A mid-day newscast that brings you up to the minute news, traffic and road conditions, weather and all the news that you may have missed in the morning.

#### ***“10 O’clock News” Monday-Friday 10:00pm – 11:00pm***

#### ***Saturday-Sunday 10:00pm – 11:00pm***

A newscast consisting of local and regional news, plus consumer and health reports, as well as your weather and sports updates from throughout the day to bring you up to date.

#### ***“Town Hall” Periodic, as issues arise.***

A panel of community leaders, specialists in the subject, and other interested parties discuss local issues, to improve the general understanding and help focus the popular consensus toward broad-based solutions.

Full Measure is a broadcast focusing on investigative, original and accountability reporting. The host is Sharyl Attkisson. Full Measure is produced by and airs nationally on stations of the Sinclair Broadcast Group. This show airs Sunday 7:00AM (Preempted for kids E/I on several occasions).

Armstrong Williams is a weekly half-hour political and current events interview program. This program has timely interviews with important government, political and community leaders. This shows airs Sundays at 5:00am and occasionally in other time periods.

This list is by no means exhaustive. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any priority or significance.

## **CONSUMER EDUCATION: Contemporary Issues in Modern Life**

Midday, Feb 15, 2022, 11:46 a.m., 00:40, Local: The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program is offering free tax preparation to low-income taxpayers through April 10. It is a joint project of the Craig School of Business at Fresno State and the United Way of Fresno and Madera counties. The program provides IRS-certified student volunteers to prepare and file taxes free of charge.

Midday, Mar 8, 2022, 11:30 a.m., 00:31, Local: President Biden is now banning Russian oil, natural gas, and coal imports. He says this decision was made in close consultation with European allies which rely more heavily on Russian energy production. The European Union says it will commit to phasing out its reliance on Russia for energy needs but filling the void without crippling economies will likely take time. This will cause gas prices to rise even higher as Russian oil provides about 8% of Americans oil imports.

Great Day, Mar 9, 2022, 6:16 a.m., 00:21, Local: Apple is now releasing a new upgraded version of its iPhone being marketed as more affordable. Apple says its third generation iPhone SE will sell for 409\$ a 30\$ increase from the previous model.

Great Day, Mar 10, 2022, 6:54 a.m., 00:18, Local: Ice cream maker Van Leeuwen are now creating a new ice cream. The pint-sized delight made from cream cheese and a mozzarella base with tomato jam swirls and basil crust cookies.

Great Day, Mar 14, 2022, 6:55 a.m., 00:18, Local: Tom Brady is not retiring just yet, the 7-time Super Bowl champion is announcing he is returning to Tampa bay for another season. Brady says in a tweet that he has unfinished business.

Great Day, Mar 15, 2022, 6:56 a.m., 00:29, Local: The Rolling Stones are now returning to the road in Europe this summer. The sixty tour which marks the legendary band's six decades in rock and roll starts June first. some of the stops include Madrid, Liverpool, Milan, Paris, and the stones hometown of London.

Great Day, Mar 16, 2022, 5:36 a.m., 00:52, Local: Toyota faces another blow to its production line thanks to the chip shortage. The company announced manufacturing lines in Japan will be suspended for eight days this month, leading to a 20% drop in production following assembly line cuts in Shenzhen, China due to COVID lockdowns.

Great Day, Mar 17, 2022, 6:16 a.m., 00:20, Local: Gas Prices in the us are still slowly going down, the average cost for a gallon of gas now stands at four dollars and 29 cents. That is roughly two cents lower than yesterday's average. and about three cents lower than a week ago.

## JUSTICE: Inclusion & Crime

10:00pm, Jan 11, 2021, 10:00pm, 1:03, Local: Someone was shot in a liquor store in our viewing area. We aired this story as breaking news. We did not have a lot of details on the story, except that someone had been shot and was taken to a nearby hospital. Stories like this are important for our viewing area because we alerted the public as soon as we learned something dangerous had happened in our area.

10 p.m., Jan 1, 2022, 10:03 p.m., :29, Local: Police were called to the area of Rd. 237 and Pepper in Terra Bella where two people were shot. They were taken to the hospital where they were to be treated for injuries. The suspect is still on the loose.

