A morning newscast that brings you up to the minute news, traffic and road conditions, weather and all the overnight news that you may have missed to make that morning commute and planning your day a little easier.

“Midday” Monday-Friday 11:30am – 12:00pm

A mid-day newscast that brings you up to the minute news, traffic and road conditions, weather and all the news that you may have missed in the morning.

“10 O’clock News” Monday-Friday 10:00pm – 11:00pm

Saturday-Sunday 10:00pm – 11:00pm

A newscast consisting of local and regional news, plus consumer and health reports, as well as your weather and sports updates from throughout the day to bring you up to date.

“Town Hall” Periodic, as issues arise.

A panel of community leaders, specialists in the subject, and other interested parties discuss local issues, to improve the general understanding and help focus the popular consensus toward broad-based solutions.

Q2-2022 QUARTERLY REPORT: Syndicated Produced Programs

“Full Measure with Sharyl Attkisson”

Full Measure is a broadcast focusing on investigative, original and accountability reporting. The host is Sharyl Attkisson. The show format includes a major investigative piece each week on topics ranging from immigration issues at home and abroad, government waste, national security concerns and vulnerabilities, whistleblower reports on government abuse and misdeeds. Full Measure is produced by and airs nationally on stations of the Sinclair Broadcast Group. This show airs Sunday 7:00AM (Preempted for kids E/I on several occasions).

“Armstrong Williams”

Armstrong Williams is a weekly half-hour political and current events interview program. This program has timely interviews with important government, political and community leaders. This show airs Sundays at 5:00am and occasionally in other time periods.

Q2-2022 QUARTERLY REPORT: Significant Local News Issues

There follows a listing of some of the significant issues responded to by this station, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period of April 1, 2021 – June 30, 2021. This list is by no means exhaustive. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any priority or significance.

CONSUMER AWARENESS

Great Day, Apr 13, 2022, 06:07 AM, 00:26, Local: Your next hike through the kings, sequoia, or Yosemite national parks will be free. Entrance fees are waived all next week...That's from April 16-th to the 24-th. You won't have to pay to get in -- but you'll still have to pay to camp overnight.

Midday, Apr 18, 2022, 11:33 AM, 00:35, Local: Today is Tax Day. Normally, the deadline to file federal taxes is on April 15th, but it was extended because Friday was a holiday in Washington, D.C. IRS officials say your return must be postmarked before midnight if you are not filing online. Paper returns are taking up to six months to process right now, and it is faster if filed electronically.

Midday, May 12, 2022, 11:35 AM, 00:30, Local: A U.S. appeals court ruled California's ban on selling semi-automatic guns to adults under 21 is unconstitutional. That ruling calls the ban a violation of the second amendment. California still bans young adults from owning handguns and requires a valid hunting license to qualify for an exception to own rifles or shotguns. The stricter age limits were passed in 2018 following events like the high school shooting in Parkland, FL.

CRIME & JUSTICE

10 O'clock, Apr 1, 2022, 10:03 PM, 01:30, Local: Thieves stole a trailer from a church in Sanger, which was later recovered but everything inside the trailer was missing. The church lost its musical equipment that cost 20-thousand dollars. This is important to viewers because the investigation is still ongoing and someone watching the broadcast could potentially have information leading to an arrest.

10 O'clock, Apr 2, 2022, 10:06 PM, 01:28, Local: A high school robotics team visiting Fresno from South Placer County got its truck and trailer stolen ahead of a big competition. The trailer was recovered in Madera, but the truck is still missing. This is important to viewers because the police department is asking for the public's help in locating the truck.

10 O'clock, Apr 3, 2022, 10:05 PM, :30, Local: The Tulare Police Department is warning bank customers to be careful when using A-T-Ms because skimmers were found on three Bank of America A-T-Ms. This is important to viewers because the warning could save many customers from being scammed and having their money stolen.

Great Day, Apr 4, 2022, 06:01 AM, 00:20, Local: The c-h-p is now investigating a deadly motorcycle crash in southern Fresno County. Officers say the driver was riding on Fowler...Just north of Laton. As the driver passed Harlan Avenue... He lost control and was thrown from the bike on the side of the road. Investigators say he died on the scene. And they believe alcohol did play a role in the crash.

10 O'clock, Apr 4, 2022, 10:06 PM, 02:33, Local: More people started reaching out to our news station saying they had also been scammed after watching a story that aired last week about an investigation into a solar company whose C-E-O was accused of scamming his own family members and friends. The new list of people scammed now included former employees of the company. This is important to viewers because there is now a grant program available through the contractors' state licensing board which gives money to people scammed by solar contractors.

