shooting in downtown Hanford. Officers say a white b-m-w sedan was seen leaving the area after the shooting. It happened near Phillips Street and highway 198 back in November. Detectives tell us they found a man who had been shot. He was taken to a hospital... He died.

Great Day, Mar 24, 2023, 8:04 a.m., 00:23, Local: The search is now on for the person accused of shooting a teenager in central Fresno. Officers say they found the teenager near Diana Street just north of Illinois avenue yesterday afternoon. We're told people were walking when shots were fired, hitting the teen. The teen was taken to a hospital and is expected to recover.

Great Day, Mar 28, 2023, 7:05 a.m., 00:40, Local: A man is now in a hospital after a shooting at a gas station in Central Fresno. Police say they found a man who was shot in a Valero parking lot off Ashlan and Blackstone just after seven last night. Witnesses told detectives about an argument between two groups in a nearby parking lot. No one is under arrest. Anyone with information is urged to call the Fresno Police department.

Four men in black hoodies went inside a jewelry store near Herndon and Cedar early last month. One was captured on camera holding the clerk at gunpoint while three others went behind the counter and grabbed several items. We're told they left in a white GMC pickup. Anyone with information is asked to call the Fresno police department.

Education

Midday, Feb 2, 2023, 11:30 a.m., 04:00, Local: The Catholic Diocese of Fresno is preparing for a Mass of dedication for Sant Charles Borromeo this afternoon. We went live at the church, which seats 3,200 people.

Midday, Feb 14, 2023, 11:36 a.m., 00:30, Local: A Selma elementary school is now recognizing the police department for its service. It comes two weeks after officer Gonzalo Carrasco, Jr was shot and killed in the line of duty. The shooting happened less than a mile from Eric White elementary school. Students represented all of Selma unified at a presentation in honor of fallen officer Carrasco.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 5, 2023, 10:02PM, 02:15, Local: A foreign exchange student from Ukraine is in the valley for longer than anticipated because of the war in Ukraine, and her Visa is expiring soon, she has no money, and wants to continue to go to college in the U.S. The story is important because the valley is an area where exchange students come often and now this exchange student is almost graduating and may not have no home to return to. The teenage girl is stuck and needs the help of her community, and our coverage is getting her story out there.

Environment

Ten O'clock News, Mar 10, 2023, 10:04pm, 00:38, Local: A county in our viewing area issued evacuation orders for several communities in its jurisdiction. This comes after the same county issued several warnings, which are a lower level of precaution before a storm. The orders come as heavy rainfall makes it way to our market. Our coverage lets people know in the communities being ordered to evacuate that they need to leave their homes as soon as possible.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 4, 2022, 10:08pm, 01:55, Local: This story is informing viewers where all the rain water goes, as California - the Central Valley - is very agriculture based and has been in a drought for a few years now. It's important to our viewers because of our drought issue and our agricultural needs. This is relevant to our market because of the impact rainwater has on the state for growers and communities.

Midday, Jan 4, 2023, 11:34 a.m., 00:20, Local: Highway 168 at the bottom of the four-lane is now back open. A rockslide forced the closure on Saturday. Geologists spent the rest of the day evaluating the rockslide. The agency says a scaling team rappelled down and removed loose rocks. A temporary concrete barrier is being place adjacent to the fallen rocks. One-way traffic control is now in effect.

Great Day, Jan 4, 2023, 7:04 a.m., 00:42, Local: Water from recent rain is now streaming down into Fresno canals. The excess water winds up in Fresno Irrigation District recharge basins west of Highway 99. The irrigation district has 35 basins stretching from Easton to Kerman. It's been dripping into the underground table since 2005 and amounts to slightly more than what Millerton Lake holds. FID plans to add another dozen recharge basins in the next decade.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 5, 2023, 10:05pm, 02:22, Local: A bomb cyclone has made its way to the coast, forcing many people from their homes and businesses. One of the areas hit by the storm is a beach town frequented by many people in our market. Our story looked at the damage the town is seeing. This coverage brings to light how bad the storm has been for coastal towns and could hopefully show that this town needs help rebuilding.