10 p.m., Jan 2, 2022, 10:04 p.m., :25, Local: An officer was on his way to a emergency call when a suspected drunk driver crashed into the patrol car. After the crash the suspect's vehicle was searched and a gun was found.

Great Day, Jan 4, 2022, 8:02 a.m., 00:25, Local: The CHP says the crash took the life of a bicyclist near Alta and Manning avenue just before seven o'clock last night. Officers say someone reported the situation after finding the man in his fifties or sixties on the ground. The driver was already gone. Anyone who was in the area and saw what happened is urged to call the Fresno County Sheriff's office right now.

Great Day, Jan 6, 2022, 6:07 a.m., 00:32, Local: A wanted felon is now on the run after evading officers in Clovis and Fresno. The chase began yesterday afternoon... When US Marshals tried to arrest 36-year-old 'Dennis Barnes' on Pollasky, between Barstow and Shaw. Officers say that man got into a car and sped off, hitting another car in the process. After losing track of Barnes... Police got a call about a crash near Sierra and First. They found his car nearby, but the 36-year-old was already gone.

10 p.m., Jan 9, 2022, 10:01 p.m., :47, Local: Tulare Sheriff's Deputies are looking for the person responsible for a carjacking. The victim of the carjacking was sleeping in his truck when the suspect got into the car and told the victim to get out and pointed a gun at him. The victim was shoved out of the truck while the suspect drove off. Deputies are still looking for the suspect.

10 p.m., Jan 10, 2022, 10:06 p.m., :29, Local: A teen has been arrested after making threats he was going to shoot up a school in Visalia. Police were able to identify the suspect and searched his home where they did find a gun.

Midday, Jan 11, 2022, 11:30 a.m., 00:25, Local: A former pastor from Lindsay is now sentenced to 25 years to life in prison. Back in October, Gustavo Zamora pleaded no contest to six counts of child molestation. These crimes happened between 1984 and 2000 against five girls between the ages of four and 14. Zamora was working as a pastor in Lindsay at the time of the assaults.

10:00pm, Jan 12, 2022, 10:01pm, 02:05, Local: Three children under the age of eight were found dead in a local apartment. The cause of death had not been released when we aired the story. A woman was found with the children. Her relationship to the children is not known. This story alerts viewers in our area that potential child abuse could be happening right under your nose, and if you see something, say something.

Midday, Jan 13, 2022, 11:30 a.m., 00:40, Local: The man wanted in connection to the disappearance of Missy Hernandez is now charged with her murder. Fresno Co. Sheriff Margaret Mims says Ramon Jimenez, Missy's boyfriend, was arrested last month, accused of domestic violence. Missy was last seen with Jimenez on December 7, leaving an art show in Downtown Fresno. Hernandez's body is still not recovered. Jimenez is not eligible for bail. He faces 25 years to life in prison if convicted.

10 p.m., Jan 17, 2022, 10:19 p.m., :24, Local: Authorities are placing bait cars in neighborhoods to catch catalytic converter thieves. They have even put up signs warning the thieves that the bait cars are out. This is due to the rising numbers of catalytic converter thefts that have been going on.

Great Day, Jan 17, 2022, 6:04 a.m., :17, Local: A 12-year-old boy is now recovering after being hit by a car in Merced. Police are now searching for the driver of that vehicle. Merced Police say this happened Saturday, near 'R' and 19th street. The 12-year-old is expected to be okay. Police say they are looking for a white Honda or Toyota.

10 p.m., Jan 18, 2022, 10:01 p.m., 00:35, Local: A standoff with Police happened in West Fresno. The standoff lasted more than 5 hours. The standoff ended with the suspect being arrested. The suspect was wanted for several felony warrants.

Midday, Jan 18, 2022, 11:30 a.m., 00:35, Local: The body of Missy Hernandez is now recovered. Fresno county Sheriff Margaret Mims announced the body was discovered submerged in the California aqueduct near Huron on Sunday. The underwater search took three hours in dangerously cold conditions. Hernandez's boyfriend Ramon Jimenez was arrested on December 8, accused of domestic violence. He is also now charged with murder and domestic abuse.