Great Day, Apr 5, 2022, 06:06 AM, 00:22, Local: More a-t-m skimmer's are now being spotted in the valley...This time in the city of Lindsay. A report was first made on Saturday about a skimmer found at the 'bank of America' drive through machine off Elmwood Avenue. Officials say you should check a-t-m's as best as possible before using them. Adding your best defense is to set up alerts for transactions and to report any suspicious charges right away.

10 O'clock, Apr 5, 2022, 10:03 PM, 02:08, Local: One of the men arrested for a mass shooting in Sacramento had recently gotten out of prison after serving less than half of his sentence. A new rule could shorten the length of time other convicted felons spend in prison. This is important to viewers because there is a public comment period going on and people can weigh in on the new rule and have their voices heard.

Great Day, Apr 6, 2022, 06:01 AM, 00:41, Local: A teenager is now recovering after police say two thieves stabbed and robbed him. It happened just after 10 p.m. Fresno police say they received calls of a carjacking at a gas station near McKinley and maple. When police got there, they found a 16 year old who was stabbed. Police say they found his stolen car a little later around cedar and shields. They are now looking for a dark colored four door Nissan sedan.

Great Day, Apr 6, 2022, 07:07 AM, 00:38, Local: Police are searching for several men believed to be responsible for shooting and killing a man in Fresno near Clinton and Thesta Avenues. They were spotted on surveillance video - two were wearing white t-shirts and dark pants, and the other two are wearing black hoodies and light pants.

Great Day, Apr 7, 2022, 06:02 AM, 00:20, Local: A man linked to a shooting last month in southeast Fresno is now behind bars. Fresno police arrested 22-year-old "Kevin Leon" at his home near cedar and McKinley. Police say he is responsible for a march 24-th shooting in that area. Officers say they found several hundred pills believed to be fentanyl in his home. He is now in Fresno County jail facing several charges.

10 O'clock, Apr 7, 2022, 10:04 PM, 01:31, Local: A 10-year-old girl was rushed to the hospital with life-threatening injuries after a stray bullet hit her in a playground at an apartment complex in Fresno. She is healing from surgery, but the gunman is still on the loose. This is important to viewers because the police is asking for the public's help in gathering information on the shooting.

Great Day, Apr 8, 2022, 06:01 AM, 00:25, Local: Police are now looking for a pair of motorcyclists they say are connected to a shooting. Officers say they were called to a house on Linwood near cherry late last night. They say the two motorcyclists opened fire on a SUV. the driver was not hit by the gunfire.

Great Day, Apr 8, 2022, 07:01 AM, 00:25, Local: Visalia police are now searching for two motorcyclists connected to a shooting. They were called to the area of Cherry and Linwood, where they found an SUV riddled with bullet holes. The driver was not hurt.

10 O'clock, Apr 9, 2022, 10:04 PM, :35, Local: A person robbed a hotel in Merced at gunpoint and took nearly 800 dollars. The robbery was caught on surveillance camera and the suspect is still on the run. This is important to viewers because the police are asking for the public's help in identifying the suspect.

10 O'clock, Apr 10, 2022, 10:02 PM, :55, Local: A mother and father were found dead at a home in Fresno and their son was discovered to have shot them. Fresno Police have yet to identify the suspect and the victim's names. This is important to viewers because there is limited information on the shooting and someone watching could potentially have more information.

Great Day, Apr 12, 2022, 06:02 AM, 00:29, Local: New this morning, Merced college was placed on lockdown after reports of shots being fired on campus. That was lifted a little after five yesterday...But classes and activities were canceled for the rest of the day. Merced police say no one was hurt, and police don't think there's an immediate threat or safety concern moving forward. Information on this is limited right now. Some news outlets reported the gunfire started with a fight in a parking lot at the school. A Merced police sergeant tells us that is not accurate.

10 O'clock, Apr 15, 2022, 10:02 PM, 01:52, Local: The Fresno Police Department's Police Chief called a mass warrant arrest one of the biggest gang take-down operations ever in Fresno and the largest case throughout California. Fresno Police found guns, thousands of dollars, and they made 47 felony arrests. This is important to viewers because it assures residents that the community is safer.

10 O'clock, Apr 16, 2022, 10:03 PM, 01:45, Local: Two men were caught on camera causing harm to cat in Fresno. This is important to viewers because there are laws that protect animal abuse victims and someone watching could potentially identify the suspects and turn them in to authorities.

