KMPH Issues & Programs Report for Third Quarter 2020

QUARTERLY ISSUES/PROGRAMS LIST

This is a listing of some significant issues, and our efforts to respond to the viewers in Fresno/Visalia market, along with the most significant programming for the period of July 1 through September 30, 2020. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any priority or significance. And, this list is by no means exhaustive. This programming is presented at different times throughout our broadcast day.

ISSUE: Consumer Awareness

In this time of social isolation, threat of disease, economic stress, and uncertainty about the future, we bring our viewers reports and stories that explain what is going on in our world, and how-to best cope with it. We also present information to help viewers avoid scams and risky offers.

Midday, Aug 5, 2020, 11:39 AM, :19, Local: There are long lines outside of Valley DMV offices due to a closure in Fresno. The DMV says AT&T accidentally cut the fiber to the office. That has now been fixed, but now crews are working on fixing a connection issued stemming from the fiber cut. This story is important for viewers who had appointments at this office, which happens to be the busiest location in the area.

Great Day, Sep 2, 2020, 05:01 AM, 00:35, Local: The Employment Development Department says dozens of unwanted letters arriving at homes across California are fraudulent. The EDD now says anyone who gets one of these letters should write "return to sender" on the envelope and stick it back in the mailbox. Then, the recipient should file a report online. This is important for people in our area to know about, so they do not become a victim of this scam.

Great Day, Oct 1, 2020, 05:06 AM, 00:31, Local: Demonstrators are now planning to gather in front of the Dos Palos city hall today to protest a temporary water shut off. The water will be turned off every night until Monday. A boil water advisory is now in effect for the city of Dos Palos. This is important for people in our area to know about so they can be safe and prepare for the water shutoffs.

Midday, Jul 13, 2020, 11:44 AM, :32, Local: The delayed federal income tax dead is now two days away. It was postponed from April due to the coronavirus outbreak. This story is important for viewers because many IRS employees are working from home, so there is a big backlog of paper tax returns. If they need to file, doing it online would speed the process up.

Midday, Sep 1, 2020, 11:34 AM, :43, Local: Governor Newsom signed new legislation into law that will allow people to stay in their homes if they haven't paid rent due to the coronavirus. This law also aims to keep homeowners out of foreclosure. People who are out of work will be able to stay in their homes through the beginning of next year. This story is important for viewers who may be struggling with payments. It grants tenants a reprieve on missed rent and gives them five more months before they need to start making full payments again.

Great Day, Sep 1, 2020, 08:00 AM, :43, Local: New legislation signed into law by Governor Newsom will allow people to stay in their homes if they haven't paid their rent because of Coronavirus. This is an important alert for viewers because of rising Coronavirus cases and restrictions on businesses allowed to operate during this pandemic.

Midday, Aug 19, 2020, 11:45 AM, :26, Local: Uber says it may shut down its rideshare operation in California starting tomorrow. This comes after a state court decision last week, which gave Uber 10 days to reclassify its drivers as employees. This shutdown would be temporary, but this story is important for viewers because people use ridesharing companies like Uber and Lyft to get to and from places instead of using public transportation and they may not have an alternative planned for.

Midday, Jul 21, 2020, 11:45 AM, :33, Local: The IRS is sharing a list of the top tax scams of 2020 that target taxpayers. Many of those schemes are related to the coronavirus. One of the most common scams involve phishing, or sending fake email designed to steal your personal information. This story is important for viewers because the IRS says everyone needs to be aware that these scams exist, especially during a pandemic.

Midday, Aug 14, 2020, 11:30 AM, :25, Local: A federal appeals court is throwing out the ban on highcapacity ammunition magazines in California. a three-judge panel ruled that the law banning magazines holding more than 10 bullets violates the second amendment. Several other states have similar restrictions. The state attorney general has not announced if he will appeal to the supreme court.

ISSUE: Crime

In this time of mass protests, increasing reports of shootings, rising homelessness/drug abuse, and social decay, our programming addresses the observed effects and suggests potential solutions for these significant social problems. We also provide information to allow the viewer to reduce their exposure to these types of crimes and social unrest.

Great Day, Jul 2, 2020, 06:08 AM, 00:27, Local: Hundreds of dollars' worth of meth and drug money were seized by Selma Police during a traffic stop. The car was initially pulled over for expired registration, and police said they found the drugs and cash in a gym bag. A woman who was a passenger in the car claimed it belonged to her, and she was arrested on drug charges.

Midday, Jul 7, 2020, 11:36 AM, :25, Local: A 21-year-old man is now dead after a shooting in Pixley. Tulare county sheriff's deputies say they were headed out to a call about a fight, but when they got there, they found a man who was shot. That man died at the scene. This story is important for viewers because investigators are still looking for information about this death and are hoping someone out there knows something.

Midday, Jul 15, 2020, 11:37 AM, :21, Local: A man is now under arrest for killing his ex-wife in Madera. Officers say he shot his ex-wife as she was walking out of a healthcare center. Shen then ran to protect her kids. He was arrested in Monterey county last night. He is now facing murder charges.