10 p.m., Jan 21, 2022, 10:01 p.m., 00:42, Local: Police responded to a Shot Spotter alert near Van Ness and Belmont. They arrived to find a man dead that had been shot several times. Officers tried CPR and the man was rushed to the hospital. Police are still looking for the suspect that shot the man.

10 p.m., Jan 23, 2022, 10:02 p.m., 00:33, Local: At about nine in the evening, Mercer Police responded to suspicious gang activity at a cemetery. Police chased down and caught a suspect. They found a gun that was tossed nearby. It is believed that the illegal gun was the suspect's. He is now facing charges.

10 p.m., Jan 24, 2022, 10:04 p.m., 00:36, Local: Police are looking for two suspects that robbed a Circle C market in Centerville. The robbery happened at about 5:30 in the morning. The two suspects forced the clerk behind the counter, and one of them knocked her to the ground. The robbers then took money. Police are asking for any information that can help.

Midday, Jan 24, 2022, 11:30 a.m., 00:40, Local: The Tulare co. Sheriff's office says an operation to solve a triple murder led detectives to a massive marijuana growing operation in the south valley. Investigators say Joe and Sirjoe Carmona of Ivanhoe were transporting and selling large amounts of drugs in several states. Deputies seized 53 guns, close to 15,000 marijuana plants, 773 pounds of processed marijuana, and more than \$650,000 in cash and assets.

10p.m., Jan 25, 2022, 10:02p.m., 00:39, Local: A grocery store employee is in the hospital after a man grabbed him by the neck. A man and a woman tried to leave the store with a cart full of groceries. The employee saw the two and grabbed the cart to stop them from leaving. The man grabbed the employee by the neck, threw him on to the ground, and punched him. The employee suffered several injuries. Both suspects had been arrested.

Midday, Jan 25, 2022, 11:30 a.m., 00:45, Local: Two people are behind bars in connection to a robbery and assault in the parking lot of a Fresno Save Mart. Officers say Koby Foster and a woman who was with him tried to leave the store without paying. An employee tried to stop them by grabbing the cart. Investigators say Foster grabbed the employee by the neck and threw him to the ground and started punching him. As this was happening, the woman took items from the cart. The employee was taken to a hospital for treatment of a fractured skull and internal brain bleeding.

Great Day, Jan 26, 2022, 6:06 a.m., 00:20, Local: Police say the deadly shooting in Visalia happened on Houston Ave., between Court and Santa Fe streets. Investigators are asking for help to find the killer.

10p.m., Jan 27, 2022, 10:04p.m., 00:51, Local: A teenager from Portville was arrested for giving a gun to another student. A school officer saw a picture of the gun on social media of the student with the gun. The student was questioned and he admitted to having the gun. The teen also told the officer about the student that gave it to him. The other student was arrested.

Midday, Jan 27, 2022, 11:30 a.m., 00:30, Local: A massive drug bust out of Kern County. CHP noticed several indications of criminal activity during a routine traffic stop of a speeding vehicle on highway 99. The officer got his canine partner to assist. After a quick sniff, the K-9 discovered 45 kilos of cocaine stuffed in the trunk of the Toyota Camry. The driver is now under arrest.

10p.m., Jan 28, 2022, 10:09p.m., 00:25, Local: Scammers are calling people claiming to be from PG&E. They are threatening to shut off power to people unless they give an immediate with a pre-paid card. PG&E said it will never request for payment on a pre-paid card from customers.

Great Day, Jan 28, 2022, 6:03 a.m., 00:21, Local: A deadly shooting in Tulare county is now blamed for taking at least two lives. 3 others are now listed in critical condition. deputies say the shooting happened at a shell gas station in the community of Ducor. Anyone with information about this shooting is urged to call the Tulare county Sheriff's office

10p.m., Jan 29, 2022, 10:03p.m., 01:07, Local: Fresno police responded to a shot-spotter call on Van Ness Ave in the Tower District. They found a man shot several times in an alley. He was taken to CRMC and died. The family is looking for any information that can help find the suspect.