10 O'clock, Apr 17, 2022, 10:01 PM, :27, Local: Police in Merced, California are looking for a man who robbed a 7-11. The clerk gave the suspect cigarettes and 5-hundred dollars. This is important to viewers because the robbery was caught on surveillance camera and someone watching could identify the suspect.

10 O'clock, Apr 19, 2022, 10:04 PM, :30, Local: Two people are caught on camera breaking into a car wash supply store in Malaga. The owner of the store says the pair got away with thousands of dollars' worth of products and destroyed the door in the process. This is important to viewers because police are asking for the public's help in providing more information and/or identifying the suspects.

10 O'clock, Apr 22, 2022, 10:04 PM, 01:39, Local: Thieves broke into a charter school in Fresno, California and stole 22 tablets from a third-grade classroom. The loss totals up to more than 12-thousand dollars. This is important to viewers because the thieves are still on the run and someone watching could potentially have information leading to an arrest.

10 O'clock, Apr 23, 2022, 10:02 PM, :21, Local: Two men were found suffering from gunshot wounds in South Fresno. Both men were taken to the hospital and are expected to recover but police have not made any arrests. This is important to viewers because Fresno Police is asking for the public's help in providing information that could lead to an arrest.

10 O'clock, Apr 26, 2022, 10:02 PM, :30, Local: Fresno Police found a man shot in Southwest Fresno. The victim died a few hours after being rushed to the hospital. Detectives say two men confronted the victim outside his home when one man pulled a gun and fired. This is important to viewers because Fresno Police is asking for public's help in providing information about the shooting that could lead to the arrest of the two gunmen.

10 O'clock, Apr 27, 2022, 10:04 PM, 01:28, Local: 1-thousand dollars' worth of radio controlled cars were stolen from a local retail hobby store in Fresno. Those cars have since been returned with the help of a good Samaritan who recognized the young thieves off a post on Facebook. Both suspects were under the age of 18. This is important to viewers because it shows the power of social media in being able to quickly track down suspects.

10 O'clock, Apr 28, 2022, 10:05 PM, :28, Local: Fresno Police are investigating a stabbing that occurred in West Fresno. The victim was taken to the hospital. This is important to viewers because police have not named a suspect and someone watching could potentially have information leading to an arrest.

10 O'clock, May 1, 2022, 10:00 PM, 00:36, Local: The Sheriff's department responded to fight that happened around 7:30p. The fight happened in the Tarpey Village area off Ashlan. The fight happened was between several family members. One of the family members was stabbed to death during the fight.

10 O'clock, May 3, 2022, 10:02 PM, 00:33, Local: Selma Police and Swat responded to a what ended up being a stand-off. Police showed up to a house to serve a search warrant. Police saw the person in the house and the person barricaded themselves in the home.

10 O'clock, May 4, 2022, 10:05 PM, 00:25, Local: A man who started a dumpster fire that spread to multiple businesses is now being charged. The man appeared in court and plead not guilty. He was convicted of all charges.

10 O'clock, May 5, 2022, 10:17 PM, :30, Local: Detectives were able to link a man to several Ag thefts. The man stole a trailer and an excavator. The man was seen stealing the excavator and was found several days later by police.

10 O'clock, Jun 1, 2022, 10:02 PM, 02:07, Local: A group of bicyclists were hit by a truck while they were riding on Old Millerton Road on Saturday morning. The cyclists believe the hit was intentional. This is important to viewers because authorities are still looking for the truck driver who hit the bicyclists and someone watching could potentially identify the truck.

10 O'clock, Jun 6, 2022, 10:06 PM, 01:57, Local: A sandwich shop in Downtown Tulare was broken into three times within the past week. The first two thieves left with about 800-dollars from the cash register and the third thief left with nothing. This is important to viewers because the burglaries were caught on camera and someone watching could potentially identify the thieves or provide more information to police.

10 O'clock, Jun 11, 2022, 10:03 PM, :43, Local: Fresno Police are investigating a shooting that sent a woman to the hospital. This is important to viewers because police are asking for the public's help in providing information about the shooting.

10 O'clock, Jun 12, 2022, 10:01 PM, :41, Local: The California Highway Patrol had parts of highway 99 closed as it continued to investigate a shooting in West Fresno. The shooting victim was sent to the hospital. This is important to viewers because CHP is looking for a brown or maroon Chevrolet Tahoe and someone watching the broadcast could potentially provide information leading to the suspect's capture.