Ten O'clock, Jul 17, 2020, 10:09 PM, :34, Local: Two farm workers were shot by strangers while sitting in their car. Three young men drove up in a white car, shot at the car and then drove off. Both people that were shot were taken to the hospital and are going to be ok. This is important because Fresno County Sheriff's Office is asking for anyone with information on this shooting to come forward.

Great Day, Jul 23, 2020, 05:13 AM, 00:23, Local: A hunt is now on for whoever shot and killed a man in southwest Fresno. Police say someone shot the man in the chest near Tupman Street and George Avenue. That man died shortly after arriving at a hospital. Investigators say a light-colored car was seen driving through the area just before the shooting. They also believe this was a targeted attack. This is important for people to know about so they can help investigators find the killer before someone else gets hurt.

Midday, Jul 23, 2020, 11:30 AM, 04:00, Local: We went live to downtown Fresno where Police issued an update to a shooting that sent a teenage girl to the hospital. She was sleeping in her room when she was shot from outside.

Ten O'clock, Jul 26, 2020, 10:00 PM, :22, Local: Two people were shot at a house party in Visalia. Both people shot were taken to a local hospital and treated for their injuries, they will both be ok. Detectives are asking for anyone with information on this shooting to come forward. This is important because they are still looking for the shooter.

Great Day, Jul 27, 2020, 06:04 AM, :21, Local: A man is now recovering after police say someone shot him six times. Police say this happened in Southwest Fresno early this morning. This is an important crime alert because police are still searching for the shooter. Great Day, Aug 6, 2020, 05:01 AM, 00:30, Local: Fresno police are now investigating a shooting that happened in Southeast Fresno overnight. A woman got shot in the arm and a man is dead. Officers say ShotSpotter alerted them to 18 gunshots in the area of Lorena and Ivy avenues around 1:30 a.m. Officers say they expect to be at the scene through this morning. This is important for people to know about so they can avoid the area if possible.

Great Day, Aug 10, 2020, 05:01 AM, 00:27, Local: Fresno Police said a man had been found shot in the head in southeast Fresno just before midnight. Detectives believed he was driving, when a bullet hit him, causing him to crash. He was taken to a hospital in serious condition. This information was important to viewers in the area who may have had their morning commutes interrupted by the investigation.

Midday, Aug 12, 2020, 11:30 AM, :15, Local: Tulare county sheriff's deputies are investigating a deadly shooting that happened near road 136 and avenue 440 near Orosi. Investigators say a farmer found a man's body around 6:00 a.m. by a canal bank and called it in. Deputies say the man appeared to be shot. This story is important because this investigation could close these roads and that could impact commutes.

Great Day, Aug 14, 2020, 05:01 AM, :32, Local: Fresno Police said a man and woman were both shot while they were driving in southeast Fresno late at night. They provided a vehicle description of a white, newer model Honda Civic so that viewers with tips on the shooter could report the information.

Great Day, Aug 26, 2020, 05:05 AM, 00:24, Local: Crime stoppers is now boosting the reward for information about a shooting in Fresno. Someone shot at a Fresno police officer eight times last Monday near Cedar Avenue and Fountain Way. Crime Stoppers is now offering \$2,500 for information that leads to an arrest in this case. This is important for people in this area to know about so they can potentially help police and earn a reward.

Midday, Sep 16, 2020, 11:30 AM, :25, Local: Fresno police say two people were shot near Maple and Belmont avenues in Southeast Fresno. This breaking news story is important for viewers because Madison avenue is closed from Maple to Backer while officers investigate.

Great Day, Jul 27, 2020, 05:00 AM, 00:30, Local: California Highway Patrol is now investigating a shooting that happened overnight on highway 41 in Madera. Parts of the highway are now shut down at Avenue 12 and highway 145. This is important for people to know about because it could impact their commute this morning.

Great Day, Aug 10, 2020, 06:00 AM, :22, Local: Police officers in Tulare are now investigating a deadly shooting. A body was found near Centennial Park around 1:30 a.m. Monday morning. This is an important crime alert as the investigation continues this morning and viewers should avoid the park.

Great Day, Aug 11, 2020, 05:01 AM, 01:00, Local: Police were investigating three separate shootings that happened in different areas of Fresno overnight. An apartment with children and adults inside was sprayed with bullets, and witnesses told police someone tried to kick in their door during the shooting. This is important for viewers who live in the neighborhood to understand the risk of violent crimes.

Great Day, Aug 17, 2020, 05:00 AM, 01:24, Local: Police are now searching for whoever fired several shots in central Fresno overnight. The shooting happened around 3:00 a.m. in the area of Cedar and Shields. Officers say several police cars were hit by the gunfire. This is important for people in our area so they can know to avoid the area to keep them and their families safe.