Midday, Jan 5, 2023, 11:33 a.m., 00:30, Local: California is now under a state of emergency because of the ongoing storm. Governor Newsom says flood operations center is working to help families beef up homes from flood damage by providing sandbags. The risk of flash flooding could stay high across the state into next week. The national guard is also mobilizing to support disaster relief efforts.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 9, 2023, 10:07pm, 00:26, Local: State highway agency closed a local highway after rain caused a rockslide to cover the road. This closure comes a little more than a week after another similar incident also shut down the highway. This road is used by many in our area to access the more mountainous regions of our market. There's no word on when the road will reopen.

Midday, Jan 10, 2023, 11:30 a.m., 00:45, Local: Parts of Merced county are under mandatory evacuation orders or evacuation warnings. That includes areas along Bear Creek. This comes after major flooding in the community of Planada. Sheriff Warnke says he expects another 24-48 hours of rising water. Emergency crews are now trying to get people stranded in their homes to safety.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 11, 2023, 10:07pm, 00:47, Local: National Guard is searching for a boy after he was swept away from floodwaters. Across the state people are hearing about floods, mudslides, sinkholes, and avalanches taking the lives of innocent people, and now another life could have been taken, one closer to home. The story draws a lot of attention to the parental choice the mother made when her son was swept away from her hand. Several hundreds of people are searching through floodwaters and the mom is now sharing what led up to her son being swept away. the story is making people aware of how dangerous to travel during flood warnings as well as allows them to also be on the lookout.

Midday, Jan 12, 2023, 11:34 a.m., 00:45, Local: The series of storms hitting the San Joaquin Valley is having a big impact on the drought outlook. Just last month, the Central Valley and much of the state was in the exceptional drought category. Many parts of the Valley are now upgrades to severe drought. Climate experts and meteorologists say more precipitation is needed to completely move the state out of ongoing drought conditions altogether.

Midday, Jan 17, 2023, 11:39 a.m., 00:30, Local: if you want to visit Sequoia National Park, you're going to need to wait. The General's Highway is now closed above the foothill's visitor center due to snow. If you do visit the park, carry chains. In some areas, these precautions are mandatory even if you have all-wheel drive.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 18, 2023, 10:01pm, 02:10, Local: Residents of small mountain community are now trapped after the route they use to get to and from the town, was destroyed by recent flooding. Because the primary road is no longer functional, many are struggling to perform day-to-day tasks, such as going to work and buying groceries. This story is more extreme than other cases we've seen, but it is not an abortion considering our market is experiencing historic amounts of rain. Our coverage lets members of the community know they have not been forgotten, and that we, as a station, are trying to bring light to the situation.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 19, 2023, 10:01pm, 03:18, Local: President Biden sees the damage left behind in California from recent storm, as well as touches on the missing child. This is important to our viewers because just last week president Biden approved of federal disaster assistance for the state to help fund the repairs and now, he's in the state seeing the damage first hand. This is relevant to our market because we been following along with all the weather damage across the state, so this is a follow up and update of what's happening

Ten O'clock News, Jan 24, 2023, 10:01pm, 00:34, Local: 15 people were displaced after an apartment fire in Fresno. 1 person was hospitalized but is expected to recover. It is believed that a space heater caused the fire. Fires are a big part of our stations' coverage because wildfires are so rampant in this area. Even though it just rained in our region, stories like this show that even small blazes can turn into something catastrophic.

Midday, Jan 24, 2023, 11:37 a.m., 00:20, Local: Highway 140 on the way to Yosemite National Park is now back open. CHP is carrying out one-way traffic control between Midpines and El Portal. That stretch has been closed for nine days due to a rockslide.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 29, 2023, 10:02pm, 03:06, Local: The national weather service is reporting the San Joaquin valley exceeded the normal amount of rainfall expected in the entire season and in return fire season may start later than normal. Fire season is coming up so we are taking a look at what the future may look like, and how people should prepare themselves.

Midday, Feb 6, 2023, 11:30 a.m., 00:20, Local: A massive fire is under investigation in Visalia. The Tulare county fire department says 1,800 tons of hay caught fire near road 80 around 8:30 a.m. yesterday. Firefighters say the flames could continue to put out smoke for the next few days.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 21, 2023, 10:03pm, 02:19, Local: Heavy wind blowing through our market is knocking over trees and causing thousands of people to lose power. We covered people's homes who were destroyed by trees. Our coverage lets people know that they could be at risk of having their home damaged.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 22, 2023, 10:03pm, 01:18, Local: Our viewing area saw a lot of winter of precipitation today. Some communities saw snow, while others received rain. But most people saw a type of precipitation called graupel. Graupel is a softer form of hail. This type of precipitation is making roads slick, causing crashes and traffic delays. Our coverage lets people know they need to drive safely.