10 O'clock, Jun 16, 2022, 10:01 PM, 02:00, Local: A man in West Fresno was stabbed this evening and was rushed to the hospital. Not much is known about what caused the stabbing, but one man was detained, and police are looking for another woman involved in the stabbing. This is important to viewers because Fresno Police is asking the public for help in finding the missing woman.

10 O'clock, Jun 18, 2022, 10:06 PM, :30, Local: A woman in Merced, California stole a package off a doorstep at a home. The victim couldn't stop the suspect but was able to take a picture of the suspect. This is important to viewers because someone watching the show could potentially identify the suspect and turn her in.

10 O'clock, Jun 19, 2022, 10:03 PM, :30, Local: A man in Fresno is recovering after being stabbed. He didn't cooperate with police, so they have limited information on a suspect. This is important to viewers because police are asking the public with more information on what happened.

10 O'clock, Jun 20, 2022, 10:07 PM, 01:49, Local: Many people are mourning the loss of a father of two children who was killed in a head-on crash involving a suspected d-u-i driver in Clovis. The crash occurred on Father's Day. This is important to viewers because this is a very important reminder to not drink and drive and to encourage others to find alternative ways to get home other than driving to avoid fatal accidents like this.

10 O'clock, Jun 24, 2022, 10:07 PM, 01:20, Local: A car left running unattended in Fresno was stolen from a store parking lot. The car contained the owner's dog. The stolen car was recovered, but the dog is still missing. This is important to viewers because someone watching could potentially recover the dog and return it to its owner.

10 O'clock, Jun 25, 2022, 10:02 PM, 01:13, Local: A man suspected of committing a string of crimes across California, the last one being a homicide here in the Central Valley, is now in jail. Law enforcement officials from around California are working to build a case against him. This is important to viewers because the Fresno County Sheriff's Office is asking for the public's help in providing information on some of the suspect's crimes.

10 O'clock, Jun 29, 2022, 10:04 PM, 01:01, Local: Fresno Police are looking for a shooter blamed for badly hurting one man and sending a bullet through the window of a GB3 gym in Fresno. Police are investigating surveillance footage of the shooting. This is important to viewers because police are asking for the public's help in providing more information on what led up to the shooting.

Midday, Apr 1, 2022, 11:30 AM, 00:35, Local: 18 people are now charged as part of Operation Killer High. All 18 are accused of manufacturing and distributing drugs. The investigation began following a series of fentanyl pill overdoses in Fresno. In total, investigators seized over 55,000 fentanyl pills, six pounds of fentanyl powder, 10 pounds of meth, a pound of cocaine, 25 guns, and hundreds of rounds of ammunition. the 18 people charged face a maximum sentence of life in prison and fines up to \$10 million.

Midday, Apr 4, 2022, 11:30 AM, 00:30, Local: Fresno County sheriff's deputies are now trying to track down a man spotted trying to steal fuel. Investigators say he was targeting commercial sites with fuel cells. The owner of the company say he caught the man using a truck, container, and a pump this morning. Deputies tracked the man down in north Fresno and pulled him over, but they say he ran off on foot. He left his truck and equipment behind.

Midday, Apr 7, 2022, 11:32 AM, 00:22, Local: A man is under arrest after running from California Highway Patrol in Fresno County. Officers evacuated a nursery on Clovis and Adams Avenue near Fowler because of reports of a man with a gun in the area. Around 10:20am, officers spotted the man running through a vineyard. They sent a K-9 officer to catch him. Investigators say the man was tracked down and arrested.

Midday, Apr 8, 2022, 11:32 AM, 00:30, Local: The Fresno County sheriff's office says its deputies seized about 6,000 marijuana plants from a house in Sanger this morning. Investigators tell us that these plants could produce more than 12,000 pounds of finished product. Deputies pulled several bags full of finished marijuana out of the house along with several illegal guns as well. Officials say the people growing the marijuana were also stealing power from PG&E for more than four years.

Great Day, Apr 12, 2022, 07:05 AM, 00:51, Local: People in California get hit by romance scams more than any other state in the nation. Older people tend to get targeted more - and the average amount people get swindled out of is \$60,000.

Great Day, Apr 14, 2022, 06:02 AM, 00:30, Local: Fresno County sheriff's deputies are now investigating a smash-and-grab at a pharmacy in southeast Fresno. It happened just after three this morning, Sheriff's deputies were called to the 'primary care pharmacy' on Kings canyon. When officer's arrived, they found the pharmacy had been ransacked...And pill bottles scattered outside. Deputies are now searching the area. Officials believe two people may have broken in...No word yet on whether anyone was found.