10p.m., Jan 30, 2022, 10:02p.m., 00:51, Local: Two teens are in jail in Merced County after a high-speed chase ended in a crash after a break-in. Police got a call about the break-in around 9 at night. While arriving at the scene, Police were almost hit by the suspects speeding away.

10p.m., Jan 31, 2022, 10:07p.m., 01:02, Local: Thieves are still on the loose after stealing from a Buddhist temple. Several women came into the temple with donations for food. The women came back later asking for a tour of the temple. One of the monks notice a safe was opened and 35 thousand dollars was stolen along with other items.

Great Day, Jan 31, 2022, 6:02 a.m., 00:24, Local: An investigation is now underway into a stabbing at a Fresno bar. Two people were stabbed during the fight outside. Both people were drunk, and one was bleeding. Both are expected to survive.

Midday, Feb 1, 2022, 11:30 a.m., 00:30, Local: A Los Banos man is hurt after a stabbing early this morning. Police say he was stabbed several times in the back and left to die near Place Rd. and Pacheco Blvd. The man was airlifted to the hospital, and investigators believe he will survive. So far, no one is under arrest.

Midday, Feb 3, 2022, 11:30 a.m., 00:30, Local: A woman accused of starting a fire of the Tulare River Indian Reservation is now under arrest. Tulare Co. sheriff's deputies say Lorhana Garfield set cardboard and wood on fire close to a home near Porterville. Investigators say she wanted to burn the home down to either hurt or kill the person inside. Garfield is already on probation for a previous arson-related conviction.

Midday, Feb 3, 2022, 11:31 a.m., 00:38, Local: Five people are under arrest after a honey oil lab bust in Visalia. The initial arrest happened during a traffic stop. Police say Dominick Vigil was planning to sell drugs found in his car. This led detectives to search Vigil's home where they discovered a honey oil extraction lab. A young child was found living at the home along with four other adults.

Great Day, Feb 3, 2022, 6:05 a.m., 00:16, Local: A package thief in Madera is caught on camera. the thief rolls up and takes an envelope from a home near Granada and Cleveland Avenue. Police say the same person may be responsible for several thefts along those streets.

10PM, Feb 6, 2022, 10:01pm, :41, Local: Fresno Police officers found four men who had been shot at an apartment complex in Southwest Fresno. Two of those men died at the scene. No arrests have been made. This is important to viewers because police are still looking for the person who shot the victims and someone watching could potentially have information leading to an arrest.

Great Day, Feb 7, 2022, 6:01 a.m., 00:23, Local: two men are dead, and 2 others are badly hurt after a shooting in southwest Fresno. police say they are looking for two people who may have shot those men. the shooting happened around 6 yesterday evening.

Midday, Feb 9, 2022, 11:32 a.m., 01:00, Local: A Visalia man is now facing murder charges. Police say he fired a gun at someone and held a woman and toddler hostage. Investigators say a man and woman were arguing when a friend of the woman came over to check on her. That's when police say the man shot at the friend. He was not hit. That is when the standoff began. Eventually, the man surrendered to police. He is now being held in the Tulare Co. jail.

Great Day, Feb 9, 2022, 8:01 a.m., 00:15, Local: Police are looking for a man who robbed a Home Depot in Clovis. officials say this man threatened a worker with a hammer while stealing from the store.

Great Day, Feb 10, 2022, 8:02 a.m., 00:21, Local: Fresno police are searching for a man involved in a shootout. officers say the shooting happened in a parking lot of a smoke shop near Channing and Shields

Great Day, Feb 11, 2022, 6:05 a.m., 00:17, Local: Fresno police are hoping you can help find this man. Investigators say this man was caught on camera robbing the Sally Beauty Supply at Manchester mall near Blackstone and Shields back in December.



10pm, Feb 12, 2022, 10:03pm, :52, Local: Fresno Police found an 18-year-old man shot outside of a Fresno bowling alley. He was taken to the hospital where he died. Detectives say it began with fight between two groups inside the bowling alley and was taken outside where the victim was shot. This is important to viewers because someone watching could potentially have information leading to an arrest since Fresno Police are still looking for the person who shot the victim.