Ten O'clock, Sep 20, 2020, 10:00 PM, :37, Local: Fresno Police were called to a liquor store after someone called 911 and said that they saw someone pointing a gun at another person. Police found a man with a gun in his waistband, the man ignored the officer's commands and reached for his gun so they shot him. The man is expected to survive. Police are going to check surveillance footage to get more information. This is important because they police still don't know exactly what happened.

Ten O'clock, Sep 23, 2020, 10:00 PM, :21, Local: Fresno Police says that shootings are way above average this year. There has been an 86% increase in shooting year-to-date in the city of Fresno. At the current pace, the city could have over 600 shootings, which is more than ever before. This is important because these shootings effect everyone in the city.

Great Day, Jul 1, 2020, 06:02 AM, :27, Local: Police were looking for a dark-colored BMW after a driveby shooting near downtown Fresno that left one man shot in the leg. Police said a group of people were standing outside of an apartment on Franklin near Yosemite around midnight when the car pulled up and someone fired shots at the crowd. The man shot in the leg was taken to a hospital nearby, and was expected to recover.

Great Day, Aug 3, 2020, 05:01 AM, 00:21, Local: Police are now searching for a driver who crashed a car into a home near Whitesbridge and Arthur Avenues in Southwest Fresno. Two others from the same car were arrested by police, but the driver managed to run away. This is important for people in our area because they could help police find the wanted driver by sharing surveillance video or calling in tips.

Ten O'clock, Aug 9, 2020, 10:05 PM, 01:39, Local: Over the span of three days, two men crashed into people's property in Madera, leaving the property owners stuck with the cost of repairs. This news package uncovers what property owners need to know if it happens to them. This is important to viewers because not everyone knows what to do if criminals crash into their home.

Great Day, Aug 12, 2020, 05:01 AM, :25, Local: A chase ended in a crash in Clovis overnight. Police were chasing a vehicle when it lost control and crashed into another vehicle. Firefighters had to use heavy equipment to open one of the vehicle doors. At least one person was slightly hurt. This was important for people living in the area to learn about, due to potential property damage by the crash.

Ten O'clock, Aug 12, 2020, 10:02 PM, 02:00, Local: A Central Valley family of a man killed in a hit-andrun crash 2 years ago hoped to close loopholes in D.U.I. laws that currently state that if a driver leaves the scene of a deadly crash, they'll only face up to 4 years in prison and if they stayed and were charged for a deadly D.U.I., the maximum sentence jumps to 15 years in prison. The bill that the Gladding family proposed that would close that loophole, failed to pass. This is important to viewers in our area because there are a lot of D.U.I.s that occur in this area and many people have been killed and a bill that would close those loopholes would have been very beneficial. Ten O'clock, Jul 1, 2020, 10:09 PM, :32, Local: California Highway Patrol is looking for a driver who hit and killed a man on the shoulder of a road in Fresno County. The man hit was in his 60's and he died at the scene. CHP is asking for anyone who recognizes the vehicles to come forward so they can find them.

Great Day, Jul 3, 2020, 06:10 AM, :25, Local: Visalia Police said they pulled a vehicle over early Friday morning because they believed it to be involved with a prior vandalism. Officers said a search of the car turned up about 65 grams of methamphetamine, some crack pipes and a wad of cash. Two people in the car were arrested for drug sales.

Great Day, Jul 9, 2020, 05:08 AM, 00:33, Local: The Tulare County District Attorney says no charges will be filed against a driver who hit two people with a Jeep during a Black Lives Matter protest back in May. The D.A. says that is because the protesters were breaking the law by blocking traffic. This is important for people to know so they can be aware of what is happening in our criminal justice system. It is also important so they can know what rights they have should they decide to demonstrate or protest publicly.

Ten O'clock, Jul 18, 2020, 10:05 PM, :32, Local: A man was attacked after accidentally bumping into another car. The driver of the other car got out and started demanding money, when the man refused, the other man started punching him in the face. This is important because the man is still out there, Merced Police are asking for anyone with information to come forward.

Ten O'clock, Sep 10, 2020, 10:00 PM, 02:30, Local: A person was driving over 100 MPH down a small road in Fresno and crossed the lane, hitting another car head-on. The driver of the speeding car was killed and two people in the other car were killed and another was taken to the hospital in critical condition. This is important because people need to understand how dangerous it can be to drive that fast.

Ten O'clock, Sep 25, 2020, 10:00 PM, :24, Local: Several people are in the hospital after a driver ran a red light and two cars, pushing them under a semi-trailer. The people in the car had to be cut out. The driver of the car that ran the red light is being arrested. This is important because people need to understand how dangerous it can be to drive distracted.

Great Day, Aug 13, 2020, 05:01 AM, :24, Local: The CHP said a man who took a curve too fast in Prather lost control of his car, flipped it, and was thrown from the vehicle early Thursday. The impact of the crash caused his vehicle to catch fire, which spread to dry brush in the area, and burned the man severely, after he was already badly hurt from the crash. This information was released for those traveling in the area who could be impacted by a road closure due to the crash investigation.