Midday, 4/14/2022, 11:30 AM 0:20 Local Merced police are now investigating after a man's body was discovered on the shoulder of highway 99.. Investigators say someone was walking near the V street offramp last night when they found the decomposing body. We are now waiting on the Merced County coroner to release information on how this man died.

Great Day, 4/15/2022, 6:03 AM 0:16 Local Police are now looking for this man after damaging part of the e-e-c-u at Clinton and fine near the Fresno airport. Officials say he set a plastic bin on fire and placed it next to an a-t-m. Officers say that fire destroyed part of the a-t-m and the building. So far...No one has been arrested.

Great Day, Apr 18, 2022, 06:04 AM, 00:18, Local: Merced police took a ghost gun off the street and sent a 17-year-old boy to Juvenile Hall. Officers from the Merced gang unit uncovered the gun on a traffic stop Saturday night. Police also found a little over a pound of marijuana after searching the car. The teen was booked for possession of a gun and sales of marijuana.

Great Day, Apr 19, 2022, 06:03 AM, 00:27, Local: Caught on camera... Owners of a local shop now need your help finding a thief. The owners of a western wear shop on chestnut say this man went in like any regular customer. But when they turned away, they say he scooped up an armload of brand-new jeans and expensive boots and left. Officials say he drives a 2005 white, Chevy Tahoe, With license plate seven-n-u-p-nine-eight-five If you have any information about his whereabouts call the Fresno police at the number on your screen

Great Day, Apr 20, 2022, 06:04 AM, 00:21, Local: Another man is now behind bars, accused of opening fire on a Sunnyside restaurant. Fresno police says that fight started over his food order. That shooting happened early in the morning back on April ninth... Off Kings canyon not far from clovis avenue. Lucky enough, no one inside was hit. He was arrested at a gas station in north Fresno. His bail is set at 195-thousand dollars.

Great Day, Apr 20, 2022, 07:01 AM, 00:29, Local: A Porterville man is now behind bars after police searched his car and found nearly an ounce of meth, a stolen catalytic converter, and a stash of tools used to steal more converters. He's now booked into the Tulare County Jail.

Great Day, Apr 21, 2022, 05:02 AM, 00:25, Local: A man is now facing charges after a hit and run in Clovis. Clovis PD say he struck a gas pump and led them on a chase that ended at Clovis Community Hospital. Police do think DUI was a factor in this hit-and-run.

Great Day, Apr 21, 2022, 06:04 AM, 00:17, Local: Madera police are now releasing a photo of a woman who stole clothes from a "boot barn". Officers are now hoping someone out there can help put a name to her face. If you know who she is -- Call the Madera police department right away. If you'd like to leave a tip, you can do so without sharing your name.

Great Day 4/25/2022 6:01 AM 0:28 Local A woman is now at the hospital after police say she was found shot in southeast Fresno while you were sleeping. Police say they were called to the area of Lamona and first near the 180/41 interchange just before four this morning. They say she was taken to a hospital - but her injuries are not that serious. Officers say it appeared she had been shot somewhere else - and dropped off in this neighborhood. Police are still trying to figure out where the original crime scene is - and who shot her.

Midday, 4/25/2022, 11:33 AM 0:30 Local Fresno police seized more than 30 lbs. of marijuana last night after smelling a strong odor coming from a car with illegally tinted windows. Officers say the driver had a gun hidden in his waistband. Police say the driver is a convicted felon and is now booked at the Fresno County jail.

Great Day, 4/26/2022, 6:05 AM 0:19 Local Exeter police are now on the search for a shooter... Investigators say a teen showed up at Kaweah delta medical center emergency room a little before four a-m yesterday with a gunshot wound. Police say the boy said he was shot at a house near orange Ave and maple street in Exeter. If you know anything about this, you're asked to please call the Exeter police department at the number on your screen."

Midday, Apr 26, 2022, 11:30 AM, 00:35, Local: A man is now under arrest following an hours-long standoff with Fresno County sheriff's deputies in Orange Cove. Investigators say a man with road rage shot at a car around 9:00 p.m. before leading deputies on a high-speed chase through Sanger. Eventually, they say the man pulled into an apartment complex and holed up inside one of the units. Investigators say the man was arrested after trying to run out the back door.

Great Day, Apr 28, 2022, 05:01 AM, 00:30, Local: A woman is now behind bars, after attempting to shoot at a teenager in Central Fresno. A 19-year-old threw a rock at an apartment complex on Saginaw and Thorn, angering the woman who lived there. She then tried to shoot at the teen. Investigators aren't sure if the two knew each other.