Midday, Feb 22, 2023, 11:34 a.m., 00:25, Local: Strong winds left fallen trees, branches and power lines throughout the San Joaquin Valley. A tree fell on one car near Fresno State. The tree came down on the trunk of the car. The rear end was crushed, but no one was hurt. The driver was trapped until Fresno Fire Department could remove the tree.

Midday, Feb 23, 2023, 11:35 a.m., 00:30, Local: A lot of roads are now closed in and around local national parks, including Sequoia and Kings Canyon national parks. The Generals highway is closed from Hospital Rock to highway 180 due to snow. That is a nearly 40-mile stretch of road. The parks are strongly advising visitors avoid the parks during the active storms.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 25, 2023, 10:06PM, 04:29, Local: Historic rain and snow is taking over most of California due to an ongoing winter storm. This is important to our viewers has people are stuck inside their homes, on the side of freeways, travel is restricted, severe weather warnings are going out. This is relevant to our viewers as it is impacting them and their family whether they are in the same town or just hours apart.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 26, 2023, 10:02pm, 02:37, Local: Road Conditions have worsened overnight due to storms causing several road closures. This is a follow up to other stories we have been doing regarding weather as traveling across the state has been severely impacted. This is relevant to our viewers because they may have had to cancel their plans because of this road closures.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 27, 2023, 10:03pm, 02:22, Local: A group of people was stuck in a cabin, up in the mountains, due to heavy snowfall. The group was not in any danger, but rather spoke to us about the intensity of the precipitation. The area where they were trapped is a popular place for our viewers to visit. Our coverage lets people know what a winter storm in their summer vacation spot is like. Our story also warned people to stay away from the area unless they have the proper gear to get through heavy snow.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 28, 2023, 10:01pm, 02:01, Local: Residents from a lakeside community in our viewing area have been trapped in their homes due to the heavy snowfall. Many residents are without power, leading to potentially dangerous situations for some people. Our coverage lets people, and utilities, that this community needs help. This community is a popular summer swimming hole for many people in our market, so this story lets them know the trouble many are experiencing during the off season.

Midday, Mar 2, 2023, 11:30 a.m., 00:45, Local: The wet weather over the past few weeks has helped the state make strides against the drought. The latest drought monitor report shows a huge change for the San Joaquin Valley. Parts of eastern Fresno, Madera, and Tulare counties now show no drought conditions at all. Mariposa and Tuolumne counties are both out of the drought as well. We are also seeing a big improvement along the coast from Santa Cruz all the way down to Los Angeles. Most California reservoirs are filled with water levels near or above average, but groundwater levels remain low and may take months to recover.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 8, 2023, 10:03pm, 00:54, Local: Several counties in our market are issuing evacuation warnings in preparation for an influx of winter precipitation tomorrow. This is important for our viewers because we're letting them know if they need to look elsewhere for shelter as winter weather moves in. This is relevant to our market because the counties being impacted are in our viewing area.

Midday, Mar 8, 2023, 11:32 a.m., 00:45, Local: The upcoming storm system is expected to bring major flooding. The office of emergency services created a storm response plan. It wants emergency responders and equipment ready in all corners of the county. The big concern is that snow 3,000 ft and below will melt when the warm pacific storm arrives.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 9, 2023, 10:09pm, 02:06, Local: We spoke with a tree grooming business to learn what homeowners need to do to prevent trees from falling on their homes. The groomer said people should monitor trees with shallow roots, and ones that do not have thick trunks. This story lets people know how they can protect their homes ahead of tomorrow's storm.

Midday, Mar 13, 2023, 11:33 a.m., 00:55, Local: Parts of Tulare county remain under an evacuation order right now. Streams and rivers are not just overflowing; three levee breaks also sent water rushing into nearby homes and businesses. It is affecting parts of Exeter, Three Rivers, and Springville. Emergency shelters and temporary evacuation points are open to anyone who needs them.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 14, 2023, 10:12pm, 00:56, Local: 10 people are now displaced after a tree fell on an apartment complex. The tree was knocked over by harsh wind and heavy rainfall. Firefighters say no one was hurt, but it will take a long time before the complex is repaired. Our viewing area is expected to see more rain and wind in the coming days, so this will likely not be the last story we cover of a tree falling on a home. Our coverage lets people take caution around large trees with skinny trunks.