Great Day, Feb 14, 2022, 6:03 a.m., 00:26, Local: 40-year-old man is now dead after the CHP says he ran across lanes on a highway in Visalia overnight. Officers say they started getting calls around seven last night for a man on the eastbound side of Highway 198 near Santa Fe Ave. They say, as they were looking for him, he ran from the center medium towards the shoulder and directly in the path of an oncoming SUV

Great Day, Feb 17, 2022, 8:04 a.m., 00:33, Local: A man is behind bars after police in Merced say he tried to carjack a woman. Officers say they were called to the Family Dollar Store on 16th Street in downtown Merced yesterday. people told police this man Christopher Mendoza tried to steal a woman's car.

Midday, Feb 18, 2022, 11:31 a.m., 00:31, Local: Governor Newsom is now backing a bill that would allow state citizens to go after gun makers in the same way Texas allows its citizens to target abortion providers. Right now, a Texas law allows private citizens to sue abortion providers for performing any abortions after a fetal heartbeat is detected. If voted into law, Californians could seek a court order to stop the spread of illegal weapons and recover up to \$10,000 in damages for each weapon.

Great Day, Feb 18, 2022, 6:03 a.m., 00:31, Local: Fresno Police are investigating a robbery at the Save mart on Nees and First. officers say the two people broke into the store's pharmacy a little before four o'clock this morning. and took a large amount of prescription medicine.

10pm, Feb 19, 2022, 10:03pm, :48, Local: Police in Turlock, California are looking for a man they say shot seven people outside of a bar. The victims are expected to survive. This is important to viewers because Turlock P.D. is asking the public for help in tracking down the suspect.

10pm, Feb 20, 2022, 10:03pm, :31, Local: A gas station in Tulare County was robbed and deputies are investigating. The suspect robbed the clerk at gunpoint. This is important to viewers because the suspect is still on the loose and Tulare County Sheriff's Deputies are asking for the public's help to provide more information on the crime.

Midday, Feb 21, 2022, 11:30 a.m., 00:21, Local: Tulare co. Sheriff's deputies are investigating after the body of a man was found in Pixley. It was lying near the railroad tracks at Terra Bella Ave. and Main St. Investigators say there are obvious signs of trauma on the body. Deputies have no leads so far, so this is a call to action for viewers who may have information.

Great Day, Feb 22, 2022, 5:04 a.m., 00:42, Local: A 16-year-old was arrested late Sunday night after a person was shot at a skate park in Parlier. Police said officers near the park heard shots fired, and a short time later, someone with several gunshot wounds showed up at the police department, asking for help. They chased down a teen that matched the description of the suspected shooter, and the teen was taken to juvenile hall, pending charges. The shooting victim was taken to a hospital and was expected to survive.

Great Day, Feb 22, 2022, 8:02 a.m., 00:34, Local: Students and staff of Parlier unified school district are trying to process the death of their own. 16-year-old student, who was gunned down in his home over the weekend. Fresno county Sheriff isn't sure who gunned him down, or why.

Great Day, Feb 23, 2022, 6:04 a.m., 00:28, Local: In North Fresno there was a smash and grab. Detectives continue their search for a group of men and women who stormed the Kohls store, and stole nearly 50 bottles of perfume and cologne.

Great Day, Feb 25, 2022, 6:03 a.m., 00:12, Local: On camera, some people got away with shopping cart full of stuff from a store in northwest Fresno. Police are not saying which store was hit or when...

Great Day, Feb 25, 2022, 7:10 a.m., 00:22, Local: Merced County Sheriff's deputies said they were able to link four men from Hilmar to another armed robbery in Gustine in early February. All four were arrested and charged with armed robbery.

Great Day, Mar 1, 2022, 6:02 a.m., 00:22, Local: A man is now in the emergency surgery after being shot yesterday in Central Fresno. Fresno police say that shooting happened before 7:30 am along Robinson Avenue, not far from Dakota and Cedar.