Great Day, Jul 30, 2020, 05:56 AM, 00:22, Local: The northbound side of Clovis Avenue is now shut down at Highway 99. This after three cars crashed under the Highway 99 overpass. Three people are hurt. This is important for people in our area to know about so they can plan for their morning commute.

Great Day, Jul 28, 2020, 5:00am, 00:36, Local: A search continues this morning for a missing Madera County woman. Her family last saw her almost a month ago. search crews found her camping gear abandoned near Johnson Meadows in Yosemite National Park. They also found the woman's car, crashed near another camp ground. They are asking anyone who sees the missing woman to call Madera County Sheriff's deputies right away. This is important for people in our area to know because it could help to save a life.

Great Day, Aug 31, 2020, 08:00 AM, :15, Local: CHP officers are on the scene of a crash west of Caruthers. This happened near Jameson and Kamm Avenues. This is an important alert for viewers who may be traveling through the area.

Midday, Jul 24, 2020, 11:30 AM, 02:00, Local: The parents of a missing two-year-old from Madera are now under arrest, accused of killing their son. We went live to Madera police headquarters for a news conference. This story is important for viewers because we have been following this story over the course of several days and a lot of people helped in the search.

Ten O'clock, Jul 24, 2020, 10:02 PM, 02:04, Local: Police found the burnt remains of a 2-year-old boy in Madera that they had been searching for weeks. The coroner is waiting on autopsy results to discover what the cause of death was. This is important because people had been searching for the child for weeks.

Ten O'clock, Jul 28, 2020, 10:00 PM, :24, Local: Three women in Avenal were arrested for an attempted murder for hire plot. The three women were arrested by the Avenal Police Department. The incident is still being investigated, the police department is asking for anyone with information about this crime to come forward.

Great Day, Aug 6, 2020, :19, 06:04, Local: A search is underway for a couple of thieves caught on camera stealing cash and other items from a Fresno Beauty School. This is an important alert for viewers as police are asking for help identifying the people in the video.

Midday, Aug 26, 2020, 11:39 AM, 01:07, Local: A man is under arrest after a massive bust spanning three different Valley counties. Tulare county sheriff's deputies found almost \$300,000 worth of stolen pistachios and trailers valued at \$60,000. Detectives were able to figure out how the thieves committed the theft and what they planned to do with all the nuts. More arrests are expected in this investigation. This story is important because investigators are hoping for viewers to come forward with information to find the people responsible.

Great Day, Sep 3, 2020, 08:00 AM, :33, Local: A search is underway for two people caught on camera breaking into a Fresno taco shop near Shields and Maroa. This is an important alert for viewers, the taco shop, El Premio Mayor is popular among Fresno residents. Anyone with information is also asked to call Crime Stoppers.

Midday, Sep 10, 2020, 11:34 AM, :41, Local: Madera county sheriff's deputies arrested two people who were caught in an evacuation zone with illegal drugs and guns. Detectives pulled over two trucks with illegal and unregistered guns, meth, drug tools and bomb making materials. This story is important because it shows people that law enforcement is helping to protect many of the empty homes from burglars.

Ten O'clock, Jul 15, 2020, 10:02 PM, 01:36, Local: A two-year-old boy from Madera is currently missing and police are asking for anyone with information as to where he may be to come forward. His parents reported him missing and say that he disappeared at some point in the middle of the night. The boy was born prematurely and requires a feeding tube to eat. This is important because this boy could be in danger and police need help to find him.

Great Day, Jul 22, 2020, 05:08 AM, 00:40, Local: Madera police are now pleading with the family of a missing boy, asking them to start cooperating with detectives again. Officers say they have not spoken with the boy's parents since the day he was reported missing. This as dozens of other people in the community attempt to help find the missing two-year-old. The police department says it hopes to get back in touch with the boy's parents soon. This is important for people in our area to know so they can continue to keep an eye out for the missing child.

Ten O'clock, Jul 29, 2020, 10:00 PM, :27, Local: The parents of Thaddeus Sran appeared in court today. Thaddeus was a 2-year-old boy from Madera who was reported missing. His parents have been charged with his murder after his body was found in a fire pit in Madera County. The parents plead not guilty in court today. This is important because this crime impacted a lot of people in the area.

Midday, Aug 21, 2020, 11:30 AM, :50, Local: The Golden State Killer, also known as the Visalia Ramsacker, will spend the rest of his life behind bars. 74-year-old Joseph DeAngelo was sentenced this morning in a Sacramento courtroom. He pleaded guilty to murdering 13 people and raping 13 women in the 1970s and 80s all over the state of California, including here in the Central Valley.

Midday, Aug 24, 2020, 11:30 AM, :30, Local: The California supreme court is now overturning the death sentence of Scott Peterson. He was convicted of killing his wife who was eight months pregnant and using a boat to dump their bodies into the San Francisco bay in 2002. The court says the trial judge made several significant mistakes jury selection that undermined Peterson's right to an impartial jury. This does not mean the conviction is being overturned, just the penalty. This story is important because this was a huge story that gripped the nation.