Midday, Mar 14, 2023, 11:31 a.m., 00:30, Local: Two large trees fell in north Fresno. One crushed a couple vehicles, the other landed on a two-story apartment complex. We took viewers live to the scene. Our photographer at the scene says crews are in route to cut the trees.

Midday, Mar 16, 2023, 11:32 a.m., 00:35, Local: The latest drought monitor shows the state's condition is improving due to all the wet weather. Almost 18% of California moved from the abnormally dry category to no drought, including Fresno county. Tulare and Inyo counties also show no drought conditions. About 56% of the state still falls under a drought classification. That compares to 100% under severe or exceptional drought.

Ten O'clock News Mar 18, 2023, 10:03PM, 02:53, Local: Several streaks were in the sky, and people were posting their concerns. This is important because it's not long after the Chinese Sky Balloon, so more people are more alert to what they see in the sky now and want answers as to what they are seeing. This story was able to provide them with answers as to it just being space debris and nothing major or crazy was happening. It helped ease the mind of our viewers and got them the answers they were looking for and posting about.

Midday, Mar 20, 2023, 11:33 a.m., 00:45, Local: High water flow from recent storms is prompting a rare flood release across Fresno, Kings, and Tulare counties. The U.S. Army corps of engineers reports we could see a record runoff season Water is being released from Pine Flat dam into the Tulare lakebed. The Pine Flat reservoir is at 78% capacity. The boosted flows are meant to make more room for snowmelt and rain ahead of the next storm. These water releases could continue through summer.

Ten O'clock News Mar 21, 2023, 10:06pm, 00:15, Local: The Amtrak station in a small town in our viewing area has been temporarily closed due to flooding. Recent rainfall in that area has flooded much of the region's farms and even residential areas. There is no word on when the train station will reopen. This closure is just one of many places forced to close due to inclement weather. Our coverage lets people know they need to find other ways to get in and out of the town.

Midday, Mar 21, 2023, 11:36 a.m., 00:25, Local: Repair crews are now making progress on repairs for parts of highway 168 damaged by wet weather. Caltrans closed part of the road from Huntington Lake to Tamarack Creek after large amounts of snow made the stretch impassable. It's unclear when that part of the highway will re-open.

Ten O'clock News Mar 22, 2023, 10:01PM, 02:30, Local: Kings County is facing major flooding, and it's affecting agriculture. This is important to our viewers because certain parts of Kings County are flooding, and people are having to evacuated. Kings County is also home to lots of farmland, and this flooding is damaging crops. This is relevant to our market because it's impacting several communities - and it's not just a local problem but a world problem, as the food we grow is shared with others.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 6, 2023, 10:03pm, 03:11, Local: A 7.8 magnitude earthquake hit parts of Turkey and Syria yesterday, killing thousands. A California state senator from our viewing area has in-laws in Turkey. We spoke to her about what her in-laws are experiencing, and how they are staying safe. The quake is garnering international coverage, so this story gives that quake a localized angle.

Great Day, Feb 26, 2023, 7:03 a.m., 01:03, Local: Madera business owners are voicing their frustration after relentless flooding at a complex on Pine and Howard. A spokesperson for the city says in part that they recognize the hardships flooding poses and are seeking \$7 million to resolve the issue. Madera County is one of 13 counties in California under a state of emergency.

Great Day, Mar 13, 2023, 7:03 a.m., 01:03, Local: A couple in Pine Flat Village is among a number trapped because of flooding and can't get out. Marilyn Bailey and her husband say they barely avoided the floods because their home is situated high on a hill. The Baileys say they've been without running water, power and cell service since Thursday night. The LA County Fire Department's swift water task force is providing supplies to people in the area by setting up a rope system across the creek.