Great Day, Apr 28, 2022, 06:03 AM, 00:22, Local: Police are now investigating an armed robbery at a bank in Tulare. It happened around three yesterday afternoon at "citizens business bank" on prosperity avenue in northwest Tulare. Investigators know very little information. All they can say is the bank was robbed by a man wearing a disguise. If you have any information on this robbery...You're asked to call Tulare police at the number on your screen.

Great Day, Apr 29, 2022, 05:05 AM, 01:10, Local: Fresno Sheriff's deputies caught a man accused of stealing items from people's cars on Wednesday after a high-speed chase. It all started when air conditioning service workers caught him rummaging through their work car. They flagged down a deputy, who gave chase. Deputies eventually found him hiding at his grandmother's home.

Great Day, Apr 29, 2022, 06:03 AM, 00:19, Local: Police are now investigating a stabbing in west Fresno. Around seven last night... Officers received a call from a man who said his neighbor had been stabbed. When detectives arrived... They found a man in his 30's or 40's lying on the ground being treated by e-m-s. He was taken to the hospital. Right now... The motive for the stabbing is unknown.

Great Day, May 2, 2022, 06:05 AM, 00:19, Local: The redwood rangers have two weeks left in their baseball season...But they are now scrambling to replace almost all their equipment. The coach says someone set a port-a-potty on fire over the weekend... And that spread to the trailer where the team stores its equipment. The head coach estimates about 30-thousand dollars' worth of equipment was lost in the fire.

Great Day, May 3, 2022, 07:02 AM, 00:43, Local: A man is now in the hospital after someone shot at him while he was sitting out in front of a home near Bond and Thomas. He was rushed to the emergency room, and the shooter took off. Investigators say the man who was shot doesn't know who shot him.

Great Day, May 4, 2022, 06:01 AM, 00:23, Local: A man is now facing charges for something unusual. Merced p-d snapped these photos of what it says is what a man carved into the side of the embankment of bear creek. 10 O'clock, Apr 8, 2022, 10:03 PM, 01:20, Local: Two girls were swept out to sea in Monterey Bay and were rescued by fishermen. The rescue was caught on camera. This is important to viewers because it's a good reminder to practice safety measures when swimming in the ocean.

Great Day, Apr 11, 2022, 06:02 AM, 00:19, Local: A big rig engulfed in flames, shut down part of highway 99 in Madera this morning. It happened while you were sleeping. Fire crews were called to avenue seven around three- 30 for reports of a tractor trailer on fire. Cal-fire says the two trailers were full of tomato paste. Officials are now investigating the cause of the crash.

10 O'clock 4/12/2022 10:03 PM 1:58 Local A father and son were rescued after they drove off a cliff in Mariposa County. The car skidded off the road, fell 400 feet, and rolled multiple times. The father and son only sustained moderate injuries and will be ok. This is important to viewers because it's a good reminder to pay attention to the speed limit signs and practice safe driving.

Great Day 4/18/2022 7:02 AM 0:26 Local A man is now dead after crashing into someone who was driving the wrong way on Highway 99. Officers were called to the southbound 99 late Sunday afternoon, where a car driving north hit the man driving south. Officers believe alcohol played a part in the crash.

Great Day 4/22/2022 6:02 AM 0:27 Local We take you back out live to southeast Fresno where we've been following a commercial fire all morning long. This is new video from our skyfox26 drone. The fire happened on maple and McKinley avenues. You can see just how massive this fire was. The cause of the fire is still unknown. We received calls from viewers on their way to work - saying they were able to see the fire from highways 41 and 168.

Great Day 4/22/2022 7:03 AM 0:36 Local Fire officials are investigating the cause behind a house fire that happened last night. They say two women were found inside the house. One was rushed to a local hospital. Officials have the other woman in custody - no word on her connection to the fire. Fire officials say squatters may have been living there before the fire broke out.

Great Day 4/26/2022 7:04 AM 0:29 Local A woman is now dead after a multi-car pileup on Highway 99 in Sanger. CHP was called to the scene around 3:15 this morning. They found four or five cars crashed in the fast lane. At least one of them flipped over. CHP hasn't given any information so far on what caused the crash.

Great Day 4/27/2022 6:02 AM 0:18 Local Golden state avenue between central and American avenues is now back open, after a train crashed into a car early this morning. It happened at golden state and central avenues. Investigators say it is still unknown if the driver drove around the crossing gates which were down. Officials also say no one is badly hurt.