Great Day, Mar 1, 2022, 7:01 a.m., 00:33, Local: A man was shot several times in the chest and legs in the parking lot at River Park's shopping center in northeast Fresno. Police said the gunman took off in a silver sedan. The man who was shot was alert and talking to police before he was taken to a hospital for treatment.

Great Day, Mar 3, 2022, 5:01 a.m., 00:29, Local: A woman was arrested in Merced for attacking a car wash employee with a wooden fence board. She was arrested for assault with a deadly weapon and drug charges. The man she was accused of assaulting suffered minor injuries.

Great Day, Mar 3, 2022, 6:02 a.m., 00:29, Local: A Merced woman is waking up behind bars after police say she hit a car wash employee in the face with a board. Officers say they were called to the car wash on 16 th and G streets just after one o clock this morning. They say a man who works there told them a woman attacked him with a four-foot wooden fence board.

Midday, Mar 4, 2022, 11:33 a.m., 00:30, Local: Several thousand dollars-worth of train cargo is now missing from a container at a Fresno railyard. Fresno police say they got a call about two people loading a bunch of microwaves into an SUV. When officers arrived, they found an open container and more than 30 microwave boxes missing. Each microwave is worth about \$80. That is well over \$2,400 in stolen merchandise.

Great Day, Mar 4, 2022, 7:01 a.m., 00:26, Local: A man was arrested in Merced after police caught him in the act stealing a catalytic converter from a vehicle in an apartment complex parking lot. Catalytic converter thefts continue to rise as thieves sell the parts for the precious metals inside them.

10pm, Mar 6, 2022, 10:01pm, :40, Local: Tulare County Sheriff's deputies are looking for a woman who is suspected of killing a man. This is important to viewers because Tulare Sheriffs have released a description of the woman's car and they are asking for the public's help in tracking her down.

Great Day, Mar 7, 2022, 5:01 a.m., 00:36, Local: Tulare Co. Sheriff's homicide detectives were looking for Pennie Ince, also known as Pennie Henson, as a person of interest after 65-year-old Randal Ince was found dead in a house Sunday evening. Detectives said she was driving a gold Yukon and could have planned to travel north to Fresno County.

Great Day, Mar 8, 2022, 6:01 a.m., 00:20, Local: Police are now on the hunt for a convicted sex-offender, and they need your help. 64-year-old Randy Toney moved from his home in the Gettysburg and Peach area, and hasn't registered a new address.

Midday, Mar 9, 2022, 11:30 a.m., 00:20, Local: One person is dead after a shooting in central Fresno around 4:45 a.m. It happened near Fresno St. between Gettysburg and Ashlan Ave. That is where officers discovered the body of a 28-year-old man who was shot at least once. So far, no arrests have been made. Investigators are looking for any potential witnesses or surveillance video.

Great Day, Mar 9, 2022, 5:03 a.m., 00:31, Local: A man wanted on several warrants stole a vehicle that was left unattended while it was warming up. Police later tracked the suspected car thief down and arrested him. It served as a reminder to never leave your vehicle unattended while running.

Great Day, Mar 10, 2022, 5:01 a.m., 00:36, Local: Tulare Co. Sheriff's deputies said a cashier at the Dollar General in Poplar was pistol-whipped by an armed robber Wednesday night. They said the suspected robber got away with money from the safe. Deputies released a grainy surveillance still of the suspect, asking the public to call in any tips that could lead to an arrest.

Great Day, Mar 11, 2022, 5:03 a.m., 00:36, Local: A man and woman were shot near an Applebee's restaurant in Fresno late Thursday night, according to police. Some individual courses may remain in-person as scheduled, but those exceptions will be made on a case-by-case basis. Fresno State's campus will remain open, including the library.

Midday, Jan 7, 2022, 11:30 a.m., 01:00, Local: The Fresno and Madera Unified school districts are now giving out free coronavirus rapid tests for students headed back to class next week. They are available today through this afternoon and on Monday. Pick up locations are available on our website. Tulare county was also giving out free tests for students, but the county says it ran out. Officials are now asking parents to reach out their child's school district for tests.