Great Day, Mar 15, 2023, 7:01 a.m., 00:20, Local: Porterville is now under a state of emergency because of the recent storm. The city is asking people who live next to a waterway to place sandbags on property and use city services if needed. Parts of Porterville along the Tule River to the Schafer Dam are also under mandatory evacuation orders. The Tulare County Sheriff's Office is urging people to avoid waterways and flooded areas. If you encounter flooded areas, don't walk or drive into it. People can also sign up for emergency alerts.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 17, 2023, 10:01pm, 02:06, Local: Large area of Kings and Tulare counties near the Tule River are now under water cause several road closures and people to evacuate. This is important to our viewers because this isn't something that they have seen in years. It's a historic flooding, dams and reservoirs reaching their capacity and water is flushing away roads. This is relevant because it still impacting travel and now peoples living situations. This is also a continued follow up as to the damage the rain storm continues to bring

Ten O'clock News, Mar 28, 2023, 10:03pm, 00:33, Local: The governor of California requested a major disaster declaration from the President to help communities in our market recover from flooding. Many communities in our area have been under water for weeks after heavy rain fell on the region. This request from the governor would give local communities more federal money. Our coverage lets people in impacted areas know that more help could be on the way.

Great Day, Mar 29, 2023, 7:03 a.m., 00:29, Local: Kings County supervisor Richard Valle is now calling on Governor Newsom to visit flood damage in Corcoran. He says he wants the governor to see the impact on the land and farmworkers. We're told many farmworkers already lost more than a month's worth of wages... and there is no relief in sight. Corcoran is also requesting \$5 million in state funding to beef up a levee to protect the city and state prisons.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 31, 2023, 10:05pm, 02:39, Local: A local congressman visited a community flooded by recent rain. During the representative's visit, he surveyed damage, and asked the President to approve the state's major disaster declaration request. That request would give even more money to communities damaged by recent rain. Our coverage spreads the word that many communities still need help recovering.

Health

Ten O'clock News, Jan 2, 2022, 10:01 p.m., 01:05, Local: A player was severely hurt during a Monday Night football game between the Buffalo bills and Cincinnati Bengals. The game was postponed after the injured player was taken to the hospital in an ambulance. Our sports reporter gave an update on the player's status in our A-block. This coverage was being widely viewed across all platforms, and was the most popular news story when our newscast aired. It was important that we address this story high in our show even though it was not necessarily related to our market.

Midday, Jan 3, 2023, 11:33 a.m., 00:45, Local: The Fresno county board of supervisors is now declaring a local state of emergency over a lack of beds at local hospitals. The county says respiratory viruses, the flu and the coronavirus are stretching hospitals thin. The recent closure of Madera community hospital's emergency department is threatening to strain resources even more. It is calling on the governor to provide state help and seek federal assistance programs.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 7, 2023, 10:08pm, 02:45, Local: A business/pharmacy was destroyed by a fire. We reported on it the day before, and viewers were worried about their records. We did a follow up story to help viewers get the answers they needed and to put their mind at ease.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 18, 2023, 10:01PM, 02:46, Local: A 16-year-old boy was in a dirt bike accident and is now paralyzed just a few months after losing his mom to cancer, the community came together to do a fundraiser. This is important to our viewers because it informs them of how they could help if they want to, and it's a tragedy that can happen to anyone - the valley has many back roads that people ride dirt bikes on. It's a life changing story, and it happened close to home. Ten O'clock News, Mar 13, 2023, 10:01pm, 00:45, Local: A city in our viewing area has declared a state of emergency. The declaration comes after the town saw a lot of rain this past weekend. The declaration helps the city receive more assistance from the state and federal government. Our coverage lets people know they are not forgotten, and that government aid is on the way.

Justice

Ten O'clock News, Jan 3, 2023, 10:02pm, 00:40, Local: A man's body was found in a basin southwest of Fresno. The had been missing since November. The county sheriff does not know how the man died, or how long his body had been in the basin. Sheriff's deputies tell us this case is still under investigation. This story has been closely followed by many in our area since the man was last seen in November. Many were hoping he would be found alive. Thousands of law enforcement officials say they helped look for him.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 27, 2023, 10:02pm, 02:51, Local: City leaders, including law enforcement, spoke out city hall following Memphis's release of its officers' body cam footage. The video shows police beating a man to death. This story matters to us because there were violent protests in our market following the killing of George Floyd in 2020. Leaders want to make sure people are able to express their emotions but ask that they do it in a peaceful matter.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 24, 2023, 10:01pm, 00:49, Local: A woman accused of hitting and killing a teenager with her car has been arrested. The crash happened weeks ago, yet the driver was not arrested until police reviewed all evidence. We reported when the crash first happened, and it gained a lot of attention. A vigil was held in the girl's honor. Many people wanted the woman arrested. There is no word on when the woman will appear in court.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 24, 2023, 10:02pm, 03:03, Local: A local representative tried to call for a vote in the state assembly on one of his bills, but that request was rejected. The bill would have lengthened sentences for people convicted of dealing fentanyl. Local law enforcement says the lethal drug is causing numerous issues in our communities. After the state assembly refused to vote on the bill, local police agencies joined the representative in a press conference voicing their frustrations with the legislations' rejection. We have covered many stories about fentanyl on our channel. This latest story shows we are keeping up with the newest developments.