Ten O'clock, Jul 8, 2020, 10:02 PM, :58, Local: The Tulare County District Attorney decided not to press charges against the people that ran into protestors with their car during a BLM protest. The reasoning for this is that when someone blocks traffic, they are no longer a protester, but breaking the law, according to the D-A. This is important because with all of the protests going on it is important to know how to stay safe and peaceful.

Ten O'clock, Sep 26, 2020, 10:00 PM, 02:00, Local: A business in Clovis was vandalized and police are considering it to be a hate crime. The business was wrecked, and hateful and racist words were spray-painted all over. This is important because the people that did this are still out there and police need help in finding them.

Great Day, Sep 28, 2020, 05:04 AM, 00:36, Local: Clovis police are now trying to track down whoever broke into a business in Old Town Clovis. They are now treating the break-in as a hate crime because of graffiti left behind by the vandal. This is important for people in our area to know about so they can help police put an end to hate crimes.

Ten O'clock, Sep 30, 2020, 10:00 PM, 03:30, Local: Someone broke into a family's backyard and spraypainted graffiti all over the deck of their pool and defaced the political signs they had in the yard. This is important because political signs have been defaced all over the valley and the presidential race is becoming very contentious.

Midday, Jul 10, 2020, 11:52 AM, :28, Local: A man seen in a drunk and racist rant shown in our Midday newscast on 7/9/20 is now stepping down as the CEO of his company. In that racist rant, a server says she was verbally abused by the man. His former company released a statement saying he is resigning immediately as a direct result of his actions.

Midday, Jul 9, 2020, 11:30 AM, 02:42, Local: We had new video captured at a taproom in Fresno of a server being verbally abused by a drunk customer. The video was almost two minutes long. Several times throughout the video, the man used racist slurs when denied another drink. The man claimed he "ran the internet" as the CEO of a company called Actionable Insights. His website was shut down after the release of the video.

Midday, Aug 7, 2020, 11:30 AM, 15:00, Local: The Fresno county sheriff's office held a news conference about the arrest of 34 men as part of an undercover operation to catch child sex predators. We went to this live for a full update.

Ten O'clock, Sep 28, 2020, 10:00 PM, :40, Local: An 11-year-old girl in Porterville reported that a man in black clothes and ski mask grabbed her and tried to run away with her. The girl was thankfully able to get away from the man and run away. Police are still trying to understand completely what happened and are asking for any possible witnesses to come forward.

Ten O'clock, Aug 7, 2020, 10:06 PM, 02:14, Local: The Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force believes the coronavirus is putting children at a higher risk of coming in contact with cyber predators. The Fresno County Sheriff's office made several arrests of men who pretended to be children online. This is important to viewers because since children are attending school online and just generally spending more time on their laptops during lockdown, they are becoming more prone to engaging with predators online.

ISSUE: Economy

The impact of Covid-19 has shaken our economy, and left families and individuals with unsecure resources, questions about the present and future opportunities. Many businesses have been required to close their doors to limit the virus transmission. This personal and business instability has overwhelmed our safety nets and social services. It has also brought out the predators, who feed on the fear of those most deeply impacted by the pandemic. Here are some of the stores we have presented to our viewers to explain the current situation, show possible opportunities for advancement, how to avoid scams, and give hope.

Ten O'clock, Jul 21, 2020, 10:09 PM, :44, Local: The Kings County Board of Supervisors allocated \$5 million to help companies in the county with 25 employees or less during the pandemic. This money will go to 250 businesses. This is important because many businesses are struggling during this time due to the closures.

Ten O'clock, Jul 25, 2020, 10:02 PM, 01:56, Local: Thousands of people in California are still waitin5g for checks to come from the Employee Development Department since businesses were shut down in March due to the pandemic. Assemblyman Jim Patterson has reached out to the state to launch an audit into the EDD to find out what is causing the holdup. This is important because thousands of people in the state are depending on those checks to survive.

Ten O'clock, Jul 31, 2020, 10:03 PM, 01:23, Local: Thousands of people are still having issues receiving money from EDD for unemployment since businesses have been shut down. One woman that we talked to finally received her first check, but money was docked because of what she says were confusing questions on the forms. Assemblyman Jim Patterson is still asking the state to audit the department to find out what the issues are and why people are not receiving their money.

Ten O'clock, Aug 6, 2020, 10:03 PM, 02:20, Local: Lawmakers are now calling for the head of the Employment Development Department to step down. They accuse her of lying and running a department that doesn't function as it should. Jim Patterson, Assemblyman for California's District 23, is leading the charge to have her replaced. This is important to viewers because issues with the EDD has been ongoing for a while and people who are affected by it need to have answers on whether their benefits will kick in.

Ten O'clock, Sep 2, 2020, 10:00 PM, 02:12, Local: 38 state legislators, including Assembly member Jim Patterson, are asking the state to perform an emergency audit of the EDD. This comes after months of issues coming forward during the pandemic. People have not receiving unemployment and there has been fraudulent activity. This is important because so many people are depending on checks from the EDD during this time when they are out of work due to the pandemic.