Midday, Apr 27, 2022, 11:30 AM, 00:25, Local: The road is back open this morning following a train crash just south of Fresno. CHP says the train hit a car on the tracks at Golden State and Central Avenue this morning. Great Day, May 2, 2022, 05:05 AM, 00:20, Local: Several businesses are now badly damaged after a dumpster fire broke out in downtown Visalia. Yesterday afternoon, crews battled the fire, closing off several streets. The fire spread to a Mexican restaurant, a Jimmy John's, and a jewelry store. Crews are still not sure how the fire started but are calling it suspicious.

Great Day, May 3, 2022, 05:02 AM, 00:19, Local: Three people are now dead this morning after a head-on crash in Fresno County that killed everyone inside two cars. The c-h-p says that crash happened just before three p-m yesterday along highway 33... Just southeast of Coalinga. Officials say the cause of the crash is still unknown. No word yet whether drugs or alcohol could have been involved.

Great Day, May 3, 2022, 09:14 AM, 00:35, Local: The Madera County community of North Fork will hold a groundbreaking for brand new emergency services facility tomorrow. The project is funded by a grant from the U.S. department of housing and urban development. This space will be home to a fire station living quarters, a sheriff substation, and an EMS substation.

Great Day, May 4, 2022, 07:05 AM, 00:19, Local: A Tulare girl is now recovering after being hit by a car. The CHP says the driver is not at fault because the girl darted into the crosswalk, giving the driver no time to stop. Firefighters were called to the highway just south of Floral Avenue around 4:00am for a brush fire. They were able to put it out quickly, but not before the flames brought down a power pole. It took about an hour for PG&E crews to de-energize the lines and get traffic moving again.

Great Day, May 9, 2022, 05:01 AM, 00:21, Local: A fire broke out in a Clovis apartment near Lind and Barstow just before 2 in the morning. Fire crews managed to contain the fire to just a couple of apartment units. Everyone in the surrounding apartments evacuated and no one was hurt.

Midday, May 17, 2022, 11:34 AM, 00:25, Local: Local and state leaders are meeting today to strategize how to rescue two injured donkeys stranded on an island at Lake McClure in Mariposa County. People have been delivering food to the donkeys but can't rescue them without permission from fish and wildlife and county officials. There are concerns that water could overtake the island at any time.

Great Day, May 18, 2022, 06:02 AM, 00:12, Local: A commercial building is now damaged after going up in flames in northeast Fresno County. The building that caught fire is around Herndon and Highland avenues. Firefighters were able to get control of the fire within about a half hour of arriving. No word on what caused it...Or if anyone was hurt.

Great Day 5/20/2022 5:01 AM 0:39 Local Two wrecking yards caught fire overnight around 2 in the morning, fueled by high winds. Fire crews took several hours to stomp them out... and the extent of the damage is unknown. The cause of the fire is being investigated.

Midday, May 23, 2022, 11:34 AM, 00:45, Local: A Hanford police officer and his K-9 partner are recovering now after being exposed to fentanyl during an arrest. Investigators say the dog began stumbling after checking a man for drugs during a routine traffic stop. While at the vet, the arresting officer also began to feel ill. Police say the powder inside the car was fentanyl.

Great Day, May 24, 2022, 08:01 AM, 00:19, Local: A bicyclist is now dead after being hit by a vehicle. The driver who hit that person is cooperating with the investigation. Traffic remains shut down on Blackstone Avenue at Herndon -- while investigators are collecting evidence. Officials are saying traffic can go west on Herndon... But expect this area to be closed until 10 a-m.

Great Day 5/25/2022 8:06 AM 0:24 Local A c-h-p officer is now recovering after a crash in southeast Fresno. It happened at Huntington boulevard and orchard street around 6-45 this morning. Police say this intersection is not controlled by stop signs or stop lights. The c-h-p officer and the driver of a white sedan crashed... But because that intersection is not controlled - no one is at fault. The officer was taken to a hospital to be checked for minor injuries."

Great Day, May 26, 2022, 05:06 AM, 01:07, Local: The school shooting in Texas is now sparking fears here in the Valley about school safety. The Fresno Teacher Association says there needs to be more done to address the problem... warning that schools are not as prepared as we think. They say more preventive measures need to be taken.

Investigators tell us something that looks like a pressure cooker bomb was discovered sitting at a high-speed rail construction site. The Fresno County sheriff's office bomb squad is on scene. One home in the area is evacuated.