Ten O'clock News, Mar 30, 2023, 10pm, 05:11, Local: Former President Donald Trump is being charged with a crime. Trump's lawyer says he's been told of an indictment by the Manhattan grand jury. This is important because this has been an ongoing topic for weeks since the Manhattan's District Attorney's office has been investigating Trump's alleged role in a hush money payment to adult film star stormy Daniels shortly before the 2016 election. It's now like a follow up as it's going to the next step. This is relevant to our viewers as Trump gets a lot of attention nationally and we have a lot of local viewers who are followers of Trump and who like to be informed on what's going on.

Great Day, Mar 31, 2023, 7:06 a.m., 00:26, Local: Reaction from local lawmakers over news of Former President Trump's indictment is pouring in. House Speaker Kevin McCarthy jumped to the former president's defense, targeting the Manhattan DA in a tweet. He says the DA weaponized the judicial system against Trump and interfered in the presidential election.

Ten O'clock News, Jan 6, 2023, 10:01pm, 03:13, Local: The House of Representatives elected California Republican Kevin McCarthy as the next speaker of the house. McCarthy had failed to secure enough votes in 14 elections but was finally able to secure the speakership late Friday night. McCarthy is from Bakersfield, just south of our viewing area, so this story is not only big nationally, but has a an outsized role in our market's politics.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 1, 2023, 10:04PM, 03:00, Local: The Fresno County District Attorney blaming California's Governor Gavin Newsom about the death of a Selma Police Officer because state laws. This is in connection with the a story we reported yesterday, as more and more shootings are happening across the state. The topic of this story is important because the suspect was let out of jail, and if he was in jail many believe the shooting would have never happened. Today Newsom gave his own remarks on the situation, so it's full circle coverage - from crime to the role crime plays within politics, as well as a follow up on the shooting itself.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 4, 2023, 10:14PM, 02:15, Local: The U.S. military shot down a Chinese spy balloon. This is a follow up story to something we have been following along all week long, as many were wondering what the balloon was, and if officials were going to remove it.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 9, 2023, 10:06PM, 02:00, Local: California voters could decide whether to reinstate voting rights to people in prison on felony convictions. This is important to our viewers because there are about 34 prisons and several lawmakers are not for this decision, but there are several supporters. This is relevant for our market because it a decision our viewers are going to have to make.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 12, 2023, 10pm, 03:12, Local: The U.S. Military shot down a fourth unidentified object Sunday over Lake Huron and expects to recover it, this comes as lawmakers start to demand answers as to what's going on. This is an important story because it's something that has been happening all week, and is not something we see often. This is relevant to our market because it's a national headline, and politicians are not the only ones wondering what's going, it's also a follow-up as we continue to cover all four objects that have been seen in our skies.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 2, 2023, 10:10pm, 02:20, Local: Two politicians from our area have introduced legislation that would prohibit foreign countries from buying land in our region, and the rest of California. The lawmakers suspect foreign powers have sinister intentions, and want to keep California land under state, or even private, control. If another country were to come here and buy land, they might lay off farmworkers who need the land in order to have a job.

Ten O'clock News, Feb 5, 2023, 10:04PM, 02:25, Local: A closer look at what's happening on Capitol hill, as tensions rise between the United States and China, following the Chinese Spy Balloon in the sky. This is a follow up story as secretary of state Antony Blinken was supposed to meet with China's president. You can ride the fax bus for free or call three-one-one to have the Poverello house arrange transportation. The relief centers will stay in effect through Sunday. Midday, Jan 11, 2023, 11:30 a.m., 00:25, Local: Two people are hurt after a work truck crashed into a home near Old Town Clovis. Fire officials say the truck hit a gas line which sparked a fire. No one was inside the house at the time of the crash. A drop line for power fell due to the heat from the flames and the gas meter was sheared off by the truck.