Ten O'clock, Sep 3, 2020, 10:00 PM, :38, Local: An emergency audit of the EDD has been approved by the state. The audit will look into the backlog of benefits and why it is taking so long for people to receive money. It will also look into ways to get the call centers working better. This is important because thousands of people all over the state depend on the benefits.

Ten O'clock, Sep 21, 2020, 10:00 PM, 01:38, Local: The Employment Development Department is going to be shut down for the next two weeks, this time is going to be used to reset their practices and get back on track. During this time you will be unable to reach them. This is important because so many people are depending on benefits from the EDD and this shutdown may help to get things back on track.

Ten O'clock, Aug 29, 2020, 10:02 PM, 02:37, Local: One man in Fresno County has received up to 100 letters from the Employment Development Department but they were addressed to different people he didn't know. FOX26 reporter Jenna Liston investigated why it keeps happening. This is important to viewers in our area because a lot of people who are unemployed are waiting for these letters and they could be arriving at the wrong address. It also highlights another issue with the E.D.D.

Ten O'clock, Aug 30, 2020, 10:04 PM, 01:54, Local: After running a story the previous night about letters from the E.D.D. being addressed to the wrong people, more people spoke up saying that they also received strange letters from the E.D.D. that were addressed to other people. EDD believes that scammers are trying to take advantage of issues that have come up during the pandemic. This is important because more and more viewers have been experiencing the same thing.

Ten O'clock, Sep 18, 2020, 10:00 PM, 01:29, Local: The owner of Colton's Social House at the Sierra Vista Mall has invested \$100,000 in creating an outdoor dining space in order to stay open during the mandatory closures from the state. The property manager of Sierra Vista Mall is not happy with the changes and says that they need to make changes or close completely. This is important because so many businesses have had to close already due to the shutdowns.

Midday, Jul 17, 2020, 11:36 AM, :14, Local: Governor Gavin Newsom is set to hold a news conference today to announce new state guidelines for school districts. This announcement follows the broadcast, but it is important for viewers because many are wondering how their child will get an education in the fall.

Great Day, Aug 28, 2020, 08:04 AM, :45, Local: A Fresno mother is now calling on the school district to allow her son with special needs back in the classroom. This is an important story for viewers because the California Department of Public Health is now allowing schools to open campuses to a small number of students with disabilities.

Great Day, Jul 16, 2020, 05:09 AM, 00:22, Local: Governor Newsom is planning to hold a news conference today to announce school reopening this fall. The announcement will happen at noon. This story includes information about where viewers can watch the conference, including on our website, and live on our channel. This is important because students still need access to an education.

Great Day, Jul 15, 2020, 05:06 AM, 00:45, Local: The Selma Unified School District will start its fall semester entirely online according to a new announcement just released last night. Central Unified says it will also begin its school year online-only. Clovis Unified is expected to announce its plans tomorrow, and Fresno Unified will make an announcement on Friday. This is important for people in our area to know so they can make plans for their children this upcoming semester.

Great Day, Jul 16, 2020, 09:04 AM, :35, Local: Clovis Unified administrators say campuses will reopen for in-person classes in the fall. The district is also offering online learning if families don't feel comfortable sending kids back to school yet. Teachers are being given the same option. More about this plan will be provided on Monday.

Midday, Jul 20, 2020, 11:34 AM, :23, Local: The CIF says education-based athletics will begin at some point this school year, but with a modified season schedule. The CIF says each section of the state will have a different timetable, but most areas won't begin the season until December or January.

This is an important alert for families in the district. Schools are still on schedule to reopen on August 17th. The district is expected to give parents an option for online only instruction.

Great Day, Aug 28, 2020, 05:01 AM, 00:45, Local: The Fresno Unified School District is now reviewing new guidance from the California that would allow some schools to partially reopen. Ten O'clock, Aug 26, 2020, 10:18 PM, 01:54, Local: With teachers getting ready to work from home for a second day, construction crews in Madera, California cut a line that provides internet service to many school sites through the County Superintendent of Schools. This is important to viewers because this story gives viewers an idea of backup plans in case something happens to the internet service while kids are attending school online.

Great Day, Aug 27, 2020, 05:03 AM, 00:30, Local: Teachers in Madera County will be working from home today because of a widespread internet outage. Construction crews cut a fiber line in north Madera, causing the outage that is impacting schools across the community. Students are now told to complete the assignments based on instructions from the day before.

Ten O'clock, Aug 27, 2020, 10:05 PM, 01:30, Local: A mother in Fresno County was told that her daughter cannot attend school classes online since her vaccinations aren't up to date. This is important to viewers because a lot of parents in the Central Valley most likely didn't know that the same rules are set in place despite school classes being held online.