Great Day, May 27, 2022, 05:03 AM, 00:41, Local: Fresno Unified issued a statement last night after a student brought a kitchen knife to school. Officials state the student said they brought the knife because they were feeling scared and unsafe following tighter security measures just two days after the shooting in Uvalde, Texas.

Great Day, May 27, 2022, 06:05 AM, 00:24, Local: A 19-year-old Lemoore man is now dead after the c-h-p says he flipped his truck overnight in the Hanford area. Officers say they were called to two-lane road on Lansing and 19th avenues just before eight last night. They say it appears the driver of a maroon chevy Silverado drifted off the road and flipped the truck on its side. The driver died at the scene. Officers say they don't know how fast he was going when he crashed.

Midday, May 27, 2022, 11:32 AM, 00:25, Local: The lockdown at Central High School's east campus is now lifted. School administrators say the loud noise prompting the lockdown was fireworks set off inside a school bathroom. The school posted on Facebook that all students are safe.

Great Day, May 30, 2022, 06:04 AM, 00:16, Local: A 17-year-old boy is now dead after drowning in bass lake over the weekend. The Madera County sheriff's office got a call around seven- 45 Saturday night... That the boy went underwater and did not come back up. Rescuers found him and got him out of the water 45 minutes later... Near falls beach.

Great Day, May 30, 2022, 07:06 AM, 00:49, Local: Clovis Police will be patrolling more frequently for Memorial Day today, cracking down on DUIs. They are reminding everyone to drink responsibly... and avoid drinking and driving. They urge people to invest in a rideshare to avoid racking up unnecessary DUI fines and saving yourself a lot of headaches... and possibly save a life.

Great Day, May 31, 2022, 07:06 AM, 00:48, Local: A group of kayakers is now safe after rescue crews saved them from river rapids on the San Joaquin. One local domestic violence shelter says it only expects that number to climb during the summer since families are now home together more during the summer months, making it harder to escape abusive behavior by going to work or school. This is important to viewers because we are providing resources for families experiencing domestic violence and a local shelter also has a wish list to help victims that viewers can donate to.

10 O'clock 6/4/2022 10:02 PM :46 Local Madera County Sheriffs found a body floating on the San Joaquin River today. The Sheriff's office says the body was already starting to decompose. This is important to viewers because the Sheriff's office is asking the public for more information on what may have led to the person's death.

10 O'clock 6/5/2022 10:02 PM 1:30 Local A swimmer was rushed to the hospital following a water rescue at Avocado Lake. A rescue team searched for a second swimmer, who was later discovered dead. This is important to viewers because with the weather heating up, more people are going to be visiting local lakes and rivers and should exercise proper water safety before entering the water.

Great Day 6/6/2022 5:01 AM 0:37 Local A man is now dead, and another is in the hospital after drowning in Avocado Lake. The second man's condition is unknown right now. Rescue crews warn people not to swim if they don't know how to swim. They also urge swimmers to practice water safety by wearing a life jacket even if they do know how to swim.

Great Day 6/8/2022 6:05 AM 0:22 Local A lockdown was triggered for a potential threat yesterday... At Armona elementary outside of Hanford. The Kings County sheriff's office says a child was found and detained in possession of a b-b gun nearby... But no one was in any real danger. No one was hurt. No details have been given about whether that child is facing any criminal charges, or if that minor is a student at that school."

Great Day, Jun 8, 2022, 07:03 AM, 00:30, Local: A person is now dead after being hit by a big rig early morning in Chowchilla. It happened around 2:30 in the morning just south of the highway 152 connector on the southbound side of Highway 99. The coroner will release the identity of the person who was hit after notifying the family.

Great Day, Jun 9, 2022, 06:02 AM, 00:22, Local: Highway 99 was at a stop late yesterday morning. The c-h-p says a big rig hauling river rocks hit an amazon van - flipping over at manning avenue near Selma. Even the engine was ripped out - and the van was totaled. This happened around 11-30 a-m. It took crews several hours to clean up the mess. The driver was pinned in, but first responders were able to get him out and take him to c-r-m-c.

But we know at least one shed burned on a property along McKinley near Leonard. No word yet how much land ended up burning... But fire teams did get it under control.

Great Day 6/23/2022 6:02 AM 0:21 Local A big rig crash forced the closure of an offramp on highway 99 near Kingsburg. This is new video from Caltrans. You can see the big rig off to the side of the road - with an axle twisted. The truck did damage to about a hundred feet of asphalt before coming to a stop. The truck was hauling about 44-thousand pounds - and the trailer was damaged as well. Caltrans worked through the night to repair the road. A heavy-duty tow truck was called in to remove the semi.