Midday, Jan 14, 2022, 11:32 a.m., 00:25, Local: Clovis Unified School District is updating its student dress code. For the first time, the district will allow students to wear distressed jeans, camouflage print, and leggings. Facial hair is now allowed as well. The district is also making changes to class times. Starting next school year, classes will begin about 30 minutes earlier every day. Students will also get out around 30 minutes earlier.

10pm, Feb 2, 2022, 10:02 PM, 01:43, Local: A Fresno Unified School Board trustee posted a controversial tweet on Twitter that sparked a heated debate at a Fresno Unified School Board meeting. MIDDAY, Jan 20, 2022, 11:32 a.m., 00:40, Local: Golden State boulevard will remain closed between Ashlan ave. and Shaw ave. for most of the day due to two crashes that left one man dead. Fresno police say there was a hit and run at highway 99 and 180. A silver truck drove away, got off the highway, lost control, and crashed head-on into another truck. The driver of that truck died.

MIDDAY, Jan 26, 2022, 11:32 a.m., 00:35, Local: All lanes are now back open along the connector ramp between NB highway 41 and NB highway 99. 10 p.m., Jan 5, 2022, 10:08 p.m., :32, Local: California mask mandate will be extended from its original day of January 15th to February 15th. The extension is due to rising number of the Omicron Variant in the state. There are no plans for another state-wide shut down.

10 p.m., Jan 6, 2022, 10:09 p.m., :26, Local: Fresno Unified is giving their students free rapid at-home covid tests. Students and their families will be able to pick them up at several different locations. They pick them up from 7am to 3pm.

Great Day, Jan 7, 2022, 8:06 a.m., 00:14, Local: The Madera unified school district is giving out two free rapid coronavirus tests to all of its students. Those kits will be handed out at all 19 of the district's schools, including all three high schools. More details about these free tests will come on Monday.

The University says all eight of its colleges will host ceremonies in May. All guests must show proof of vaccination or have a negative coronavirus test taken within 48-hours to attend.

Great Day, Feb 21, 2022, 5:07 a.m., 00:27, Local: The number of coronavirus cases and hospitalizations continues to go down. A report from Johns Hopkins university shows only about 100-thousand cases were reported nationwide Saturday. That's down, compared to the daily average of more than 800,000 that was reported in mid-January. Health experts believe the Omicron variant is now running out of people to infect, and are hopeful this is a sign that we are entering "endemic" status with this virus.

Great Day, Feb 21, 2022, 6:05 a.m., 00:24, Local: Merck's covid pill appears to be keeping people out of the hospital. A new study is now finding the anti-viral treatment reduced the risk of hospitalization by 65%. Researchers looked at more than 1200 people with covid and found just one percent of the group was hospitalized.

Great Day, Feb 24, 2022, 5:06 a.m., :50, Local: The Clovis Unified School District board voted to allow maskless students to remain in class, rather than sending maskless students to a different part of campus, as public mask mandates continue to loosen. To be able to qualify for this change, students and faculty must not have been in close contact with someone who had coronavirus within the past 10 days and have not tested positive for 10 days. Face masks are still strongly encouraged, especially in large group settings. Fresno State says it has a campus vaccination rate over 90%.

Great Day, Mar 11, 2022, 6:01 a.m., 00:22, Local: China is now locking down millions of its residents after a Covid-19 outbreak. Chinese authorities ordered nine million people in the city of Changchun into lockdown today.

Great Day, Mar 16, 2022, 6:04 a.m., 00:14, Local: The white house says it needs funding from congress to continue fighting Covid-19. White house press secretary Jen Psaki says there is no option. She listed examples of how Americans could be impacted if the money is delayed.

Great Day, Mar 21, 2022, 5:19 a.m., 00:26, Local: Health experts are keeping an eye on the BA.2 subvariant. White House chief medical advisor Dr. Anthony Fauci warns this subvariant is up to 50% more transmissible than the original omicron strain but says it doesn't appear more severe.

10pm, Feb 28, 2022, 10:05pm, 01:43, Local: Mask mandates are ending statewide, meaning vaccinated people no longer need to mask up indoors and mask requirements in schools are ending as well. This is important to viewers because it is a call to action and the company might be pushed to perform better after being exposed.