Midday, Sep 23, 2020, 11:32 AM, :25, Local: The president of Fresno state has now been appointed as chancellor of the California State University. Joseph Castro served as president of Fresno State for seven years. He is the first California native and first Mexican-American to be appointed to oversee the 23-campus university system.

Great Day, Jul 22, 2020, 08:09 AM, :26, Local: California State University trustees are expected to vote today on making ethnic studies a graduation requirement. This is an important news story for viewers who may be going to Fresno State, which is part of the CSU system.

ISSUE: Environment

The fierce wildfires, which have devastated much of this state, and the unusually hot weather we have endured this year have caused problems with power distribution and air quality. Our reports educated our viewers about the current status of the airmass covering the valley, and need to protect ourselves, especially the most sensitive, from the large number of particulates in the air. We also reported on the issues the state was having with meeting the large demand for power during hot days. Our informed population was able to moderate demand to a point where the need for blackouts was minimal. The following is a list of reports on these, and other related topics.

Great Day, Jul 29, 2020, 08:01 AM, :24, Local: A growing number of people around the country say they are receiving mysterious packages of seeds in the mail from China. There are reports of seed packets showing up in Fresno and Madera. This is an important alert because agriculture officials are telling people not to plant the seeds because it can be an invasive species or have a virus or bacteria that harms local crops.

Ten O'clock, Aug 13, 2020, 10:02 PM, :47, Local: With record-breaking temperatures in the forecast, the California Independent System Operator is encouraging people to cut back on using power. This is important to viewers in our area because the weather is going to get hot and if the energy grids get overwhelmed, our power could be shut off via rolling black-outs.

Ten O'clock, Aug 14, 2020, 10:03 PM, :30, Local: After the previous days voluntary 'flex alert', in which residents were asked to conserve energy, California entered a stage 3 emergency, after the California Independent System Operator realized the electricity demand was outpacing the supply. This is important to viewers because our area was subject to rolling blackouts and parts of our area lost power.

Ten O'clock, Aug 15, 2020, 10:05 PM, 01:28, Local: After an announcement was made by the California Independent Systems Operator saying that there would be no power shutoffs, they changed their mind and announced that there would be rolling blackouts an hour and a half later. This package uncovered that a 500-megawatt unit went out, and the ISO lost a thousand megawatts of wind power, causing the stage 3 emergency across California. This is important to viewers in our area because a lot of people in the area lost power when they weren't expecting to.

Ten O'clock, Aug 17, 2020, 10:03 PM, 02:00, Local: California Governor Gavin Newsom is calling for an investigation into what's going on with the California Independent System Operator and the rolling blackouts. This is important to viewers in my area because people in our viewing area are very affected by these rolling blackouts.

Ten O'clock, Aug 18, 2020, 10:03 PM, 01:44, Local: FOX26 Weather Forecaster Kimberly Kolliner explains why temperatures are so high on the Central Valley floor and why there is so much moisture developing in the mountains. This is important to our viewers because this story provides a scientific explanation for the rising temperatures that affect residents in the Central Valley.

Ten O'clock, Sep 24, 2020, 10:00 PM, 01:54, Local: A new study by the Scripps Institute of Oceanography shows that the dust at the Oceano Dunes in Pismo that is kicked up by off-road vehicles could be less harmful than once believed. Many people are using this study to say that the dunes should be opened to recreation once again. This is important because many people from the valley go to the dunes.

Ten O'clock, Aug 22, 2020, 10:06 PM, :20, Local: With all the wildfires burning up and down California, the smoke is being blown through the Central Valley and making the air dirty and hard to breathe. This is important to viewers in our area because the bad air affects those with asthma and it's making allergies worse.

Ten O'clock, Aug 23, 2020, 10:03 PM, 01:37, Local: Almost 2 thousand square miles have burned in California and the state is now bringing in extra reinforcements to help firefighters. And now the threat of dry lightning in the atmosphere is causing concern over more fires sparking. Ten O'clock, Jul 6, 2020, 10:09 PM, :19, Local: Air quality in the Central Valley is very poor right now due to several large fires in Santa Clara County. There is a smoky haze caught on camera over Lake Kaweah in Tulare County. This is important because many people in the Central Valley are affected by bad air quality.

ISSUE: Health

It's been 5 months since COVID19 has changed our way of living. And there's still a great concern about the on-going impact of COVID19. Families are still learning to cope and those with health issues. And, those with young children need information, resources and coping strategies for the new norm. Our programming addresses the impact and the needs of families with a member with dementia, preschoolers, with diabetes, and other disabilities as they fight to stay healthy and cope with the challenges and stress.

Midday, Sep 14, 2020, 11:39 AM, :22, Local: The World Ag Expo is canceled over coronavirus concerns. It was scheduled for February 2021. This story is important because this event attracts people from all over the country and world. This is the first time in the expo's 52-year history that the show will not be held live.

Ten O'clock, Jul 14, 2020, 10:04 PM, :35, Local: The Lindsay district office for the Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency is temporarily closed due to an employee testing positive for coronavirus. Other employees have been notified and the entire office is being deep cleaned. Anyone who needs service can call the call center. This is important because this closure could affect many people who use those services.

Great Day, Aug 20, 2020, 05:02 AM, 00:29, Local: Air quality throughout the central valley is expected to be poor today as wildfires are sending smoke our way. The San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District is issuing a health warning because of how bad the air is. The warning will remain in effect until all the fires are out. This is important for people in our area to know so they are aware of why the air outside smells like smoke.

Great Day, Aug 21, 2020, 05:05 AM, 00:46, Local: Thick smoke from California wildfires is now creating poor air quality throughout the central valley. This is prompting doctors to issue health alerts for people who are not directly impacted by the flames. They say unhealthy air is worse right now because it is happening during an intense heat wave and in the middle of a pandemic. The doctors recommend staying indoors as much as possible. This is important for people in our area to know so they can keep themselves and their family safe during while the wildfires are burning.

The fires have caused loss of life, destroyed homes, vehicles, and many other structures, including historic buildings. The fires have also endangered the thousands of fire fighters and support personnel risking their lives to bring these fires under control. These fires have also significantly damaged our ecosystem. Trees and brush needed to hold together hillsides are now gone. The carbon laden gas and ash released by the fires were released into the air, will remain in suspension in the atmosphere for years, and will undoubtedly affect our weather. We present reports to keep our viewers up to date on the current situation and give them what they need to stay safe.

Midday, Jul 1, 2020, 11:30 AM, :27, Local: A 13-year-old boy is in the hospital after he was hit by a car while he was on Facetime. Officers say he was found not breathing around 3:30 a.m. According to police, the boy was talking to his girlfriend when he was hit. Officers are now looking at surveillance video from nearby businesses.

Ten O'clock, Aug 3, 2020, 10:04 PM, 01:31, Local: A man in Fresno, CA is without his fiancée and his unborn baby after they were hit and killed while crossing the street. A red flag warning is also in effect for the china peak area through 8:00 a.m. this morning, and the flames are expected to keep spreading through at least tomorrow. This is important for people in our area to know about, so they get how urgent it is for them to get somewhere safe.

Midday, Sep 9, 2020, 11:30 AM, :40, Local: The owner of China Peak ski resort says the Creek fire destroyed some employee housing near the resort. The flames were so dangerous, fire crews trying to protect the resort were forced to get out for their own safety.

Great Day, Sep 10, 2020, 05:04 AM, 00:25, Local: All national parks in California are now closed to visitors. The national parks service says the fire risk is just too dangerous. That means all camping sites, trails, and anything else in the 18 national forests is off limits. This is important for people in our area to know about, so they know to stay away from the forests, giving fire crews the space they need to do their jobs.

Great Day, Sep 11, 2020, 08:01 AM, :14, Local: Firefighters say they are now starting to make progress battling the Creek Fire. This is an important alert for viewers because it is burning across Fresno and Madera Counties in the Sierra National Forest. It's now 6% contained.

Ten O'clock, Sep 11, 2020, 10:00 PM, 02:10, Local: CALFIRE told us today that the containment number has stayed the same but that it is good news. The containment number staying the same means that firefighters were able to maintain the fire and keep the growth way down. When the fire first started they were focused on getting people evacuated and saving communities but now they can focus on stopping the fire. This is important because this fire effects thousands of people.

Ten O'clock, Sep 12, 2020, 10:00 PM, :21, Local: The Creek Fire has burned almost 200,000 acres since it started about a week ago. At least 365 homes have been destroyed and that number may continue to climb. About 14,000 homes or other buildings are still in the path of the fire. CALFIRE believes that the fire will not be contained for at least another month. This is important because many people from around this area have connection to the areas the fire has been destroying.

Ten O'clock, Sep 13, 2020, 10:05 PM, :24, Local: Firefighters that have been fighting the Creek Fire since it began thanked the community today for all of the donations they have received. They have been given food, water, and toiletries. They are saying now that they can no longer accept donations due to local health and safety ordinances because of COVID. There are still many other places that are taking donations. This is important because so many people are in need of donations.

Great Day, Sep 14, 2020, 08:02 AM, :54, Local: The Creek Fire in the Sierra National Forest is now 10% contained. This is an important alert for viewers because evacuation orders and warning are now being lifted for parts of Madera County.

Great Day, Sep 15, 2020, 08:04 AM, :15, Local: A smaller fire is now burning east of the Creek Fire in the Sierra National Forest. The Bullfrog Fire is burning northeast of Clovis. This is an important alert for viewers because this fire is burning with no containment and may continue to grow.

Ten O'clock, Sep 15, 2020, 10:00 PM, 01:56, Local: CALFIRE is continuing to cut containment lines to try and keep the Creek Fire from spreading north. This fire now covers more than 158 square miles and is 12% contained. A new evacuation warning is also in effect now for the Three Rivers area. Because of the fire, the Sequuia National Park is also shutting down today. This is important for people in our area to know about so know which areas to stay away from for their own safety.
